- Status quo in concert with County Executive Parisi's budget guidelines
- Decision Items Contractual Changes
 - Rental adjustment for office (\$2500)
 - Software maintenance fee increase (\$1300)



VETERANS SERVICE OFFICE 2022-2023 AND BEYOND

- Sergeant First Class (SFC) Heath Robinson Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxic (PACT) Act – Signed into law August 2022
- Office move October 2022
- Hired and trained new staff Spring 2023
- Booming business increasing daily
- Community outreach
- Planning for future

PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE



- While we added a total of 2.0 FTE on the heals of the PACT Act, this is only a start. We must remain proactive to keep up with the ever-growing needs of our veterans. PACT Act workload will continue to increase for decades!
- Short-term goal (next couple years) increase staff by an additional two people.
- Community outreach specialist A recruiter of sorts to find/identify veterans and survivors in our community who are not already connected to VA benefits. Countless people are out there, we just need to find them!

LANGUAGE ACCESS

Continued Utilization of existing services – as needed

- Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has free language assistance
- Translation and interpretation services through Dane County Department of Human Services



Developing plans

- Create Spanish and Hmong office brochures, other pertinent signage
- Additional training for staff member who knows basic American Sign Language (ASL)
