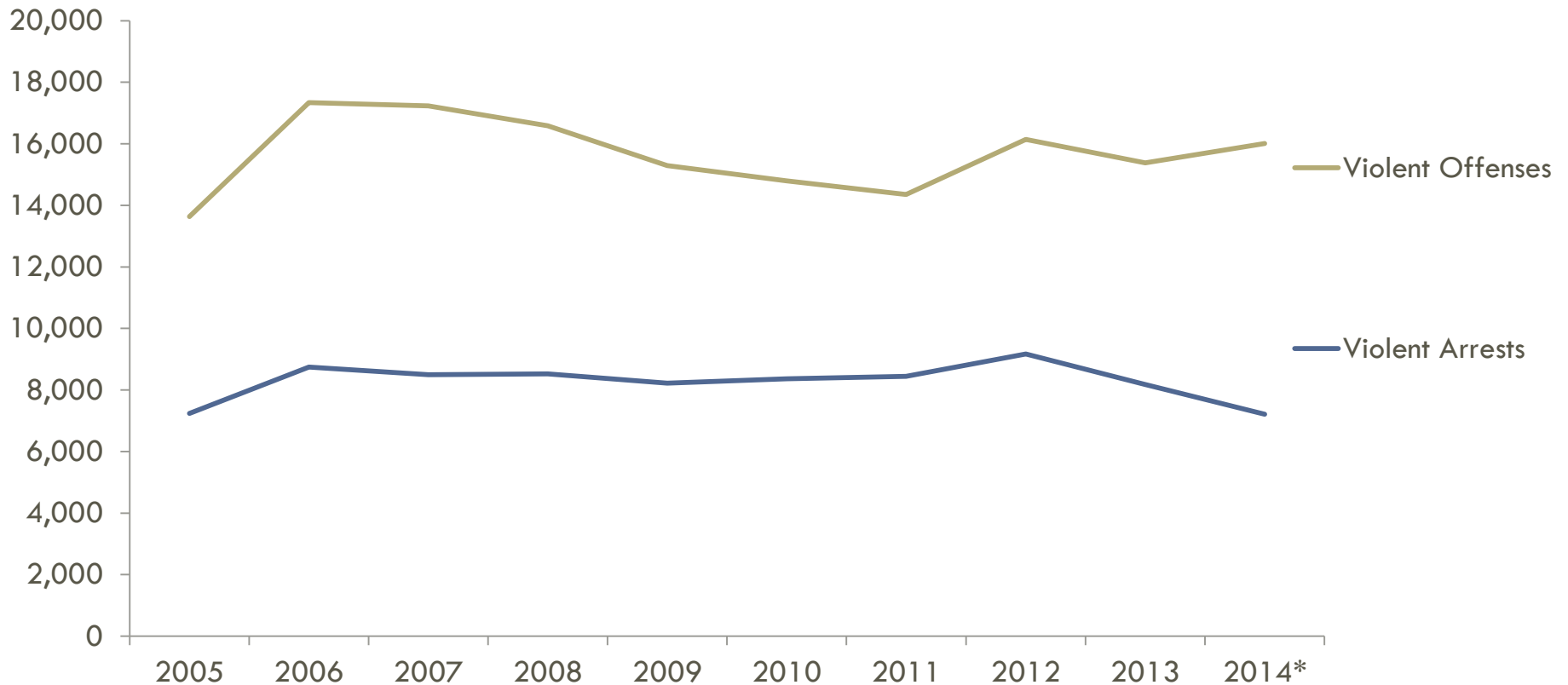

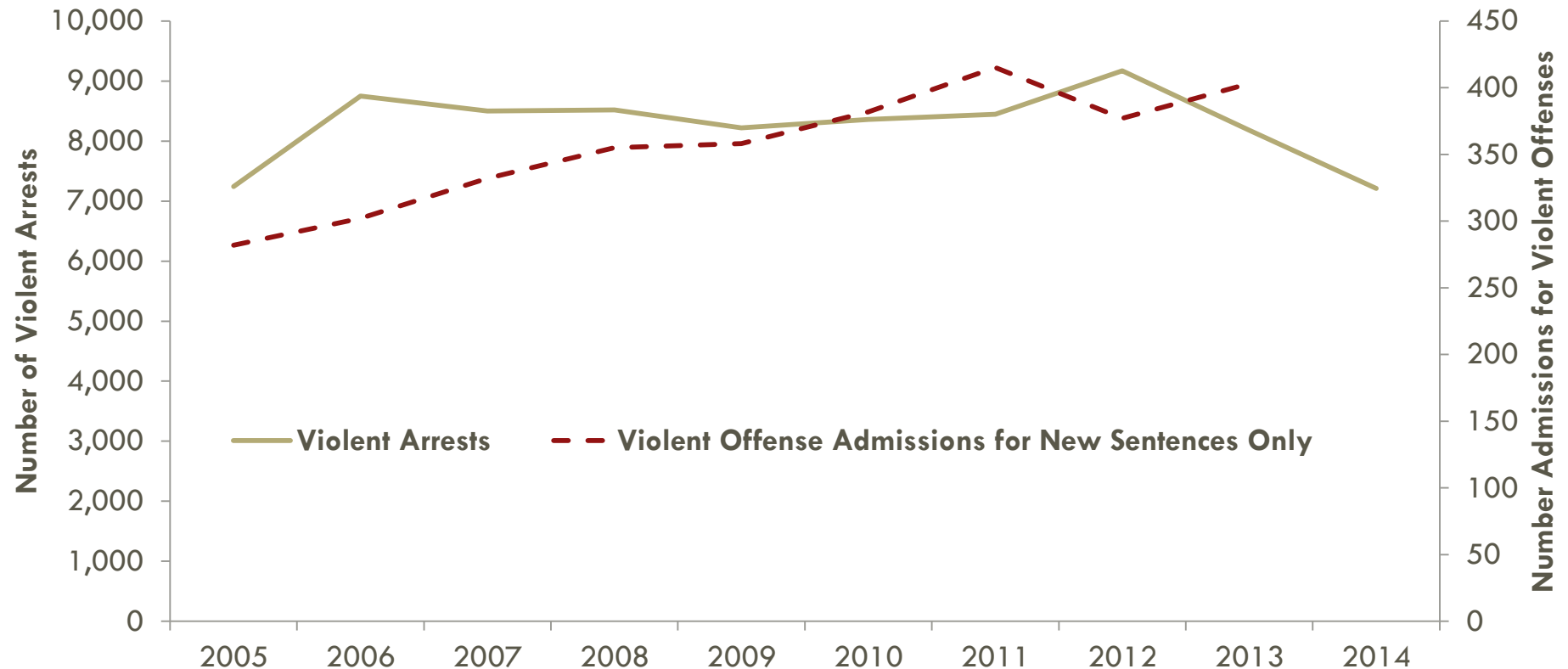

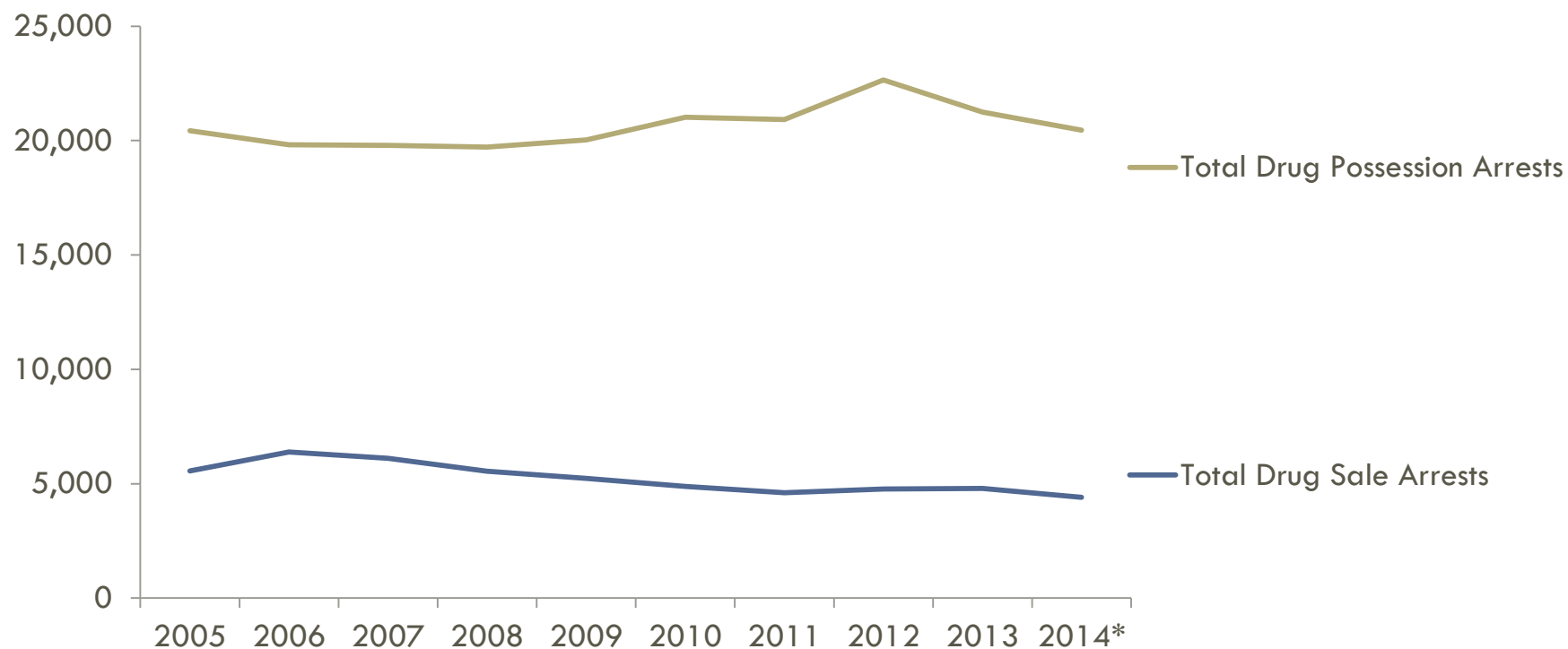
UCR Violent Crime Arrests and Prison Admissions by Violent Crime

