Batterman distributed and discussed the handout on the proposed Older Americans Act funding. The funding is distributed to each state based on the state's census of people age 60+. The funding is then allocated to the Counties based on census data.

3. Wisconsin Aging Advocacy Network

The White House Conference on Aging has identified four main focus areas: long-term care, retirement security, healthy aging, and elder justice. WAAN is forming workgroups to draft position papers on these topics.

Batterman provided a summary of the State's initiative to integrate AAAs and ADRCs throughout the State. More details will be made available at a later date.
