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3 ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL OPIATE TREATMENT AND
4 AMENDING 2014 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS WITH JOURNEY MENTAL
5 HEALTH CENTER

8 The Department of Justice has awarded additional funds to Dane County to reach out to jail
9 inmates who are dependent on opiates and provide treatment upon their release from jail. Initial
10 funding for this project ended September 30, 2014. These additional funds cover services for
11 the period of October 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015. Journey Mental Health Center will
12 continue to provide treatment to individuals as soon as possible after their release from jail.
13 Presentations on overdose prevention and educational materials will continue to be provided by
14 Aids Resource Center of Wisconsin while individuals are held in the Dane County Jail, which will
15 refer opiate-dependent individuals to Journey Mental Health Center. While individuals are in jail,
16 Journey will conduct intakes and set initial treatment appointments for the day of release from
17 jail, a time where many are at risk to return to use of opiates and in some cases overdose.
18 Journey Mental Health Center’s ACS contract increase includes awarding an additional \$25,060
19 for these purposes for a 2014 total of \$116,572. Aids Resource Center of Wisconsin will receive
20 an additional \$3,325 for a 2014 total of \$15,199. The County is required by the grant to provide
21 a match of 25%. The amounts for both vendors include this required match, which is already
22 included in the Department’s budget. The balance of the grant will be awarded in 2015
23 contracts.

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25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following 2014 Department of Human
26 Services revenue be credited to the County General Fund and transferred from the General
