

**Dane County Board of Supervisors
Amending Chapter 10 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances
Zoning Map Amendment Petition 11249**

Dane County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

The Zoning Districts Maps as referenced under Dane County Code of Ordinance Section 10.03 shall be amended as follows:

Town Map: Town of Vermont

Location: Section 9

Zoning District Boundary Changes

A-1EX to RH-1

Part of the N ½ of the NE ¼ of Section 9, T7N, R6E, Town of Vermont, Dane County, Wisconsin. More fully described as follows:

Beginning at the N ¼ corner of the said Section 9; thence S89°50'31" East along the section line 1818.70 feet to the Westerly line of CSM No 3178; thence S22°39'09"E along the said CSM (previously recorded as S22°18'55"E) 594.86 feet to the center of Blue Mounds Trail; thence S67°41'05"W along the center of Blue Mounds Trail 617.42 feet; thence S65°03'11"W 132.92 feet to a point on the right-of-way line of Blue Mounds Trail; thence S57°42'24"W, 259.25 feet; thence N74°13'45"W, 1181.07 feet; thence N00°01'43"W, 662 feet to the point of beginning.

CONDITIONAL ZONING

Conditional zoning is hereby imposed pursuant to Section 10.255(3)(a)2.(b) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances. The rezoned area shall be subject to the following conditions.

CERTIFIED SURVEY REQUIRED

The above listed description/s is/are intended to describe land for which a certified survey map will be prepared for approval and recorded. Within 90 days of rezoning approval by Dane County, a *final* certified survey map that describes the land to be rezoned shall be prepared in accordance with all applicable provisions of Chapter 236 Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 75 Dane County Code of Ordinances, and submitted to the Dane County Zoning Division. Upon submission of the final certified survey map, the Zoning and Land Regulation Committee, or its authorized representative, shall, within 30 days, approve, approve conditionally, or reject the certified survey map. **Failure to submit the final certified survey within the 90 day period and/or failure to record the survey with the Dane County Register of Deeds will cause the rezone to be null and void. Two copies of the recorded survey shall be submitted to Dane County Zoning.**
