- 63 ix. the Youth Justice Manager
- 64 x. the Dane County Department of Human Services Community Programs
65 Manager;
- 66 xi. two persons from diverse backgrounds who have lived experiences of
67 incarceration or have been directly impacted by the criminal justice system
68 selected from a list of applicants and appointed by the chair of the Community
69 Justice Council.
- 70 b. Duties. The subcommittee shall 1) research local and national best
71 practices to identify criminal justice system approaches to decrease and eliminate
72 disparities, including making recommendations about current programs to
73 decrease criminal justice system involvement; 2) use data to analyze racial equity
74 gaps throughout the criminal justice system and set benchmarks for reductions; 3)
75 lead inclusive engagement of communities most impacted by the criminal justice
76 system; 4) report quarterly to the Community Justice Council
- 77 2. Pretrial Services Subcommittee
- 78 a. Composition:
- 79 i. District Attorney or their designee,
- 80 ii. the Clerk of Courts or their designee;
- 81 iii. the Presiding Judge of the Dane County Circuit Court or their designee;
- 82 iv. the Sheriff or their designee;
- 83 v. the County Executive or their designee;
- 84 vi. a representative of the Office of the Public Defender, appointed by the State
85 Public Defender;
- 86 vii. a representative of the Wisconsin Department of Corrections appointed by
87 the Secretary of the Department of Corrections
- 88 viii. the director of the Office of Pretrial Services
- 89 ix. the Criminal Justice Council Coordinator;
- 90 x. two persons from diverse backgrounds who have lived experiences of
91 incarceration or have been directly impacted by the criminal justice system

92 selected from a list of applicants and appointed by the chair of the Community
93 Justice Council;

94 **b.** Duties: The subcommittee shall 1) identify approaches to lowering the
95 pretrial population; 2) analyze court appearance rates and publish findings; 3)
96 investigate local and national best practices regarding peer supports and
97 community engagement at pretrial; 4) report quarterly to the Community Justice
98 Council.

99 **3.** Behavioral Health Subcommittee

100 **a.** Composition:

101 **i.** District Attorney or their designee,

102 **ii.** the Director of the Department of Human Services or their designee;

103 **iii.** the Presiding Judge of the Dane County Circuit Court or their designee;

104 **iv.** the Sheriff or their designee;

105 **v.** the Madison Police Department Chief of Police or their designee;

106 **vi.** a representative of the Office of the Public Defender, appointed by the State
107 Public Defender;

108 **vii.** a representative of the Wisconsin Department of Corrections appointed by
109 the Secretary of the Department of Corrections

110 **viii.** the Chief of Chiefs of Police or their designee;

111 **ix.** the Corporation Counsel or their designee;

112 **x.** the director of NAMI Dane County, or their designee

113 **xi.** one additional public member with behavioral health expertise selected
114 from a list of applicants and appointed by the chair of the Community Justice
115 Council.;

116 **b.** Duties: The subcommittee shall 1) review the intersection of behavioral
117 health and criminal justice including data analysis; 2) investigate local and national
118 best practice in the crisis continuum of care; 3) analyze data and set goals for
119 reduction of criminal legal involvement; 4) report quarterly to the Community
120 Justice Council.

121 **(f)** Section 15.04(2) shall not apply to the subcommittees set forth in sub (3)(e).

122 **(g)** all public members of the subcommittees listed in sub(3)(e) shall serve 2
123 year terms and may receive per diems and mileage per section 15.04(7)(a).

128 *provides mileage and per diems for such public members.]*