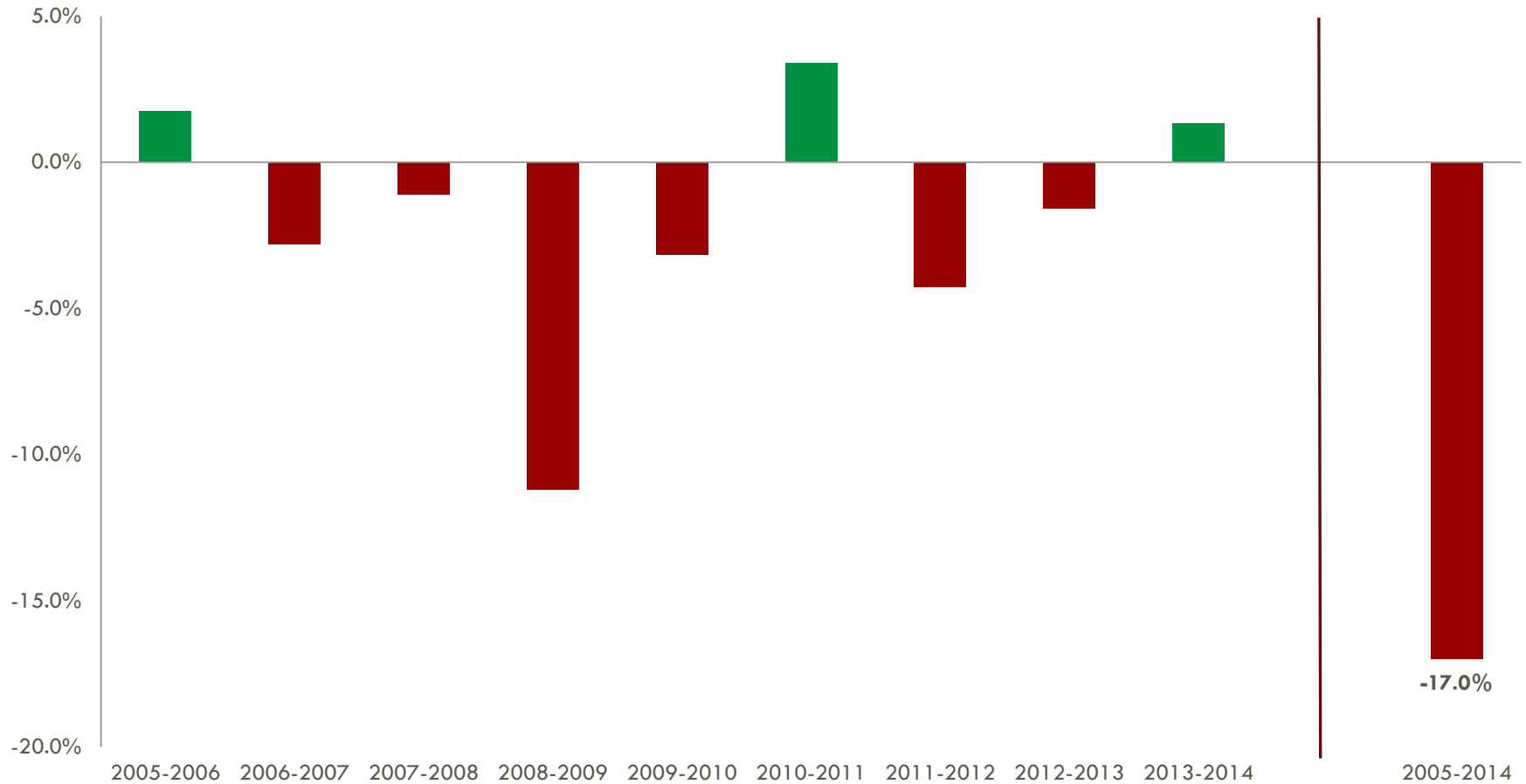

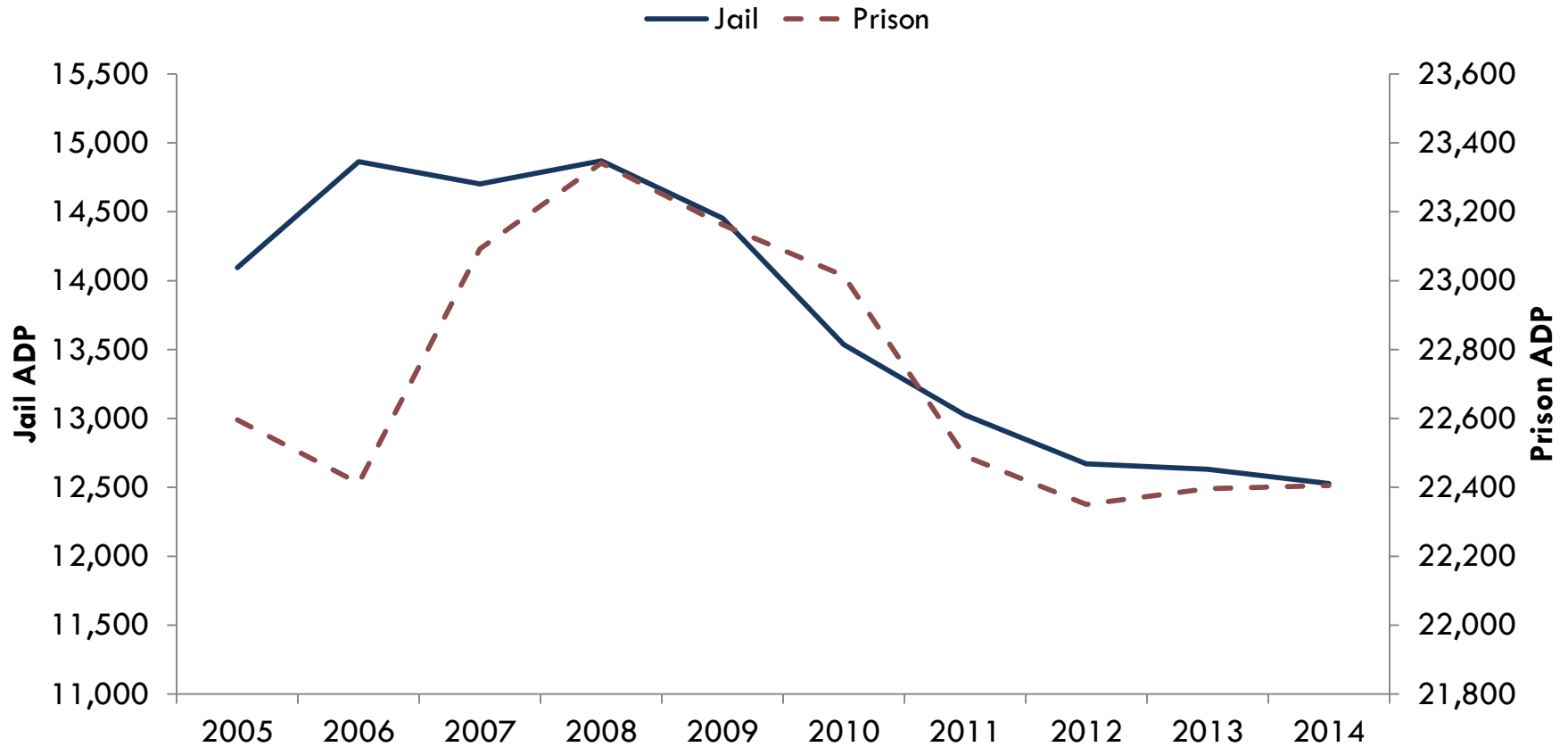

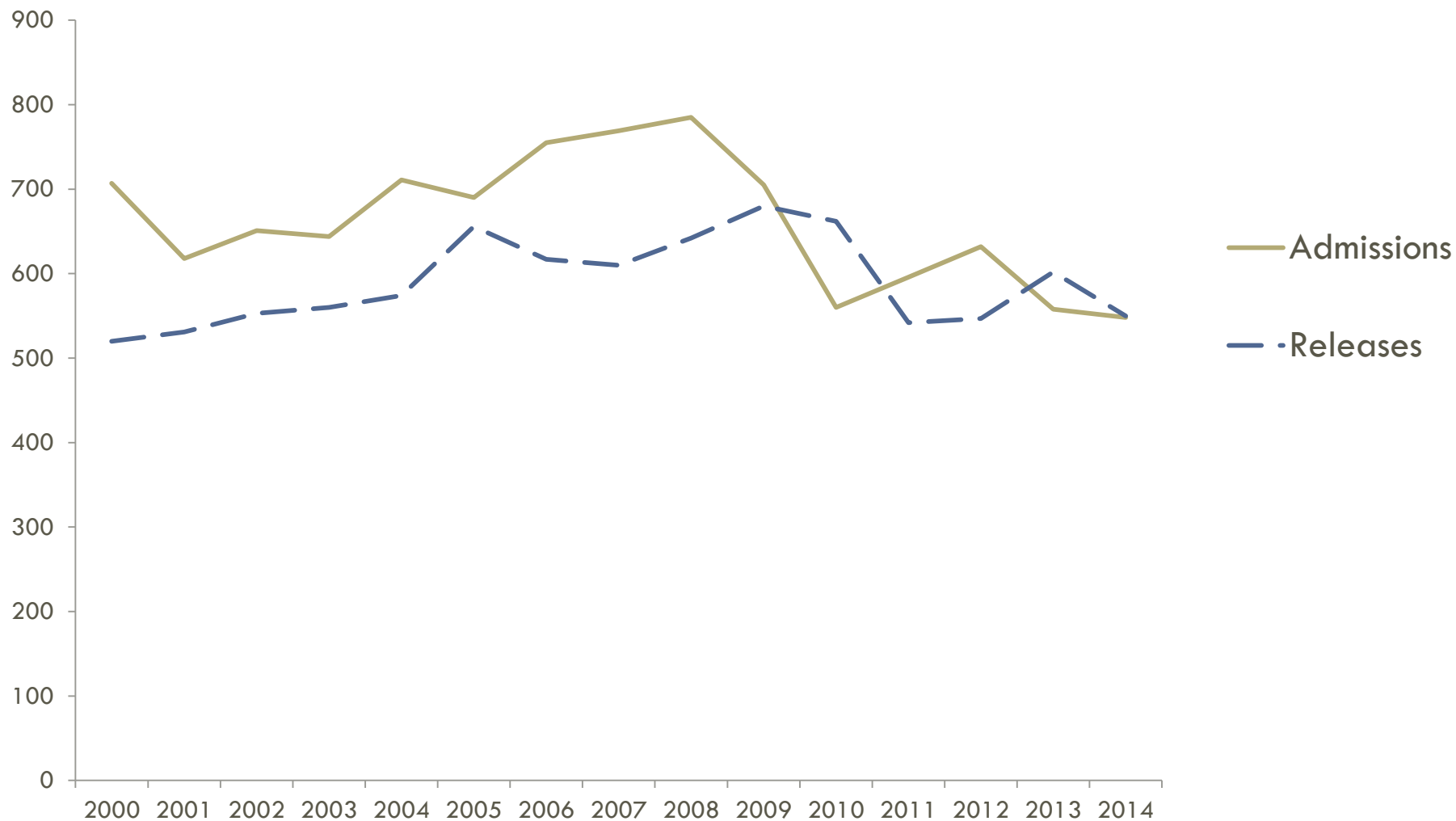

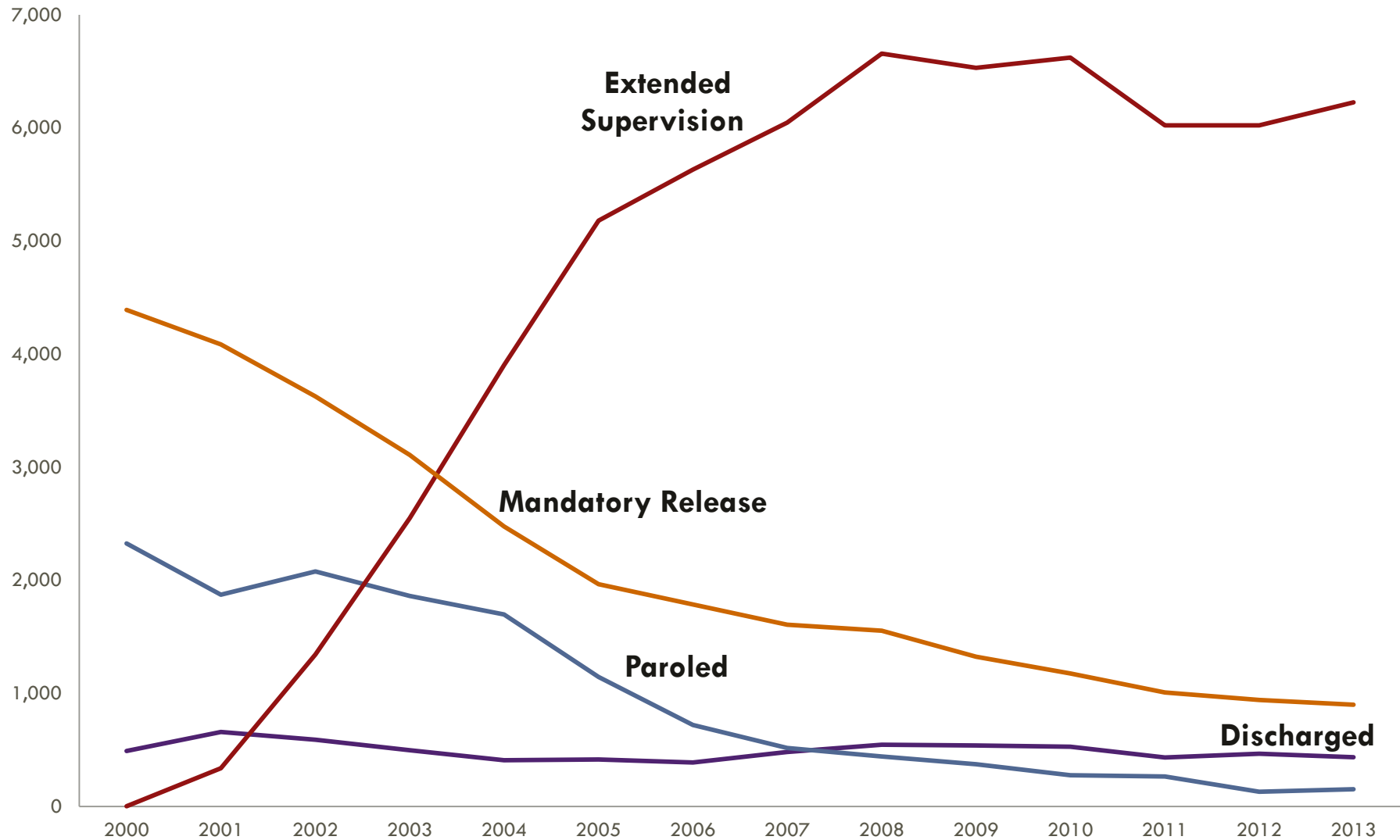

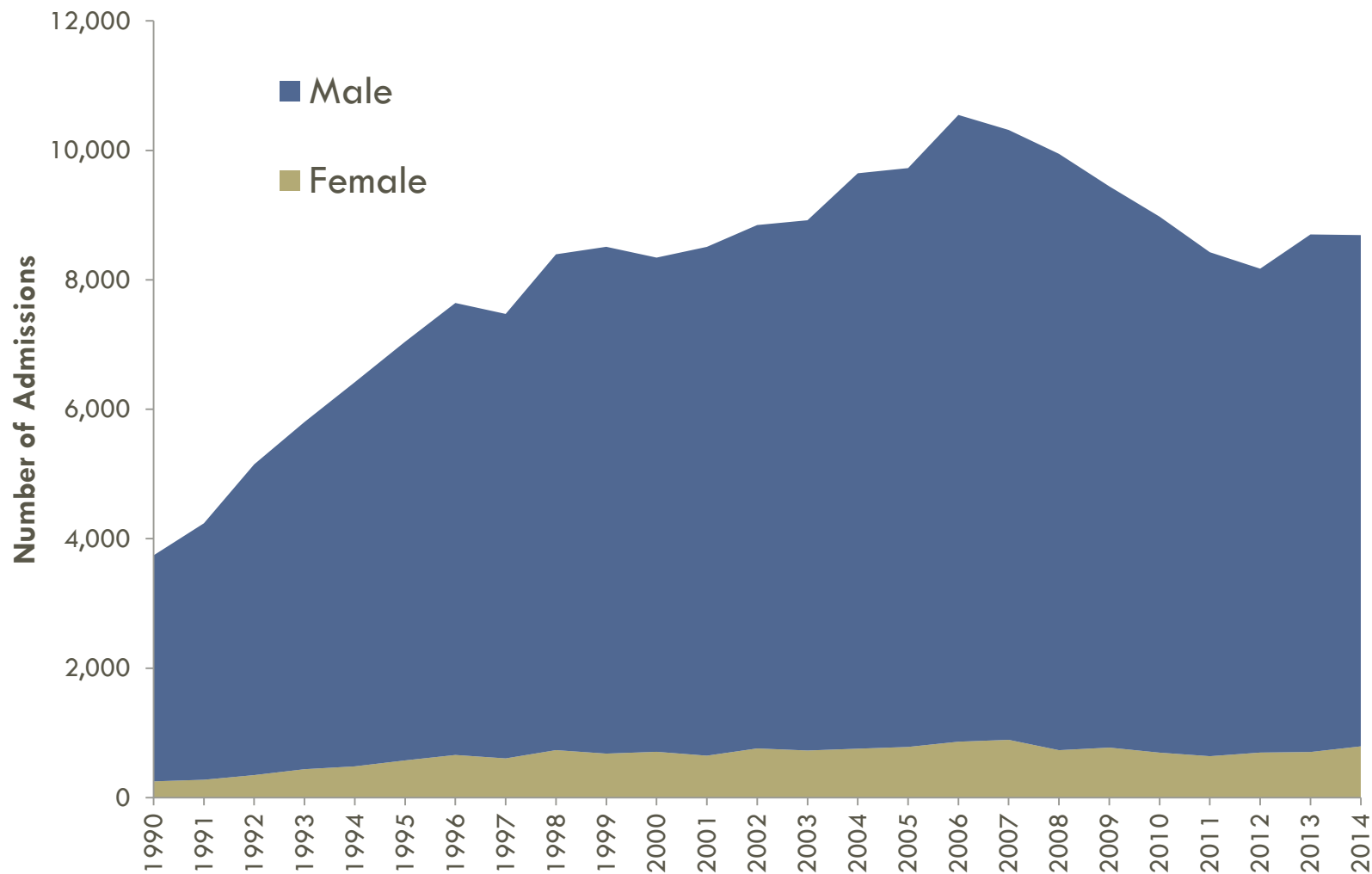
Prison Releases by Release Type

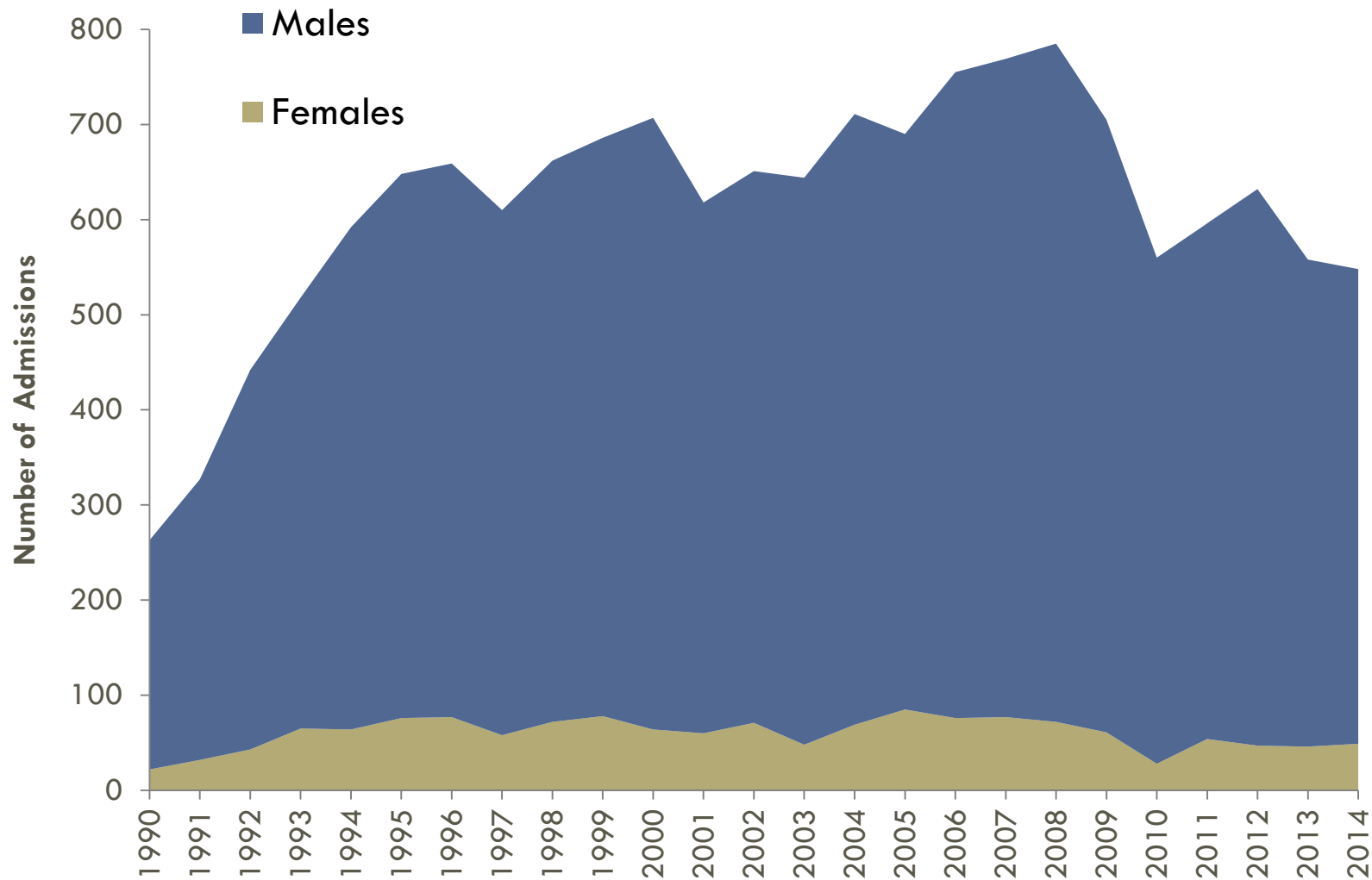

