D. Action Items

REVIEW OF PREVIOUSLY FUNDED HIGHWAY HEATED STORAGE FACILITY INSULATION PROJECT

John Welch and Jerry Mandli explained the revised project estimate: This project was funded in Round 2 at \$43,000.00 based on pre-bid estimates. Per subcommittee policy on bid estimate overruns, the Public Works Dept. is asking the subcommittee to review the anticipated additional costs and approve the revised project cost. The Public Works Dept. needs to proceed with and complete the project before the winter heating season in order to realize the energy and cost savings of the project this year. Based on further research, the Public Works Dept. has determined that expanding spray foam insulation will provide superior insulation and savings results over the originally proposed batt insulation. The existing insulation was wet and was not sealing out air. They determined that replacing it with new batt insulation would result in the same problems over time and that spray insulation would result in air sealing, moisture prevention, and insulation for energy and cost savings.

The bids for expanding spray foam insulation (including power washing and removing the existing crumbling exterior walls) included one (base bid 1) for 1" of insulation with an R value of 7.5, which will provide a 10 year payback based on energy savings estimates, and one (base bid 2) a 2.5" layer of insulation with a R value of 19, which will provide a 6.3 year payback based on annual energy saving estimates.

NOTE: The original award for this project was \$43,000.00, so this subcommittee action on the revised project estimate increased the award by an additional \$57,629.00.

A motion was made by HENDRICK, seconded by ERICKSON, that the revised project cost estimate for base bid 2 (2.5" of spray foam insulation) with a total project cost not to exceed \$100,629.00 be approved. The motion carried by a voice vote. (4-0)
