AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FOR GOODLAND TENNIS COURT RESTORATION

Dane County Parks is reconstructing the tennis and basketball courts at Goodland County Park.

Goodland County Park is located on the western shore of Lake Waubesa surrounded by a residential community in the Town of Dunn. The Park is on the National Register of Historic Places for a Native American Mound and offers a boat launch, beach, two reserveable shelters, a restroom, playground and tennis and basketball courts. These are the only sport courts within the Dane County Park System and are over 40 years old.

The restoration project will include new asphalt with court surfacing, new fencing, and lines for basketball, tennis and pickleball. Pickleball is a court sport similar to tennis, played on a smaller court with a perforated plastic ball and wooden paddles about twice the size of ping pong paddles. Pickleball is fun for all ages and has grown in popularity throughout the United States.

The cost of the project is \$156,860. The Dunn Town Board has approved cost share funds up to \$34,885 for the restoration project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$34,885 in funds from the Town of Dunn for the Goodland Tennis Court Restoration.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LEWSLUNY 81566 and expense account LEWSLUNY 58036 be increased by \$34,885. These funds shall carry forward until expended.
