RE: Public Hearing: Amending the Dane County Comprehensive Plan by Adopting the Town of Springfield Comprehensive Plan

The Town of Springfield has adopted a Comprehensive Plan and has requested its adoption by Dane County as part of the *Dane County Comprehensive Plan*. In order to comply with the requirements of the state comprehensive planning law, Dane County must notify all local government jurisdictions within or adjacent to the county, giving them at least a 30 day review period prior to the county public hearing.
