## History/Related Actions:

During its 23 March 2016 meeting, the AAA Legislative/Advocacy Committee discussed the Family Care/IRIS 2.0 Concept Paper and Stakeholders' Blueprint for Long-Term Care Redesign.

Tom Frazier distributed copies of an article he wrote for the Milwaukee-based publication 50 Plus detailing four major concerns he has with the Concept Paper. Mickey Beil stated the Concept Paper was scheduled to go before the Legislature's Joint Finance Committee (JFC) as early as 1 April 2016 for approval.

A motion was made and passed to draft a letter detailing the Committee's major concerns with the Family Care/IRIS 2.0 Concept Paper. The letter would be introduced at the 4/4/16 AAA Board meeting for approval and subsequently sent to all JFC members and Dane County State legislators.

Frazier stated the Stakeholders' Blueprint was developed by the Wisconsin Long-Term Care Coalition, a diverse group of 60 organizations that includes consumers, advocates for the disabled and elderly, Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRCs), aging units, and managed care organizations.

A motion was made and passed to recommend the AAA Board support the Stakeholders' Blueprint for Long-Term Care Redesign.
