INCREASING 2015 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TELLURIAN UCAN, INC. DCDHS - ACS DIVISION

### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Tellurian UCAN, Inc. operates the Transitional Housing Program (THP). THP is licensed as a twenty bed Community Based Residential Facility that is primarily funded by HUD and Dane County. THP plays a critical role in the mental health and AODA systems by providing housing for single adults who are homeless. Tellurian has been notified that its 2015 HUD funding will be further reduced by \$61,982. Given the critical role THP plays, it is important to maintain THP's capacity at twenty beds. This resolution enables DCDHS to transfer funds from the PACT account to the Tellurian THP account to cover the HUD reduction and maintain transitional housing services for single adults.

## Current Policy or Practice -

Budget and professional service contract changes require County Board approval.

## Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Given the critical role THP plays, it is important to maintain THP's capacity at twenty beds. The State of Wisconsin has informed DCDHS that the funding required to maintain the State operated Program of Assertive Community Treatment (PACT) is less than the 2015 budgeted amount. This enables DCDHS to transfer funds from the PACT account to the Tellurian THP account to cover the HUD reduction and maintain transitional housing services for single adults who are homeless. The professional services contract for Tellurian UCAN, Inc. will be amended.