Prison Admissions by Gender Statewide



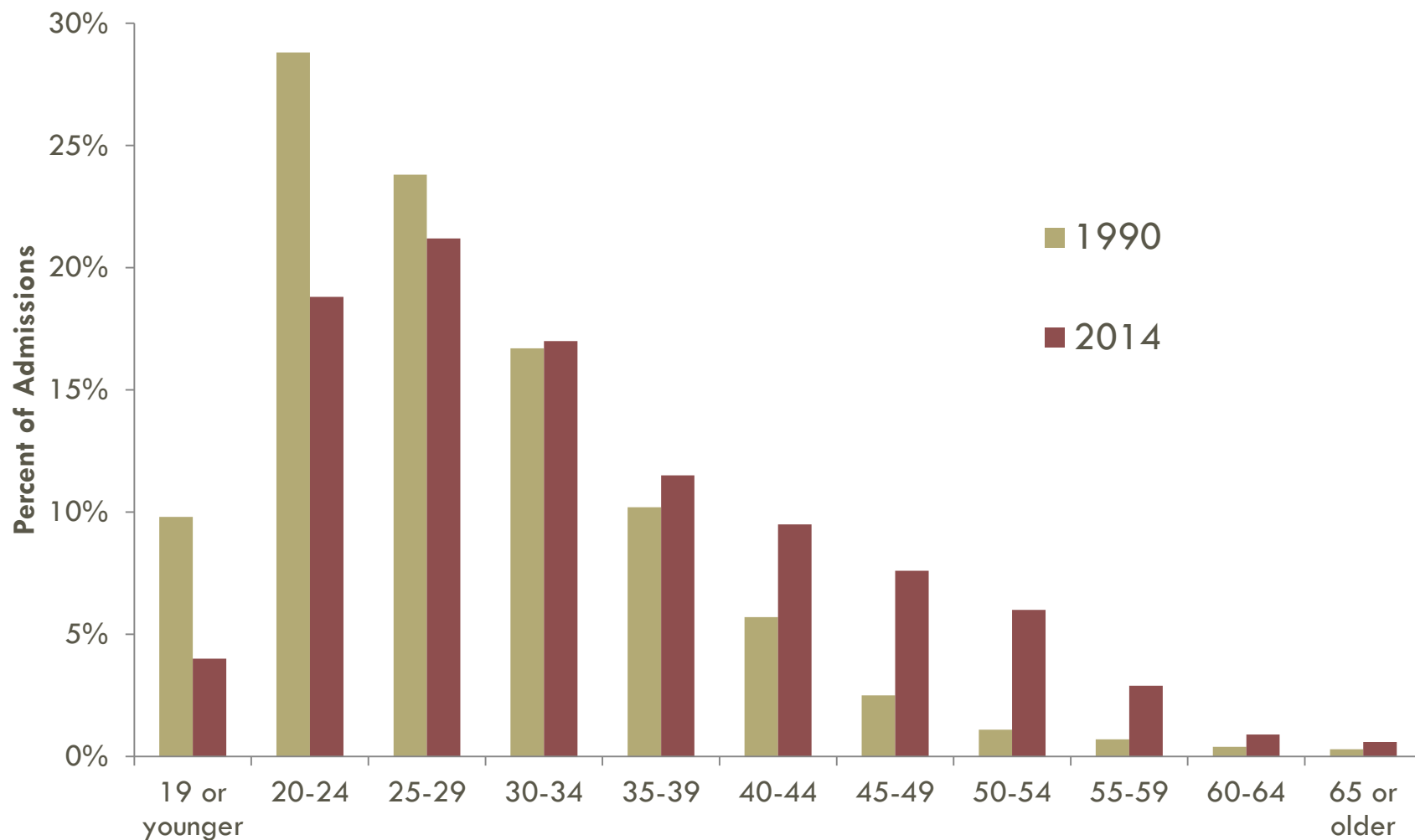

Prison Admissions by Gender *Dane*



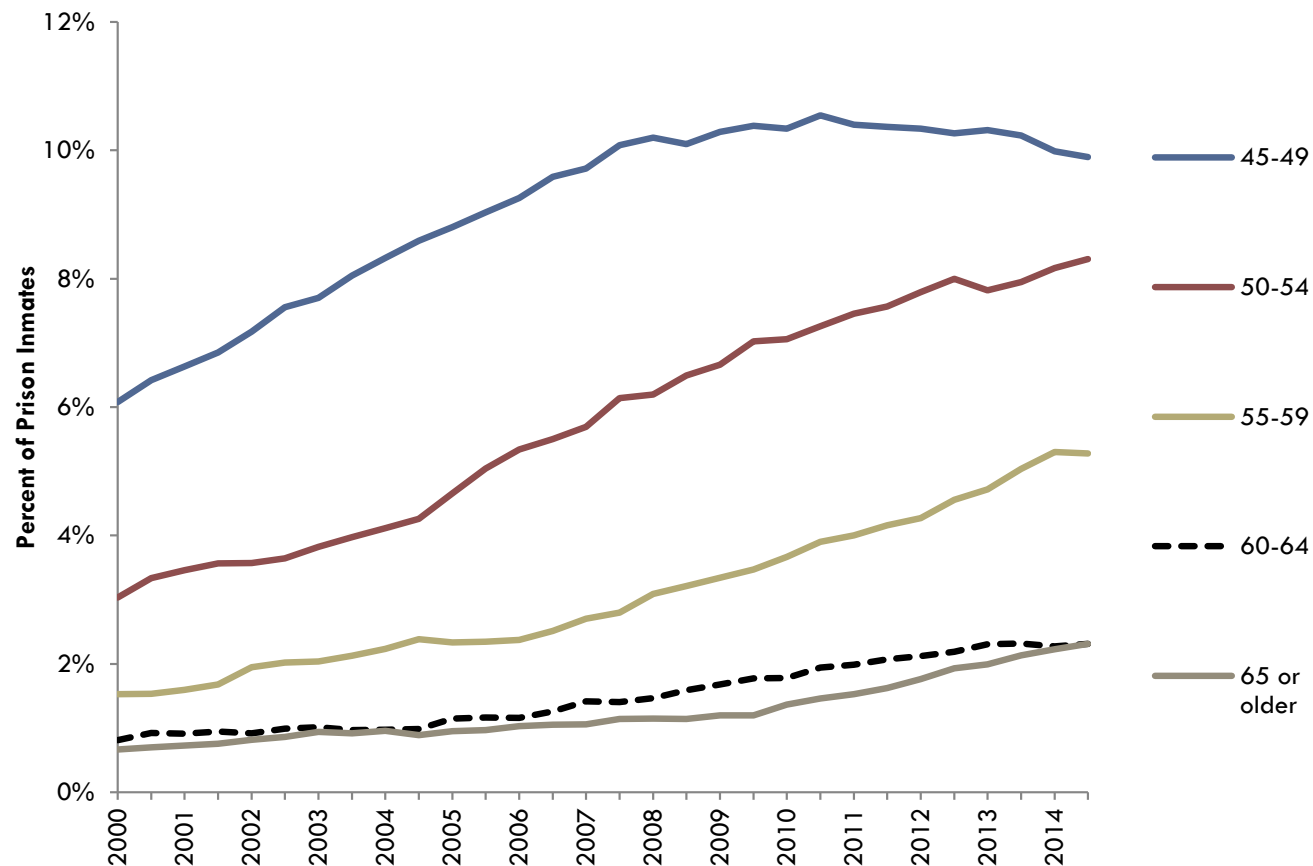

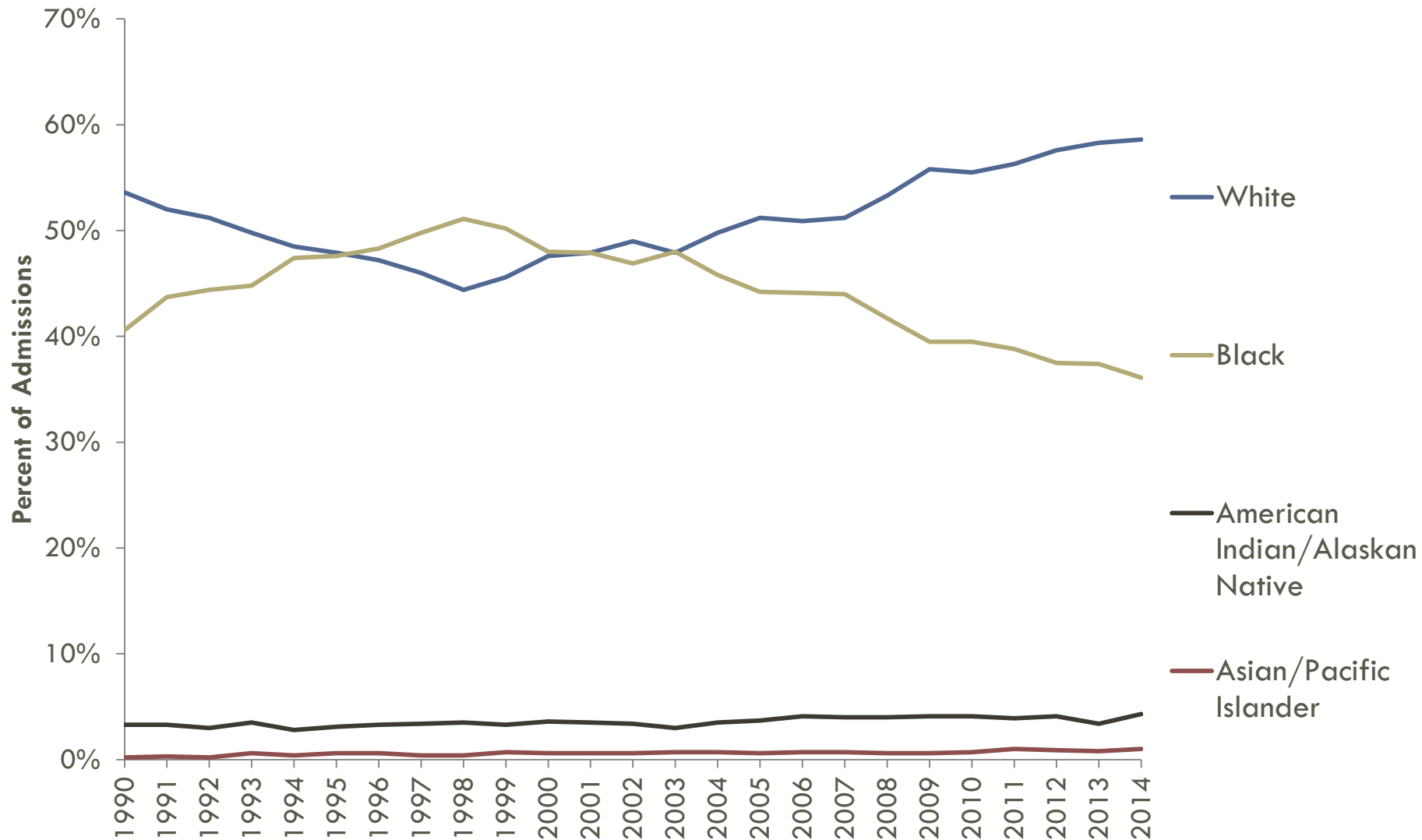

The % of inmates **45 and older** more than **doubled** from 2000 to 