4 AWARDING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO THE DANE COUNTY
5 WISCONSIN PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION/SUPERVISORY
6 LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT

8 The County has reached a tentative agreement with the Dane County Wisconsin Professional
9 Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit on a collective bargaining agreement that will
10 run from December 15, 2024 through December 13, 2025. The current collective bargaining
11 agreement will run through December 14, 2024. The County employs approximately 46 full time
12 equivalent employees in this bargaining unit.

14 The agreed upon principle increases are in the sick leave hours and cap, vacation hours and
15 vacation bank, increase in fixed holidays, Caregiver Leave policy, Paid Parental leave policy,
16 update of 2025 health insurance costs. The economic items agreed to are within the County's
17 budgetary constraints. All negotiated changes are highlighted in the attached summary.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors
20 approves the terms and conditions of a successor agreement between Dane County and the Dane
21 County Wisconsin Professional Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit for the period
22 of December 15, 2024 through December 13, 2025; and

24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that County officials take appropriate action to implement this
25 resolution.
