**REPEAL AND RECREATE CHAPTER 17, FLOODPLAIN ZONING**

**Policy Analysis Statement:**

Brief Description of Proposal -  
 A mapping project initiated by FEMA and Wisconsin DNR has resulted in an updated Flood Insurance Study (FIS) being produced for areas of Dane County. In order for the County to remain eligible for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program we must adopt the revised FIS. State law requires that our floodplain zoning ordinance meets certain minimum standards when adopting a new FIS, this OA brings our ordinance into compliance.

Current Policy or Practice -  
 Enforcement of floodplain regulations under existing Chapter 17 language and previous Flood Insurance Study.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -  
 Amendment will repeal and recreate Chapter 17, Floodplain Zoning, to comply with minimum standards required by State Statute. The changes include updated flood insurance rate maps and a revised Flood Insurance Study based on newer data. The revised ordinance language provides clarity on the procedures and requirements of complying with floodplain development standards and their administration.