2014, increasing from **12.1%** to **27.9%** of the total prison population.

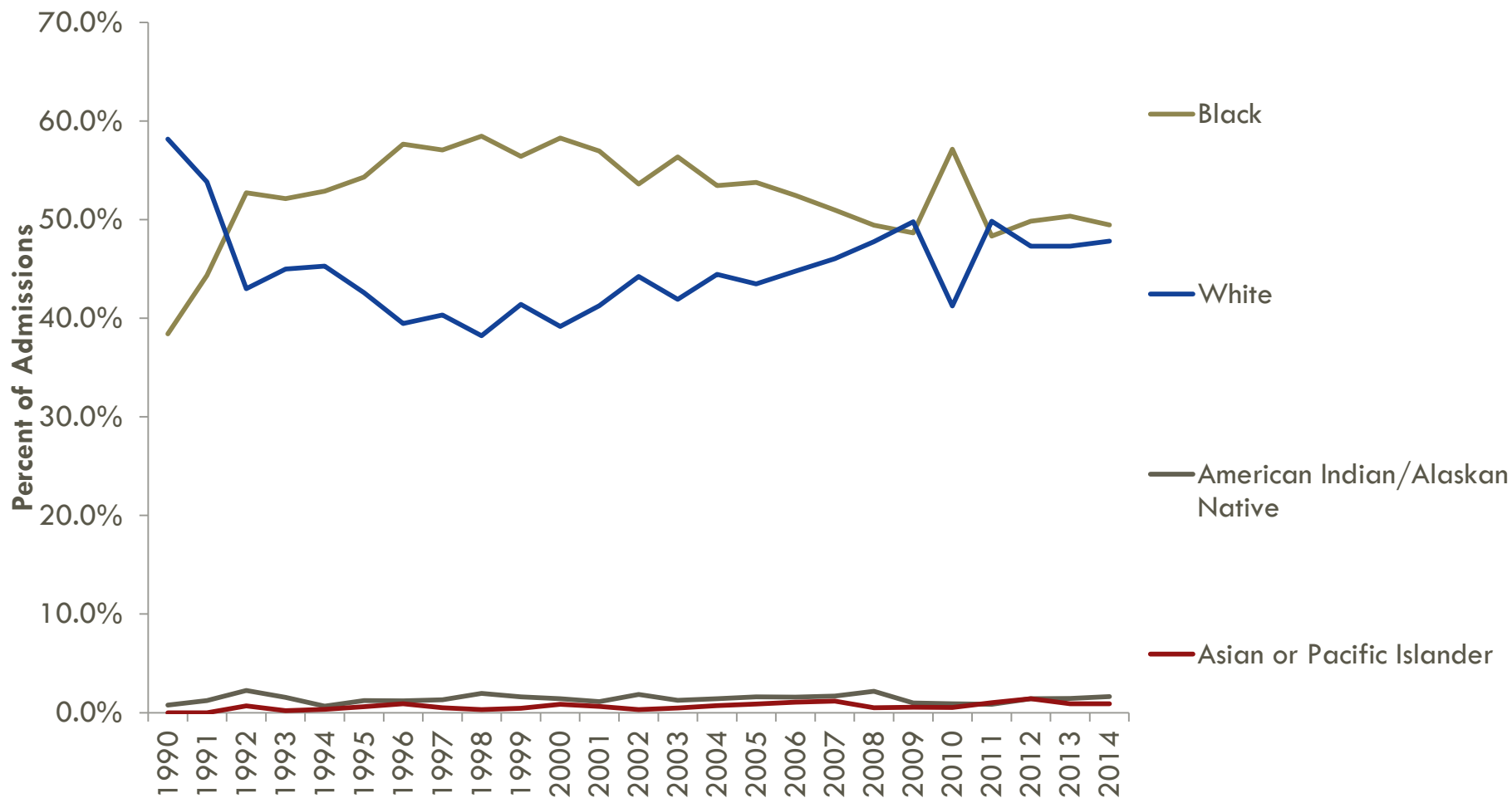
Prison Admissions by Race Statewide

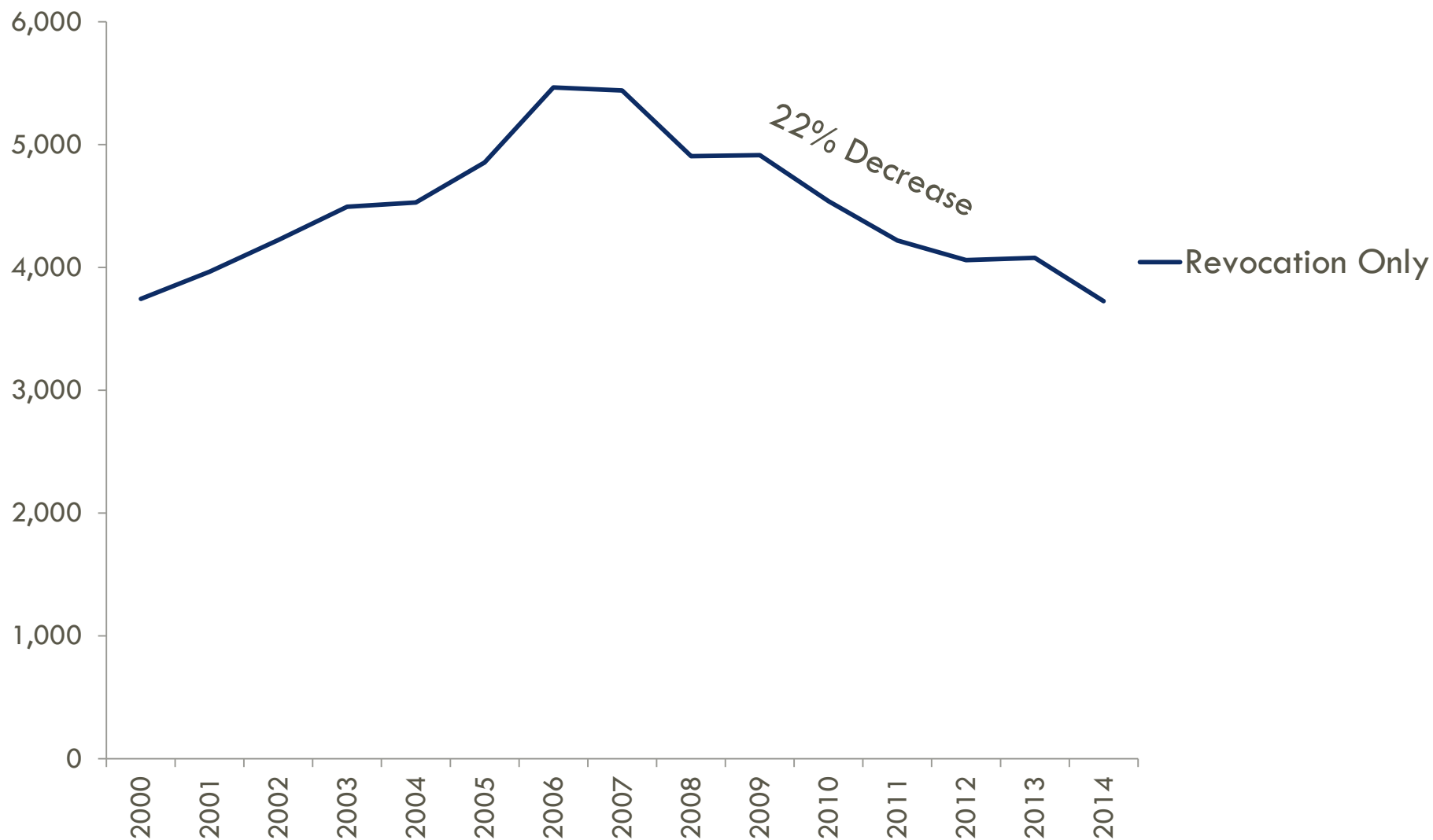

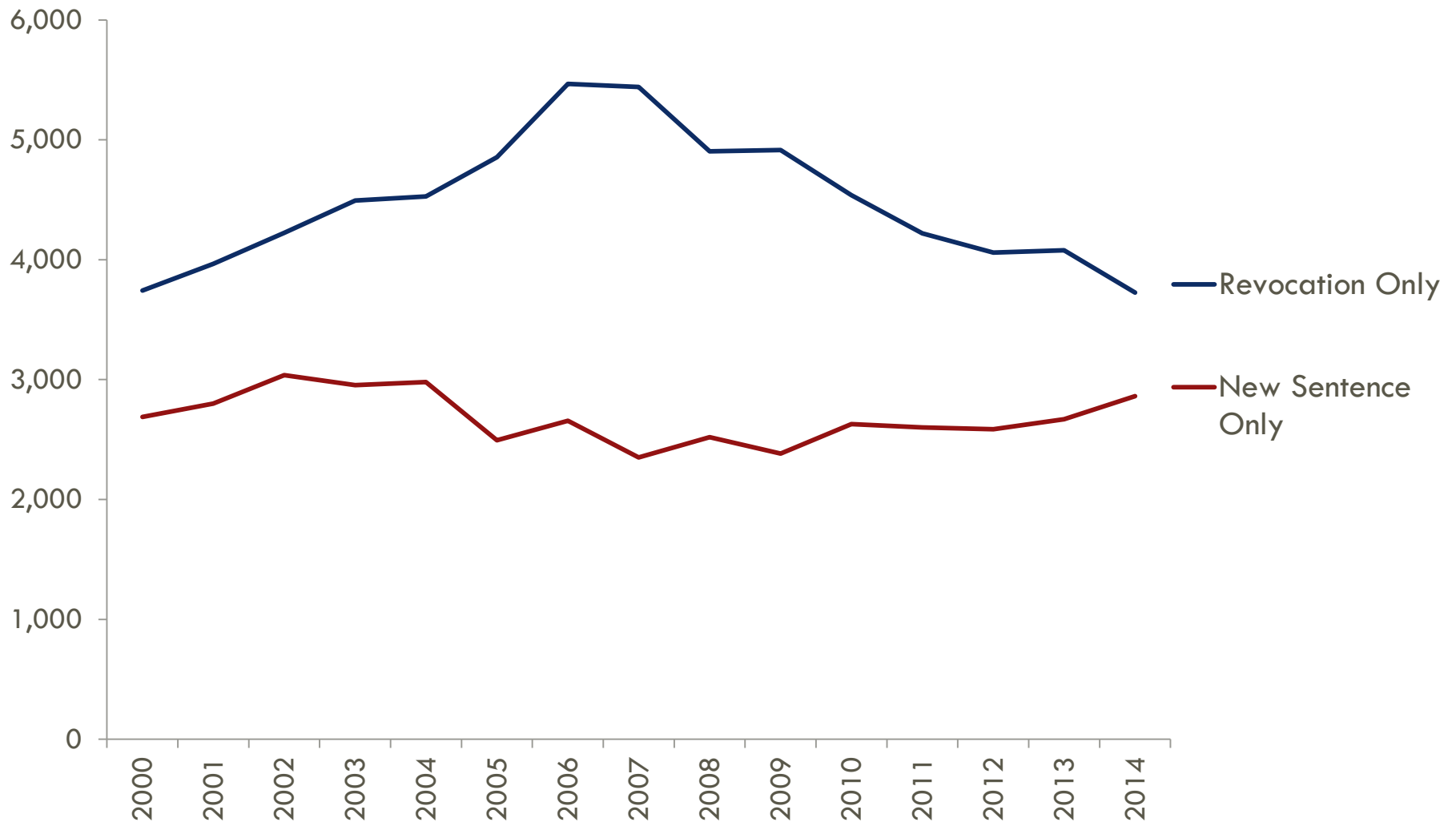
Prison Admissions by Admission Type Statewide

