AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF TRAINING GRANT

STREET SMART HAZMAT – LESSONS LEARNED

Dane County Emergency Management was awarded a training grant from Wisconsin Emergency Management totaling \$14,230.00.

This training grant award will be used to deliver "STREET SMART HAZMAT – LESSONS LEARNED." Course participants will review lessons learned by emergency responders over the last twenty years while responding to hazardous materials emergencies. Total cost for this offering is \$14,230 which includes instructors and material fees. This course will be repeated three times (over the course of three days) to incorporate "shifts" of fire personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$14,230.00 be set up as additional revenue in the Emergency Management, Hazardous Materials Planning Division Training Revenue Account 81812 and be credited to the General Fund and that \$14,230.00 be transferred from the General Fund to the Hazardous Materials Planning Division Training Expense Account 31133.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all unexpended funds and unrecognized revenues from this account be carried forward from the 2014 to the 2015 budget period.
