Intent/Justification

Part of the county's ARP allocation plan provided \$250,000 per year for three years (2022, 2023 and 2024) for legal services dedicated to eviction prevention efforts. Other funds have been combined with this allocation to address evictions. The county will be applying additional ARP funds to contract for these services through 2026. In the development of the 2025 budget, the \$250,000 was inadvertently left in the expenditure budget. This budget amount can be eliminated and reallocated to other housing needs. Amendments HHN-O-02 and HHN-O-03 apply these funds for staffing in Dane County and at the Dane County Housing Authority.

Intent/Justification

Resources are spread extremely thin in the Out of Home Care unit and cases coming into the system are increasingly complex. The children in county care and foster homes need more support but staffing has not grown. This position is an Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) position and the person in the position has worked an additional 214.8 hours in 2023 and an additional 32.02 hours so far in 2024. The position helps the Out of Home Care team with challenging referrals, complicated school/ESSA situations, placement emergencies, and licensing of foster care homes.