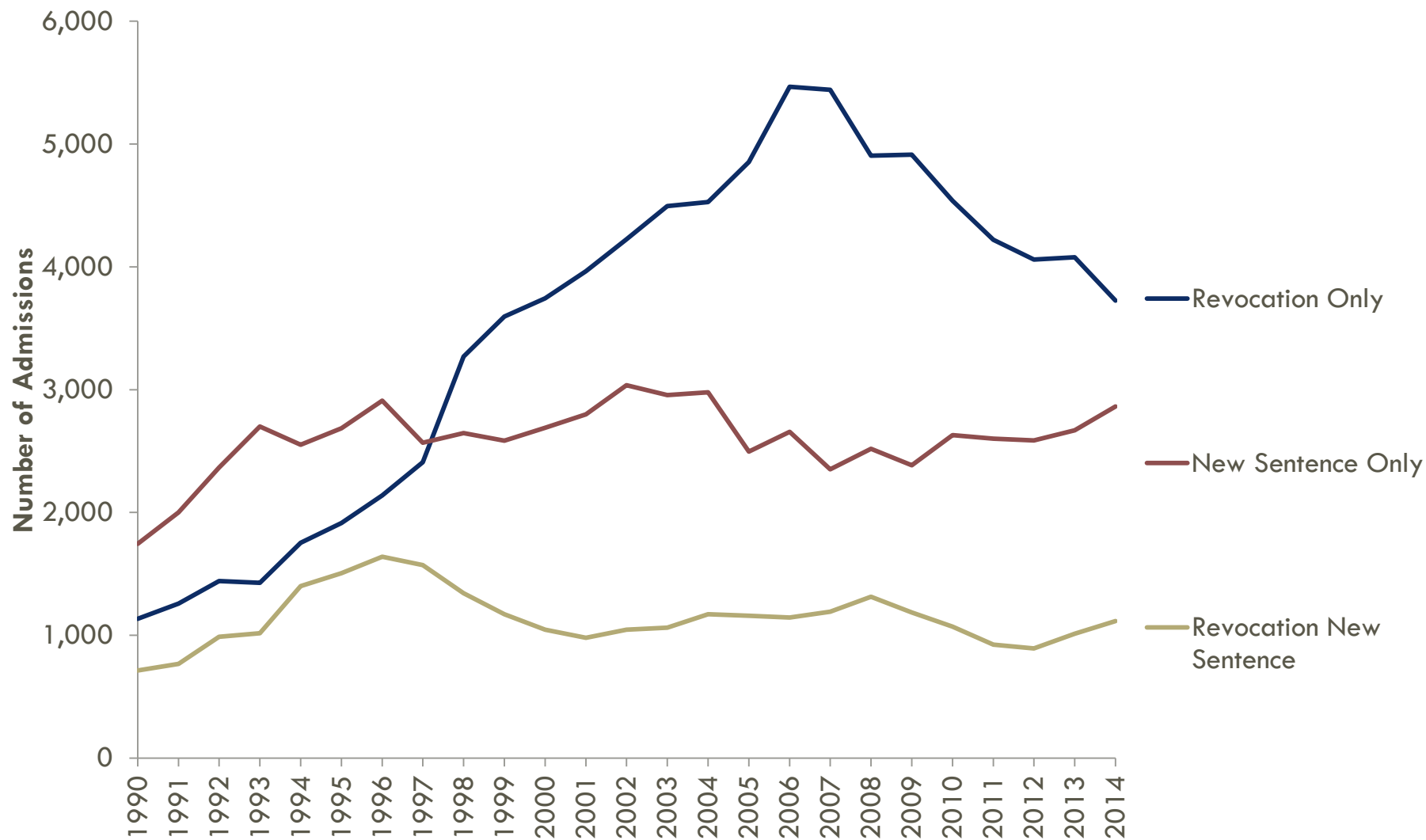

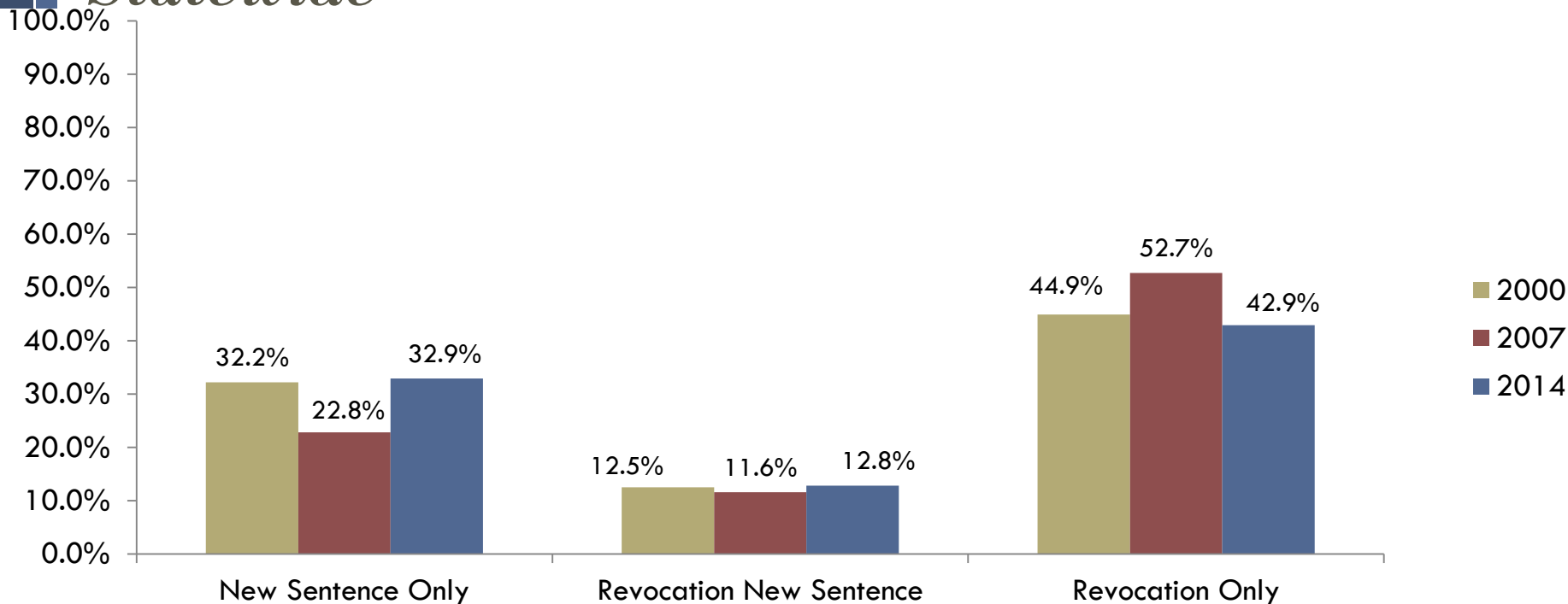


Prison Admissions by Admission Type Statewide

Proportion of Prison Admissions by Type Statewide



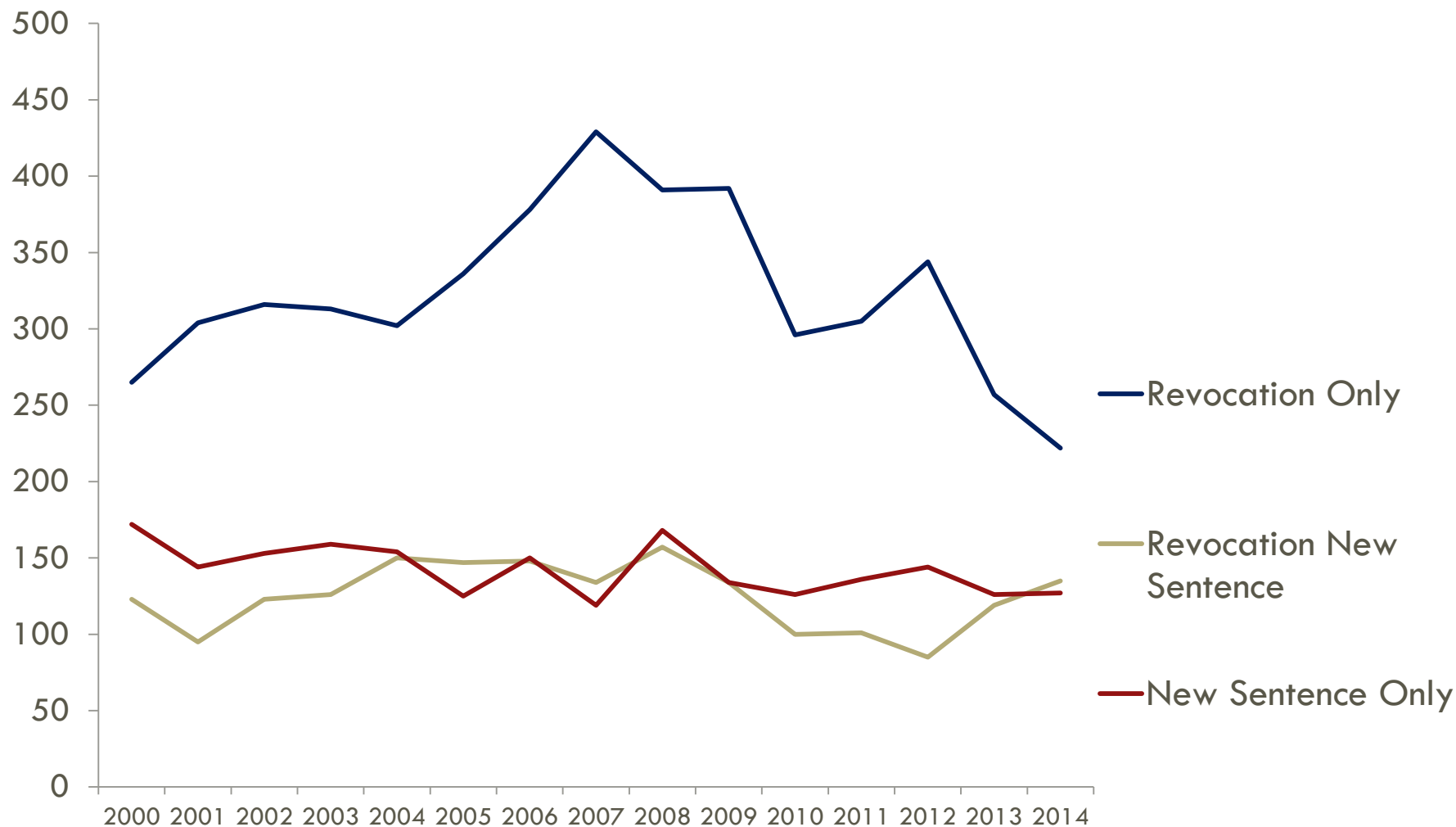

