AWARDING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO THE DANE COUNTY WISCONSIN
PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION SUPERVISORY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT

The County has reached a tentative agreement with the Dane County Wisconsin Professional Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit on a collective bargaining agreement for 2023. The current collective bargaining agreement will run through December 17, 2022. The County employs approximately 46 full time equivalent employees in this bargaining unit.

The agreed upon principle economic items include increases to the wages, undesirable hours pay to be paid on overtime, educational incentive pay being included in undesirable hours pay, vacation bank and overtime, increases in maximum amounts for the sick and vacation banks. The economic items agreed to are within the County's budgetary constraints. All negotiated changes are highlighted in the attached summary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors approves the cost of living adjustments between Dane County and the Dane County Wisconsin Professional Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit for the period of December 18, 2022 through December 16, 2023; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that County officials take appropriate action to implement this resolution.
