2 AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR PHASE 10 – CELL 2 LINER CONSTRUCTION  
3

4 The Department of Public Works, Highway and Transportation reports the receipt of bids for  
5 Phase 10 – Cell 2 Liner Construction at Dane County Landfill Site #2, 7012 US Highway 12 and  
6 18, Madison, WI, Bid #316024.

17 The Public Works staff finds the amount to be reasonable and recommends the bid be awarded  
18 to RelyCo, Inc., Contractors.

20 There are sufficient funds available for this project. The term of the borrowing used to support  
21 this project will be ten years.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that a Contract be awarded to RelyCo, Inc.,  
24 Contractors. in the amount of \$ 2,011,571.04; and

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Executive and the County Clerk be authorized  
27 and directed to sign the Contract; and

29 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$2,011,571.04 in account SWRODFLD 58059 “Phase VII  
30 and VIII Closure” be transferred to account SWRODFLD 58066 “Phase 10 Cell 2 Liner  
31 Construction”, and

33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$400,000.00 in account SWRODFLD 58059 “Phase VII and  
34 VIII Closure” be transferred to account SWRODFLD 58066 “Phase 10 Cell 2 Liner Construction”  
35 for Contingency with regards to this project; and

37 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Department of Public Works, Highway & Transportation  
38 be directed to ensure complete performance of the Contract; and  
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40 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Public Works & Transportation Committee shall approve  
41 all change orders to the Contract, subject to submission of change orders to the County Board  
42 for approval where the sum involves \$20,000 or more than 10% of the original approved  
43 Contract amount, whichever is smaller.