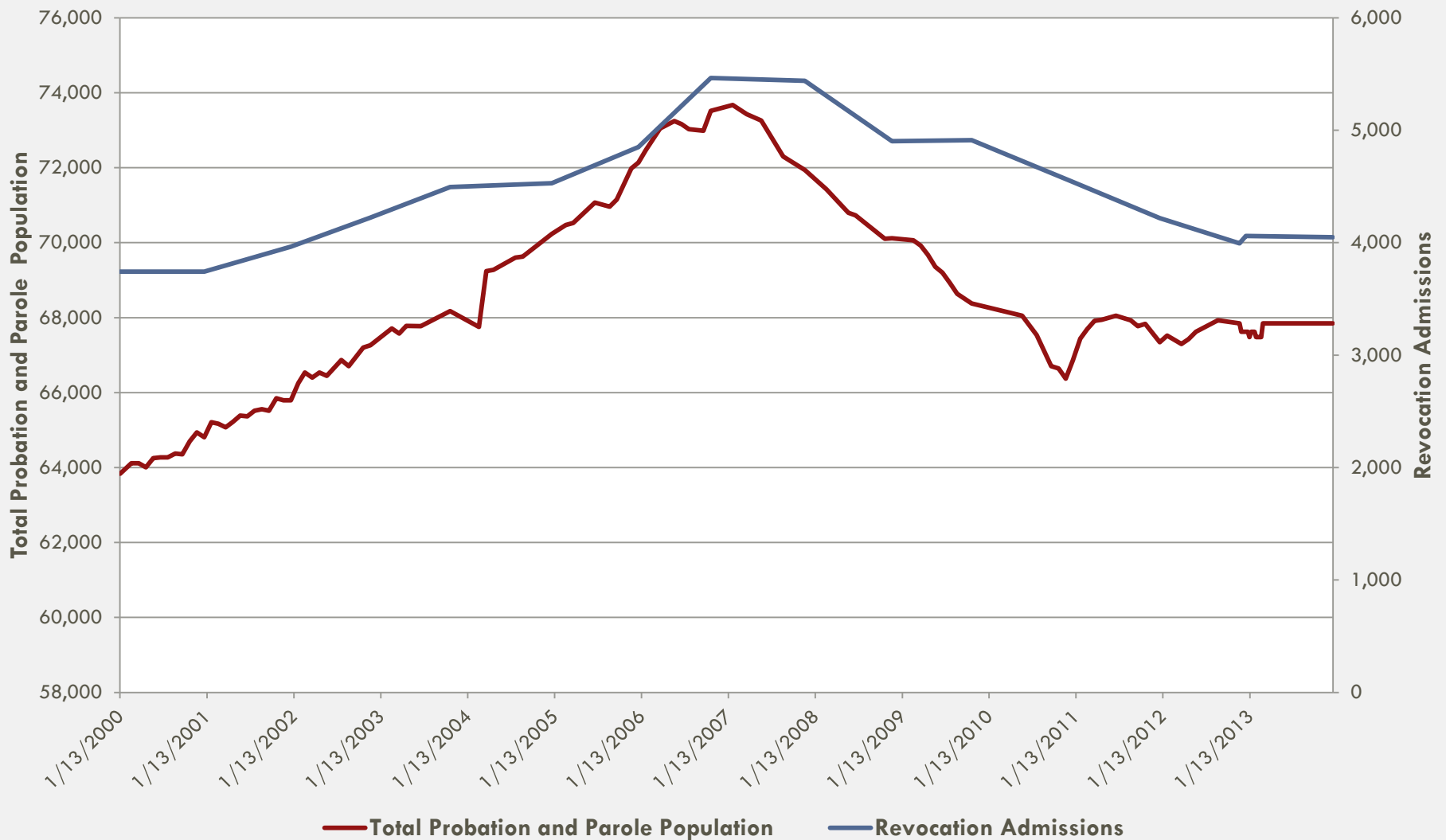

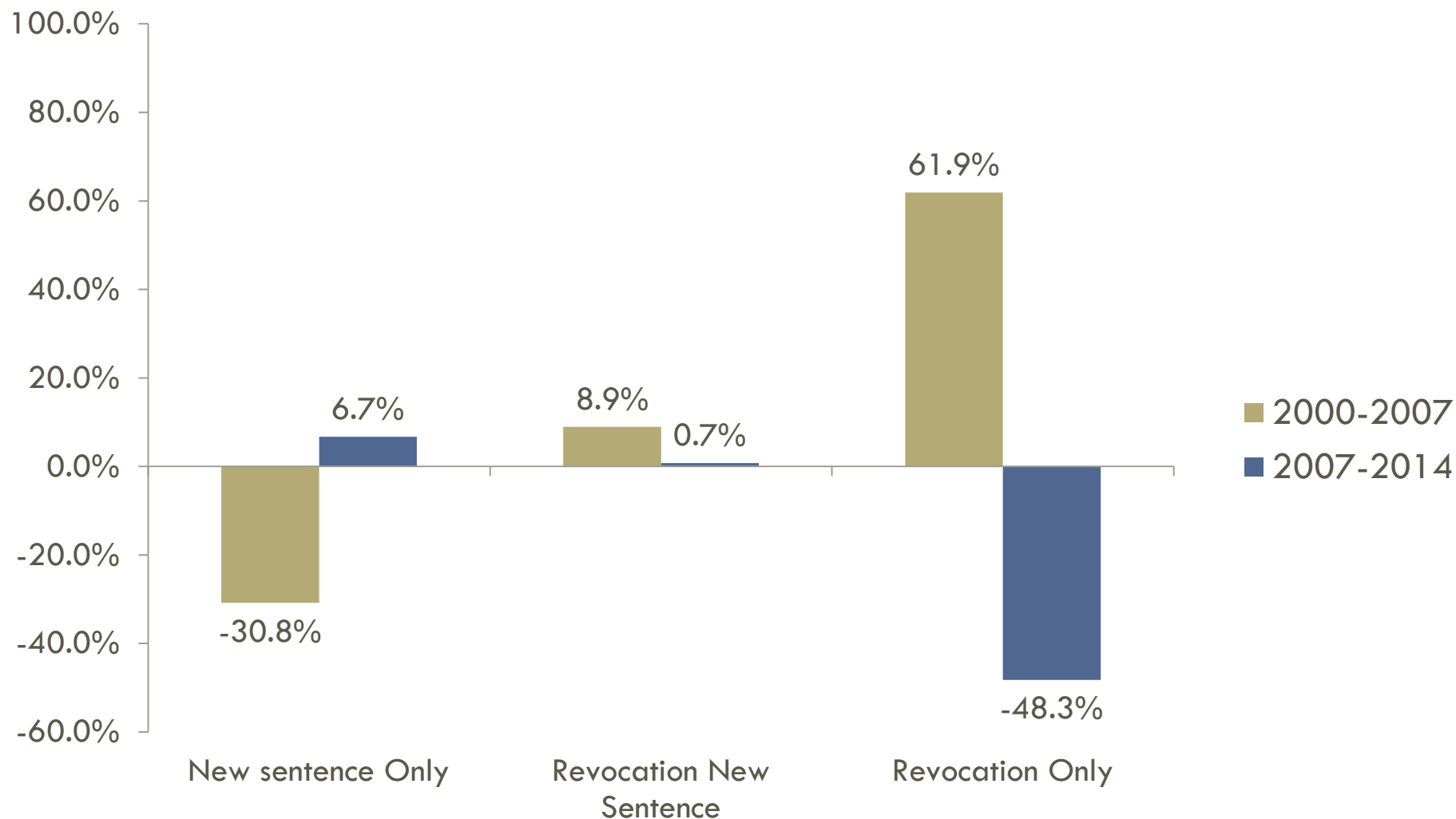

Probation and Parole Population vs. Revocation Only Prison Admissions



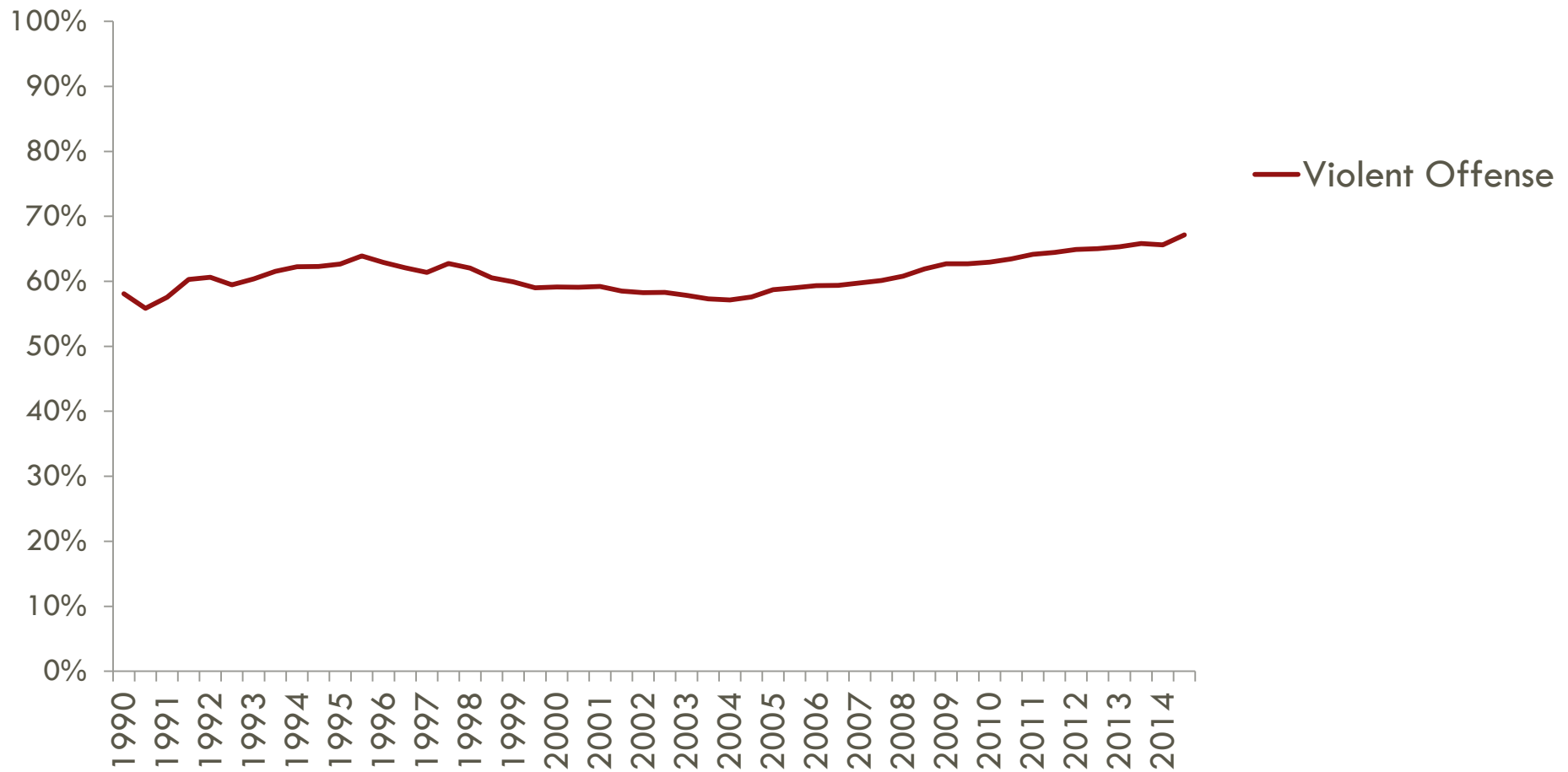


Percent Change in Admissions to Prison Dane



