The Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act ("the Act") requires employers covered by the Act to either purchase worker's compensation insurance or be self-insured (and thereby assume the responsibility for worker's compensation risk and payment.) Dane County transfers some of the risk of operating a self-insured workers' compensation program by purchasing
