Dane County Human Services Dept. (HS) is seeking to limit public access to certain spaces in the Job Center on Aberg Ave. There are currently eight different entities in the bldg working with different clientele, hours of operation, needs for privacy & security concerns. Based on similar needs, four other HS facilities have added card reader door access systems in the last few years. Environmental Systems Inc. (ESI) has provided the card reader door access systems at all four of these facilities. HS staff is trained in ESI's software & hardware & the different bldgs & the systems are interconnected. The HS Dept. is requesting a bid waiver to have the same vendor provide a fifth system to maintain consistency in operations, programming (current plans & future changes), parts, equipment, service and systems troubleshooting.
