AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND DANE COUNTY
FOR FUNDING OF A CITIZEN-BASED INVASIVE PLANT MONITORING PROGRAM

The Land & Water Resources Department – Parks Division has secured funding of \$1,800 from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) through the Wisconsin Citizen-based Monitoring Partnership Program for improving invasive plant monitoring by Dane County Parks volunteers.

The goal of the program is to recruit and train volunteers to monitor invasive plants on county parkland and to submit invasive plant data to the Parks Division. The project includes volunteer training events which may include providing food and beverages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby authorize the \$1,800 Wisconsin Citizen-based Monitoring Partnership contract with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive is authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a new revenue account LWRPKOP Invasive Species Control Revenue be established for \$1,800 and account LWRPKOP 21285 Invasive Species Control Expense be increased by \$1,800. These funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
