Intergovernmental Agreement Relating to the Sharing of Costs for Improvements to CTH M & CTH S and for the Jurisdictional Transfer of a Portion of CTH S to Madison

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The Dane County Dept of Public Works, Highway & Transportation and representatives of the City of Madison have determined that CTH M & S, Mineral Point Road from Pleasant View Road to USH 12 and Junction Road from Isaac Dr to Valley View Road needs to be reconstructed. In exchange, the City agreed to accept the jurisdictional transfer of CTH S from the eastern US Highway 12 ramp termini to the western intersection of the jug handle interchange.

The Dane County Highway Dept has drafted an agreement to cover the cost charing for the reconstruction project, and for the jurisdictional transfer.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The County has funds budgeted in in account HWCONCAP-59993 for this project. After a fund transfer of \$61,000, the available funds will be \$2,861,000.
