Wildlife Areas

Marsh provided an overview of public information meetings that were held in May to discuss the potential opening of 3 new wildlife areas. Related to the Mud Lake Wildlife Area, members of the Marx family asked the Park Commission to reconsider the hunting as an allowed use due to proximity of the area to their home site and limited size of the property. John Keefe of the Ferry Bluff Eagle Council asked the Park Commission to further investigate potential negative impacts to nesting, perching and fishing bald eagles that have been frequently observed in the Fish, Crystal and Mud Lake region. The Park Commission asked staff to continue discussions with the Marx family and John Keefe, and to report back at a future meeting.

Friends of Dane County Parks Endowment

Bill Lunney announced the upcoming healthy park tour that will highlight the connection between physical and mental health and parks. Events will be held at CamRock Park Shelter 3 on June 11, Indian Lake on July 23, Donald Park on August 6, Pheasant Branch Conservancy on August 13, and Capital Springs Recreation Area on August 20th. The tour will lead up to the annual fund raising event.
