Amending Chapter 62 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances, Revising the Medical Examiner's Cremation Fees

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The ordinance amendment increases the fee for services related to issuing a cremation certificate to \$350. The amendment also creates a new fee of \$150 for services related to issuing a medical certification of death. The amendment further specifies that these fees would be waived for individuals who would qualify for funeral expenses to be paid by the State of Wisconsin. A 2/3 vote is required under County ordinance 7.61(1)M.

Current Policy or Practice -

The County currently charges \$285 for services related to issuing a cremation certificate. No fee is currently charged for services related to issuing a medical certification of death.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Increasing the cremation fee to \$350 per certificate would generate an additional \$123,500 in annual revenue based on an estimated 1,900 cremation certificates issued annually. Establishing a fee of \$150 per certification for services related to issuing a medical certification of death would generate an additional \$60,000 based on approximately 400 certifications issued annually.
