AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MADISON COLLEGE FOR THE PROVISION OF **EDUCATIONAL INSTRUCTION SERVICES TO JAIL RESIDENTS**

Dane County currently contracts with Madison College to provide General Education Diploma (GED) and High School Education (HSED) instruction to Dane County Jail residents including, preparation and testing, basic skills and literacy assessment, literacy skills, education in reading and writing, and basic literacy computer skills training. The current 5-year Contract #13577 expired 12/31/2023 and the Sheriff's Office seeks authorization to enter into another 5-year contract, term 1/1/2024 through 12/31/2028, for a total contract cost not to exceed \$208,310 as follows:
