8/10/21 Redistricting Commission placed on file Brian Standing and Rachel Rodriguez presented a memo from County Clerk Scott McDonell and County Board Chair Analiese Eicher, proposing a compressed timeline for completion of county, city, village and town decennial redistricting efforts by December 1. The timeline for the Redistricting Commission's work remains unchanged.

Caryl Terrell spoke in favor of a compressed timeline, and of getting new maps in place by the filing deadline for the 2022 spring elections.
