19	employees may voluntarily donate leave to other employees who face a

22	catastrophic leave. Approval of catastrophic leave is dependent upon availability
23	of donated leave pursuant to sub (a).
24	(c) If the Division determines an employee is ineligible to receive donated leave
25	under this subsection, the employee may appeal to the Committee by filing a
26	written request within ten business days of a denial. The Committee may affirm
27	the Division's denial or grant the employee's request for donated leave. The
