

AUTHORIZING DONATION OF FUNDS TOWARDS  
ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS AT JENNI AND KYLE PRESERVE

The Jenni and Kyle Preserve is a unique park that is intended to serve children and persons with disabilities. It offers accessible fishing and picnic areas, trails, wheelchair swings and a shelter building around two spring-fed ponds containing trout and panfish. The vision for the Jenni and Kyle Preserve began in 1989 with a donation from Harvey and Patricia Wilmeth as a memorial for their grandchildren, Jenni and Kyle, who both died at the age of 4 due to a degenerative neurological disorder.

The Jenni and Kyle Foundation donated \$100,000 to restore and expand the accessible path at Jenni and Kyle Preserve. Improved access to the stream and to some of the interior areas of the preserve, along with places for viewing wildlife, will increase accessible amenities at to the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$100,000 in funds from the Jenni and Kyle Foundation for accessibility improvements,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive gives thanks to Sally Wilmeth and Terry Geurkink for their ongoing generous donations in memory of their children Jenni and Kyle.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LEWSLUNY 81566 and expense account LEWSLUNY 58137 PARK ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS be increased by \$100,000. These funds shall carry forward until expended.