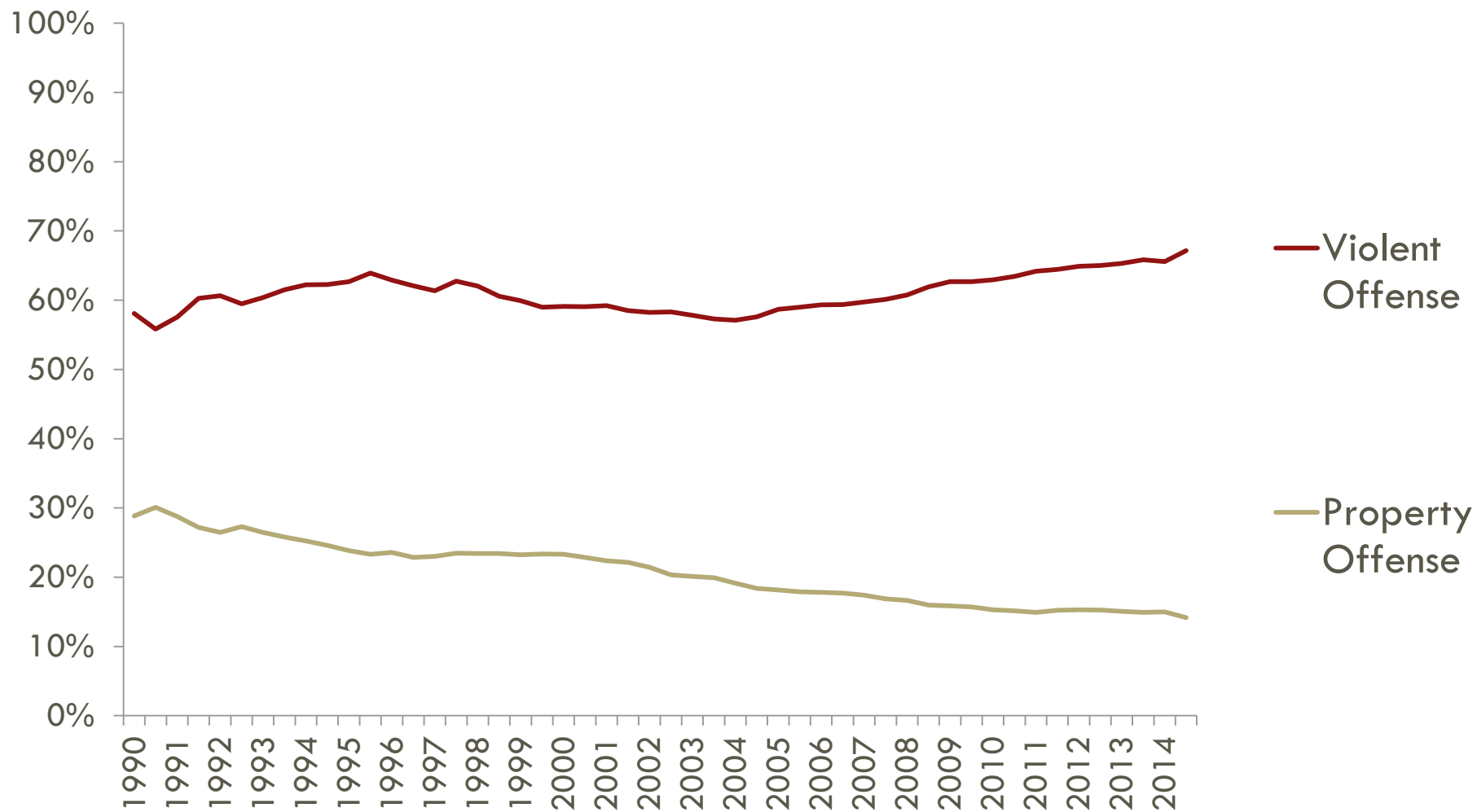

Most Serious Offense – Statewide



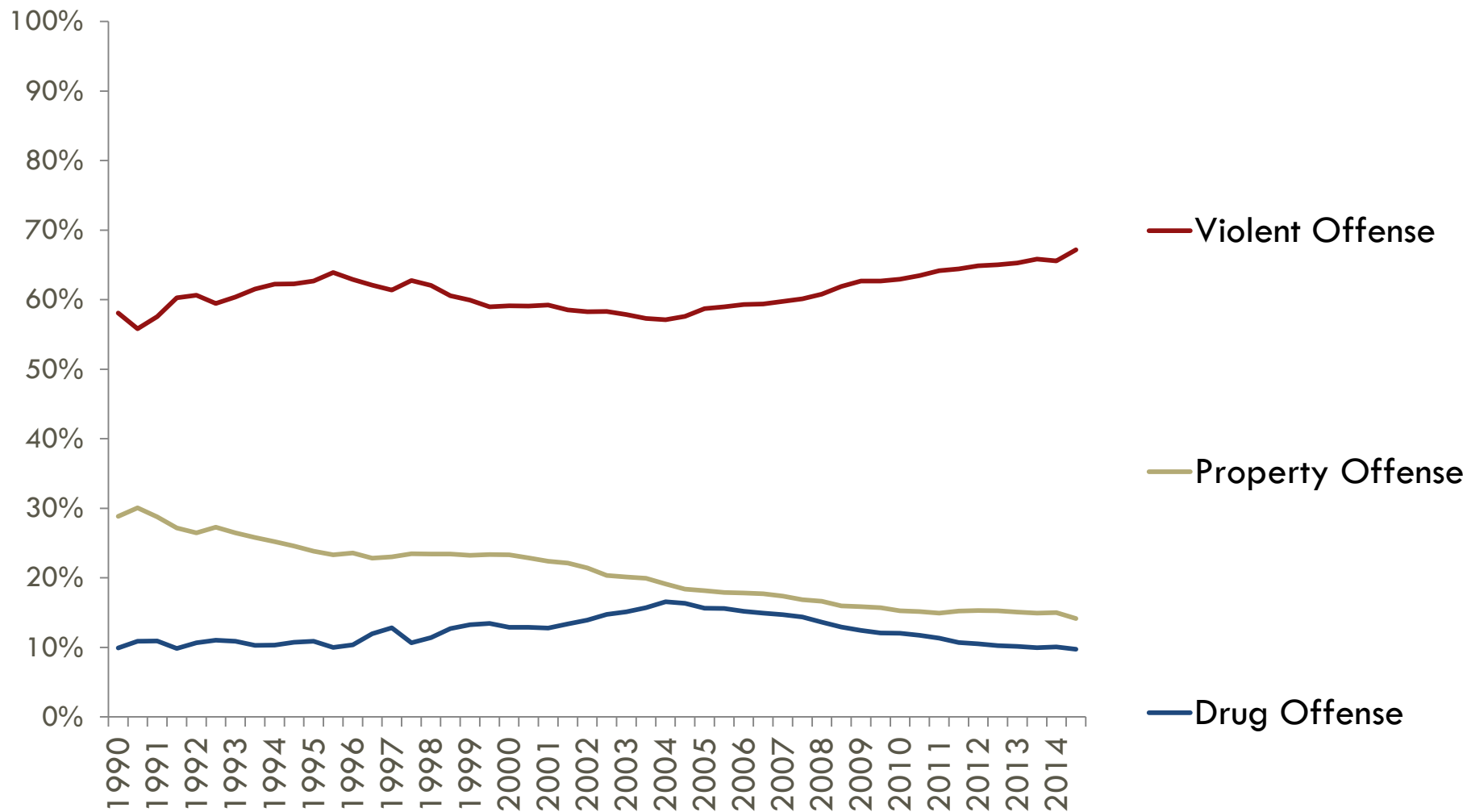

Most Serious Offense -- Statewide



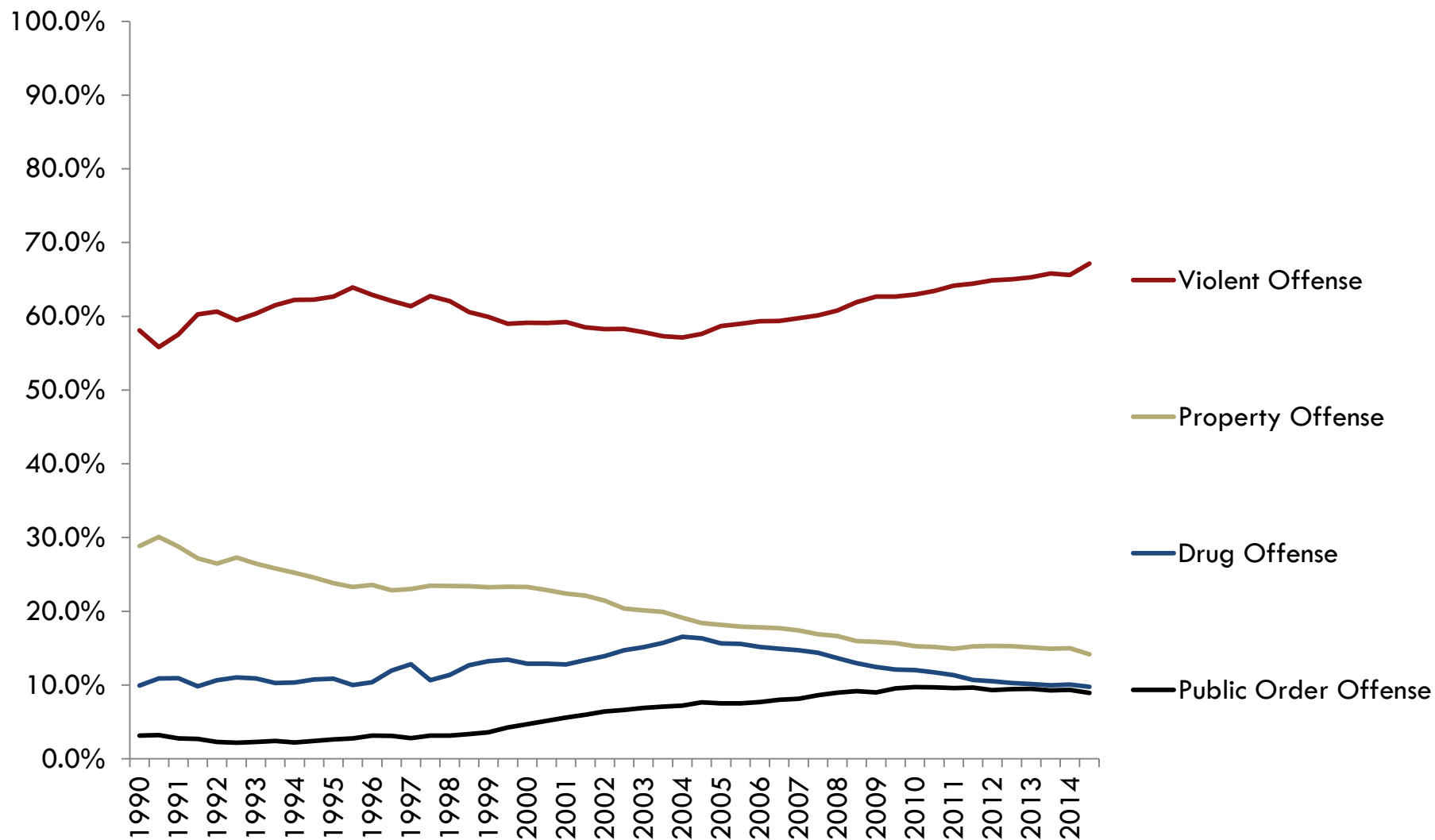

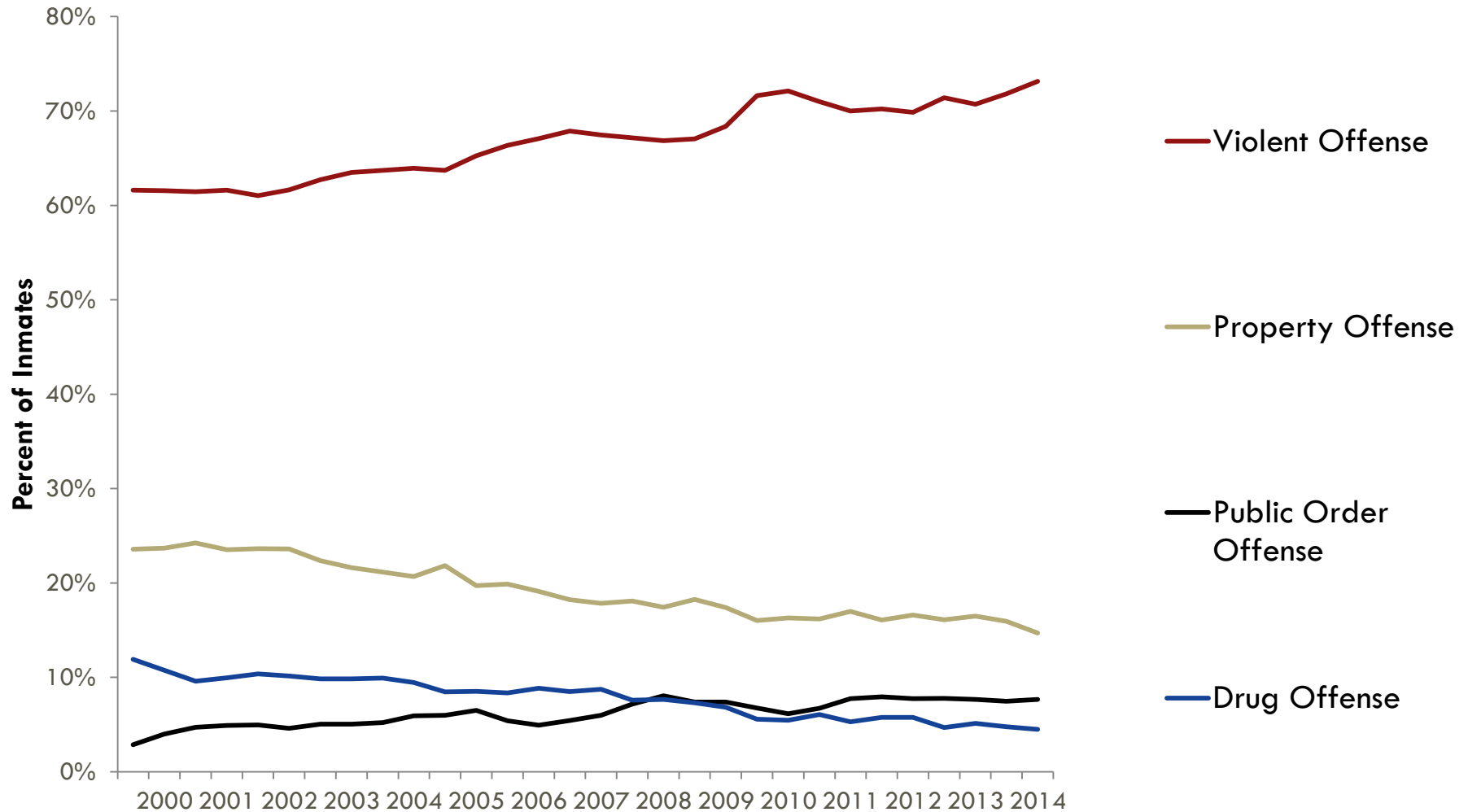

