AUTHORIZING STAFFING AND FUNDING UPDATES TO SUPPORT THE VIOLENCE PREVENTION UNIT WITHIN PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON AND DANE COUNTY

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Public Health Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) Violence Prevention Unit received additional funding through the 2022 City of Madison Operating Budget to create new positions and this resolution creates those positions in the Dane County personnel roster for PHMDC. PHMDC was also allocated portions of the City and County American Rescue Plan Act funds and this resolution creates a new position to manage sub-awards to community partners.

Current Policy or Practice -

This creation of new positions requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Adopting the resolution will allow the PHMDC Violence Prevention Unit to be more appropriately staffed to implement strategies and initiatives to prevent, reduce, and end violence in Dane County through both individual-level interventions as well as population-level interventions to support a safer community.
