Authorizing Law: In March of 2021, the federal government authorized the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan (ARP) stimulus bill authorizing additional funding to respond to and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic across multiple areas of need.

AWARDING A GRANT TO BAYVIEW FOUNDATION FOR

CONSTRUCTION OF BAYVIEW COMMUNITY CENTER

DCDHS - HAA DIVISION

Dane County was allocated over \$106 million in ARP local aid. A portion of those funds has been previously committed to various efforts to promote economic and housing stability for households impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. \$1,000,000 in ARP funding was authorized in the 2024 Dane County Budget to provide funding to Bayview Foundation to complete construction on the Bayview Community Center, and related neighborhood amenities and facilities. The Bayview Community Center serves the residents of the Bayview Apartments and Townhouses, a Section 8 project based development, and the surrounding neighborhood.

Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic: Enduring economic hardship that originated during the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact Dane County. The pandemic has caused financial stress to many individuals and households. In 2020, 30-35 percent of Bayview residents lost their job due to the pandemic. Social isolation has exacerbated mental concerns such as anxiety and depression. More recently, inflationary pressures in the general economy and supply chain changes have caused increased food insecurity in Dane County.

Funding will be used to complete construction of the community center, make exterior improvements to the center and neighborhood, and purchase necessary furnishings and program supplies. The newly constructed Bayview Center increases the size of the center to 11,500 feet, and expand its ability to meet community needs.

It is anticipated the completed center will expand services available by doubling the number of children and teens participating in academic support, recreation, wellness, and employment programs; increasing adult participation in wealth building, parent programs, and language literacy; providing frontline mental health and wellness programming and resources for all ages; tripling the impact of food distribution by creating a dedicated, properly equipped food pantry; and doubling older adult participation in daily opportunities for connection, self-expression, fitness, and healthy meals.

The total grant award is \$1,000,000 for Bayview Foundation. The grant term is from April 8, 2024 - June 30, 2025.

Duplication of Funding/Existing Partnerships and Programs: The funding is not duplicative and additional funding is needed to complete the planned community center and neighborhood amenities.
