

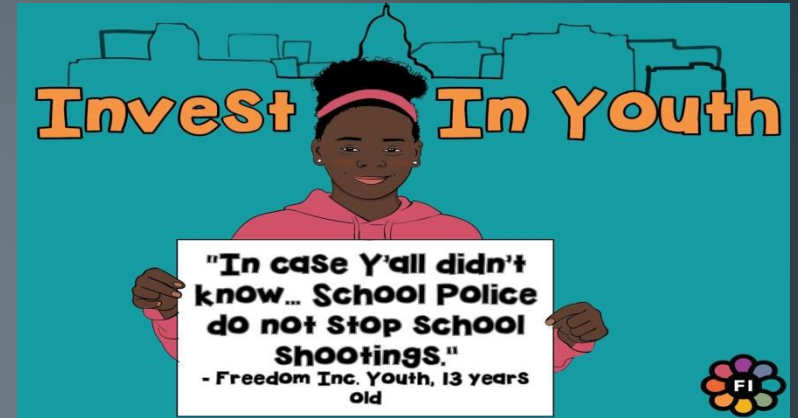

According to Madison police, there have been 133 cases of juveniles operating a vehicle without the owner's consent — i.e., car theft — between Jan. 1 and Oct. 11, and 27 juveniles were implicated in 90 of those cases. Those implicated include drivers and passengers

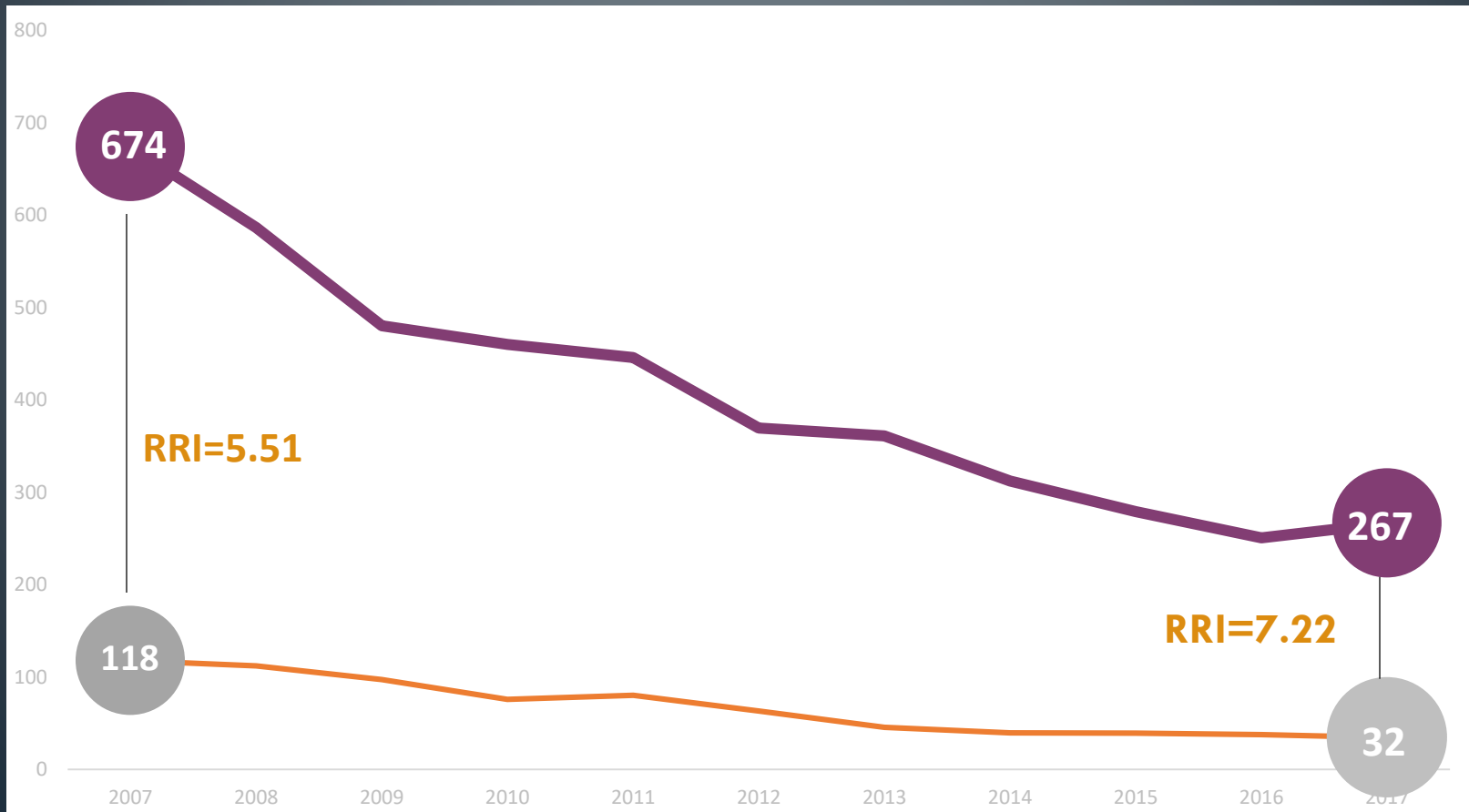
DISTRICT ATTORNEY RESPONSE TO CHIEF KOVAL'S BLOG REGARDING THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM

"I agree that we need to all put our heads together and come up with a community solution," Green said, but plenty of programs — including a new city violence prevention program — already exist for juvenile offenders. She said what's needed is to build on and better coordinate the programs. (Lynn Green, Director of Dane County Human Services—Oct 2018, WSJ)

What does the data tell us?

The juvenile arrest rate is decreasing for both Black and White juveniles.

However, the Black-White disparity in juvenile arrest rates has increased over time.

 - Zeidler Center and local police departments (LOI)
- When?
 - February 2019-December 2019
