

What does it mean to be "Treatable"?


- Statutory Definition of Treatment: 51.01(17)

 Psychological, educational, social, chemical, medical or somatic techniques designed to bring about rehabilitation of an individual who has mental illness, drug dependency, or developmental disability.
- An individual is a proper subject for treatment if the administration of psychiatric and/or psychological treatment techniques may control, improve or cure the mental illness, developmental disability or drug dependency.

(from Civil Jury Instruction 7050)
