2015 RES-506 AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A WDNR GRANT FOR A SNOWMOBILE TRAIL BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT -MARXVILLE OVER HALFWAY PRAIRIE CREEK Dane County Land & Water Resources – Parks Division has received a grant for \$17,400 from the WI Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for a Snowmobile Trail Bridge Rehabilitation Project. The purpose of the grant is to replace a deteriorating snowmobile trail bridge with a new bridge. This bridge is located in the Town of Berry on State Corridor #21 over the Halfway Prairie Creek and is maintained by the White Lightning Snowmobile Club. Dane County Parks will work with the White Lightning Snowmobile Club to complete this project. Once the project is complete, WDNR will reimburse Dane County for 100% of the costs up to \$17,400. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dane County authorizes the acceptance of a WDNR Grant for a snowmobile trail bridge rehabilitation project. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a new expense account CPLWRESC Marxville Snowmobile Bridge Grant be established for \$17,400 and revenue account CPLWRESC 81623 Snowmobile Trail Bridge Grant be increased by \$17,400. These funds shall carry forward until expended.
