

CELEBRATING VETERANS DAY AS AN OFFICIAL COUNTY HOLIDAY

Veterans Day is celebrated every year on November 11 as a day to pay respect and gratitude to Veterans of all wars for their patriotism, commitment to country and willingness to serve and sacrifice.

Originally recognized as Armistice Day in 1918, and later changed to Veterans Day in 1954, Act 52 Stat. 351; 5 U. S. Code, Sec. 87a, was approved on May 13, 1938, making the 11th of November in each year a legal holiday¹.

According to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, there are 350,042 Veterans in the State of Wisconsin, and an estimated 23,000 in Dane County². The Department of Veteran Affairs has projected a decline in the number of living veterans in the United States over the next 25 years, from 18.3 million today to 12.1 million by 2048³.

On Veterans Day throughout the county, state, and country, many veterans' organizations host events for veterans to give support, ease loneliness, and use comradery to combat lasting ill effects of service.

In Dane County, the County's Veteran Service Office provides invaluable expertise and support to veterans in the Dane County community. Their assistance in helping veterans apply for and receive their benefits is completed with the compassion and care that the members of the community that have committed to serving the country deserve.

2023 OA-073 has been introduced to establish November 11 as Veterans Day and makes Veterans Day an official Dane County Holiday.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board expresses gratitude to the veterans living in Dane County, and throughout the country for their service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dane County commemorates Veterans Day as a county holiday for employees on November 11 each year.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors encourages employees to use this proposed holiday to recognize, support, and learn more about veterans in the community.
