ADDENDUM OF AGREEMENT #12059 A

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into effective as of the date by which both parties hereto have executed this document, by and between the County of Dane (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System on behalf of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and UW Milwaukee Cultural Resource Management (hereinafter, "Provider").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Provider and County, by a separate document (hereinafter, the "Master Agreement"), Purchase of Services Agreement No. 12059, have previously entered into a contractual relationship pursuant to which Provider conducted Phase III Archaeological Data Recovery within the Lake Farms Archaeological District and site 47DA1428, and

WHEREAS County and Provider wish to amend the Master Agreement in order to extend the contract and provide required additional field/lab investigations in Lake Farm County in the summer of 2015, complete the Phase I Archaeological Survey of the staging and storage area within McDaniel Park and provide onsite construction monitoring throughout the trail development.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party for itself, the parties do agree as follows:

- 1. The Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unchanged in any manner by this addendum except as changes are expressly set forth herein. This addendum shall control only to the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Master Agreement and this addendum.
- 2. The term of the contract is extended through December 31, 2017 to continue the program at an additional cost not to exceed \$156,079.
