

AUTHORIZING DONATION OF FUNDS FOR
ACCESSIBLE SHORE FISHING ENHANCEMENTS

The Babcock County Park lake access site is one of the most highly used on the Madison chain of lakes. The boat landing hosts several annual fishing events each year for veterans and persons with disabilities. Dane County Parks has been working with the Foundation for Dane County Parks, Madison Fishing Expo and Access Ability Wisconsin on preliminary planning for an accessible fishing pier, kayak landing, boat loading assistance station and parking improvements at Babcock County Park.

Sally Wilmeth and Terry Geurkink have donated \$25,000 towards the development of an accessible fishing pier for Babcock County Park. The existing accessible fishing pier is now in need of replacement. The new accessible pier will improve universal access and shore fishing opportunities for all people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$25,000 in funds from Sally Wilmeth and Terry Geurkink for an accessible fishing pier at Babcock County Park,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive gives thanks to Sally Wilmeth and Terry Geurkink for their generous donation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LWRPKOP 81566 be increased by \$25,000, expense account LWRPKOP 10104 be increased \$23,223 and expense account LWRPKOP 10108 be increased by \$1,777. These funds shall carry forward until expended.
