AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FUNDING FROM WISDOT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE LOWER YAHARA RIVER TRAIL INTERPRETATIVE SIGN

Dane County has been notified by WisDOT that funding has been approved in the Surface Transportation Program (STP) for an interpretive sign for the Lower Yahara River Trail.

Dane County and WisDOT completed construction of the Lower Yahara River Trail project from the Capital City Trail to McDaniel Park in 2016. As part of the design process environmental commitments including the installation of interpretive signs along the trail were required. The project was closed before the signs were fabricated and installed. Interpretative signage about the history of the area will be installed near the Lower Yahara River Trail in William G. Lunney Lake Farm County Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the funding amount of \$28,000 from WisDOT and the County Executive is hereby authorized to signed the State Municipal Agreement on behalf of Dane County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revenue account LEWSLUNY NEW "LYRT Signage Grant" be created and expense account LEWSLUNY 51043 be increased by \$28,000 and that all funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land & Water Resources Director, Dane County Parks Director and the Parks Planning and Development Manager are authorized to execute additional documents necessary to accept the funds, implement the project, and submit payment requests to WisDOT.
