## ACCEPTANCE OF A WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANT FOR UPPER MUD LAKE PARKING DEVELOPMENT

The Land & Water Resources Department has successfully secured a grant in the amount of \$59,195 from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI DNR) Outdoor Recreation Aids Grant Program.

9 The purpose of the grant is to develop a permanent public parking area and walk-in access to Upper Mud 10 Lake. Upper Mud Lake is perhaps the most popular ice fishing destination on the entire Madison chain of 11 lakes and has been lacking public access for decades. The project will include site preparation, parking lot, 12 storm water basin, surfacing, signage, gate information kiosk and landscaping.

The required match of \$59,195 for this project will be requested in the Land & Water Resources 2015 budget.
The debt issued to support this expenditure will have a term of 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County
Executive hereby accept the \$59,195 grant from the WI DNR,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a new revenue and expense account LEWSLUNY "Upper Mud Lk Parking Development" be established for \$59,195. These funds shall be carried forward until expended.
