Eliminate the earmark of \$100,000 to the Perry Family Free Clinic for harm reduction services and instead initiate a competitive request for proposals to be issued by Public Health for Madison and Dane County for harm reduction services and add the following language to 2024 RES: "The 2025 operating budget for the Opioid Settlement Funds includes \$100,000 to fund harm reduction services. These funds will be subject to a competitive request for proposals to be issued by Public Health for Madison and Dane County. PHMDC will coordinate with the Behavioral Health Division of the Department of Human Services in the development and evaluation of the RFP. Funds will be available to PHMDC on a reimbursement basis once a contract has been executed and expenses are incurred."
