3	AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF A CONSERVATION SPECIALIST II TO
4	CONSERVATION TECHNICIAN FOR THE LAND CONSERVATION DIVISION OF LAND &
5	WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

7	The Department of Land & Water Resources – Land Conservation has identified the need to
8	reclassify the vacant Conservation Specialist II position #2614 to a Conservation Technician.
9	This position has been vacant for over six months. The Department of Administration has
10	recommended approval of this request.
11	
12	The Land Conservation Division provides conservation planning assistance and engineering
13	technical services to landowners throughout Dane County that are focused on reducing soil
14	erosion and nutrient loading to surface water. Conservation specialists primarily provide
15	planning assistance and the agricultural engineer provides technical services. Increases in
16	workload due to new programs, flooding impacts due to climate change, and cost-share
17	opportunities has generated a technical workload backlog. Converting the vacant Conservation
18	Specialist II position to a Conservation Technician will allow the division to address the backlog
19	and continue providing timely services to the landowners of Dane County.

21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors does
22	hereby approve and authorize the reclassification of the vacant Conservation Specialist II (P8)
23	position #2614 to a Conservation Technician (P8) position in the Land and Water Resources
24	Department – Land Conservation Division and filling of the vacant position.
