AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDS FOR AN ANTI-TEXTING/INATTENTIVE DRIVING ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN GRANT NUMBER FG-2014-DANE CO-2453

The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin, is making funds available May through September 2014, for participation in an 2014 Anti-Texting/Inattentive Driving Enforcement Project, Grant Number FG-2014-DANE CO-2453. The goal of the federally funded enforcement project is to decrease the number of person's texting while driving and ultimately reduce traffic crashes. Texting is a leading cause of crashes related to inattentive driving and with the beltline highway undergoing a large construction project, additional enforcement of texting/distractive driving will minimize injury and loss of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept \$10,000 from the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for the Anti-Texting/Inattentive Driving Enforcement Grant, targeting the beltline highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$10,000 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's Office, Field Services Anti-Texting/Inattentive Driving Enforcement Grant revenue account (SHRFFLD-New) and to be credited to the General Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$10,000 is transferred from the General Fund to the following accounts:

Overtime-Texting/Inattentive (SHRFFLD-New)	\$8,100
Social Security (SHRFFLD-10108)	\$600
Retirement Fund (SHRFFLD-10099)	\$1,000
Workers Compensation (SHRFFLD-10189)	\$300

Grand Total \$10,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on behalf of the County of Dane, the County Clerk and County Executive are authorized to execute an agreement embodying the above provisions; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all unexpended funds and unrecognized revenues are carried forward from the 2014 to the 2015 budget period.