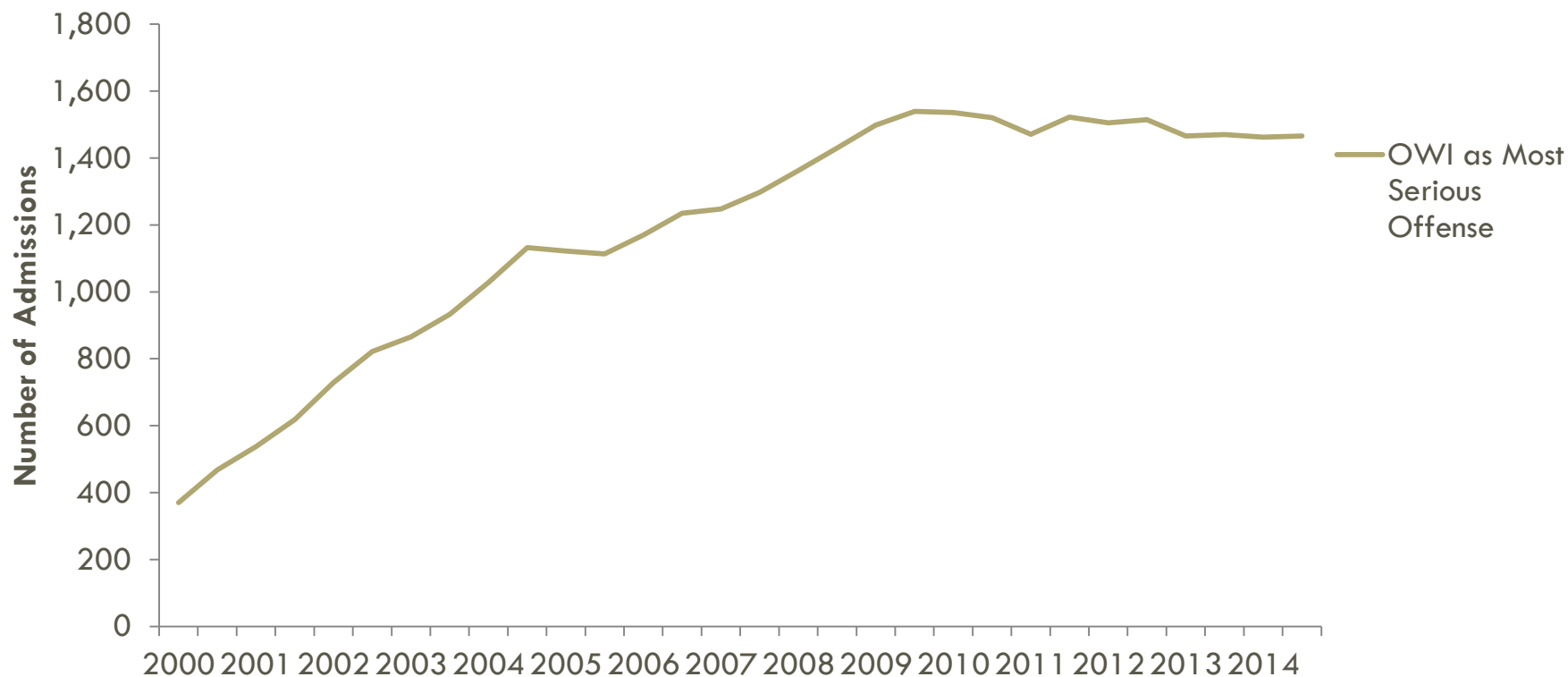

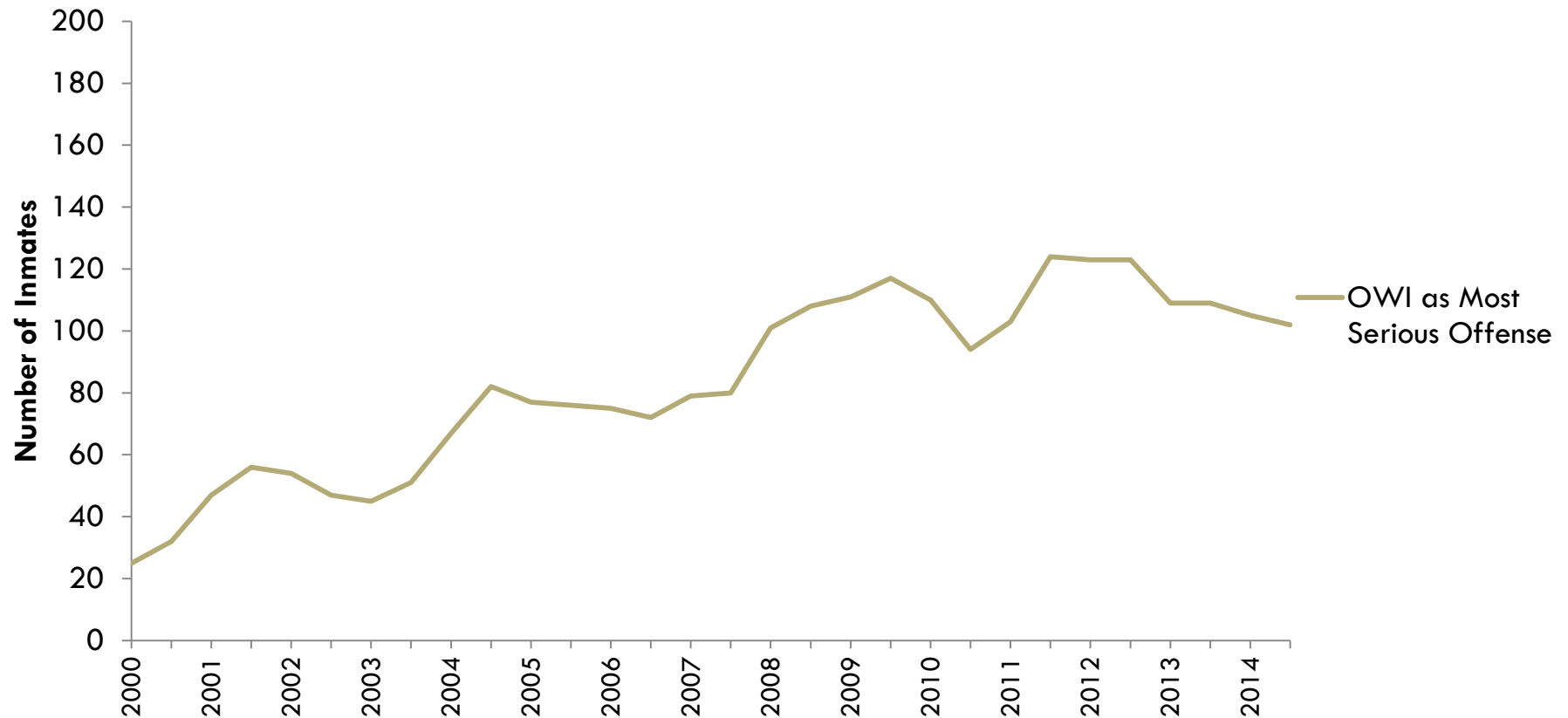
Percent Change in OWI as Most Serious Offense

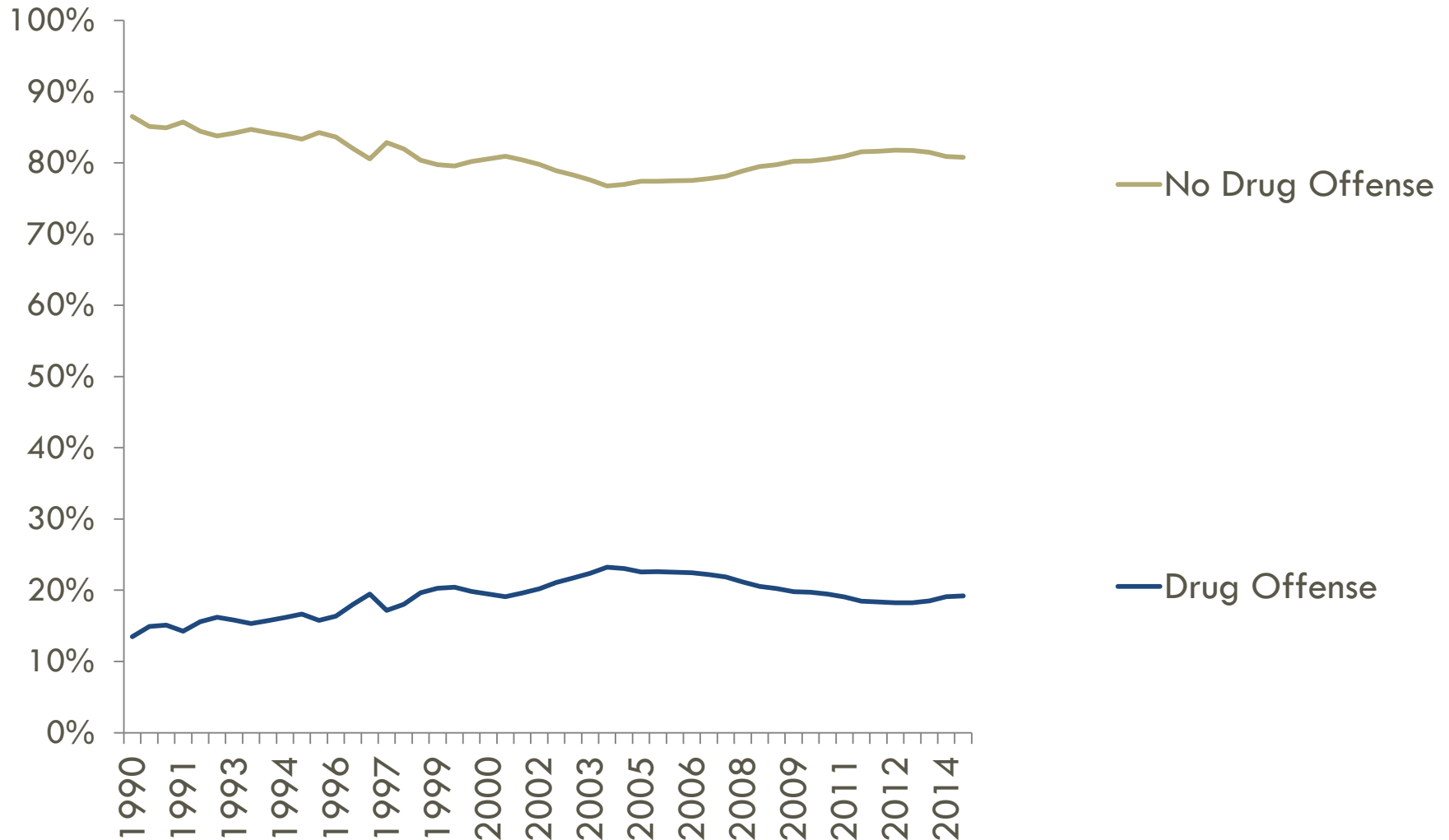

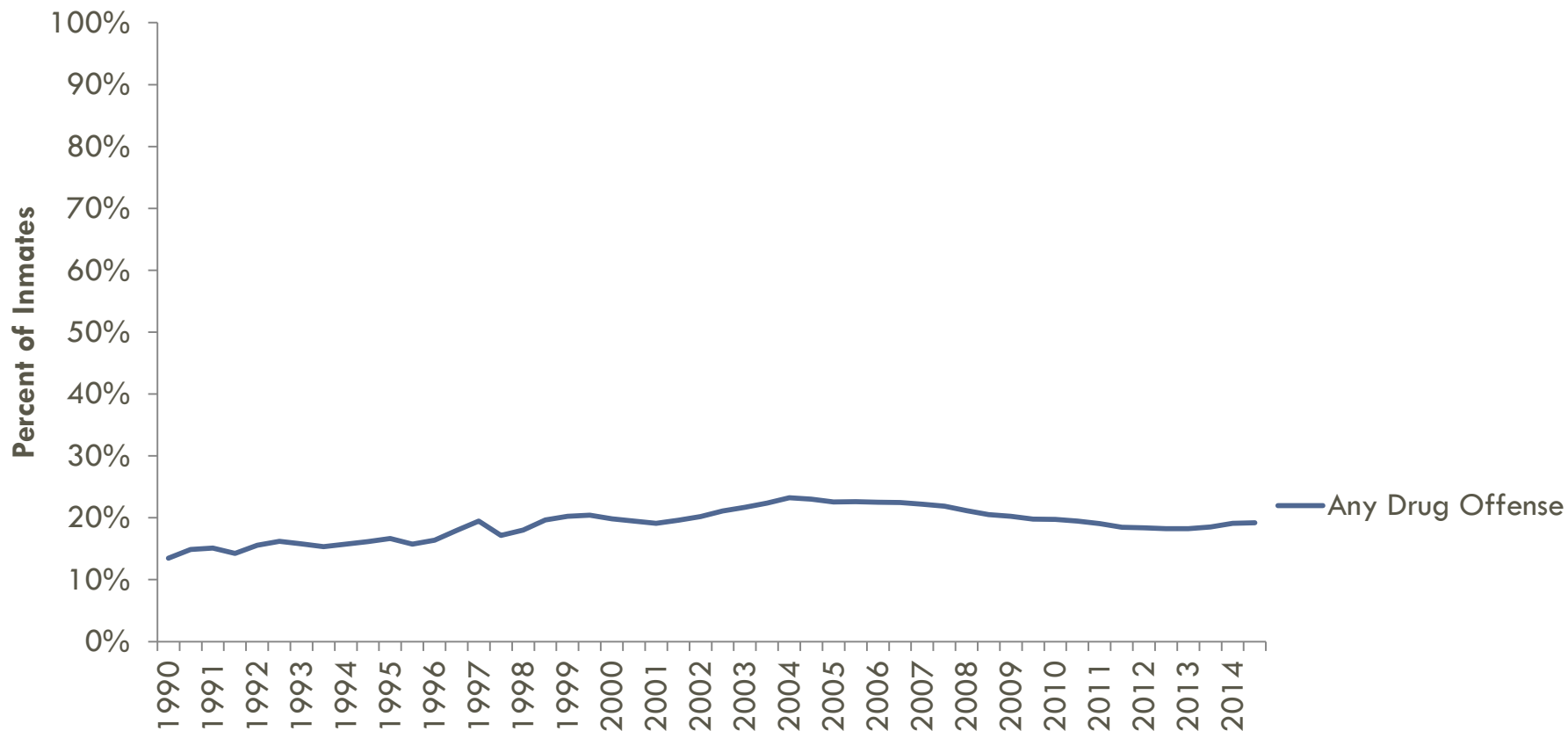

Any Drug Offense vs. No Drug Offense



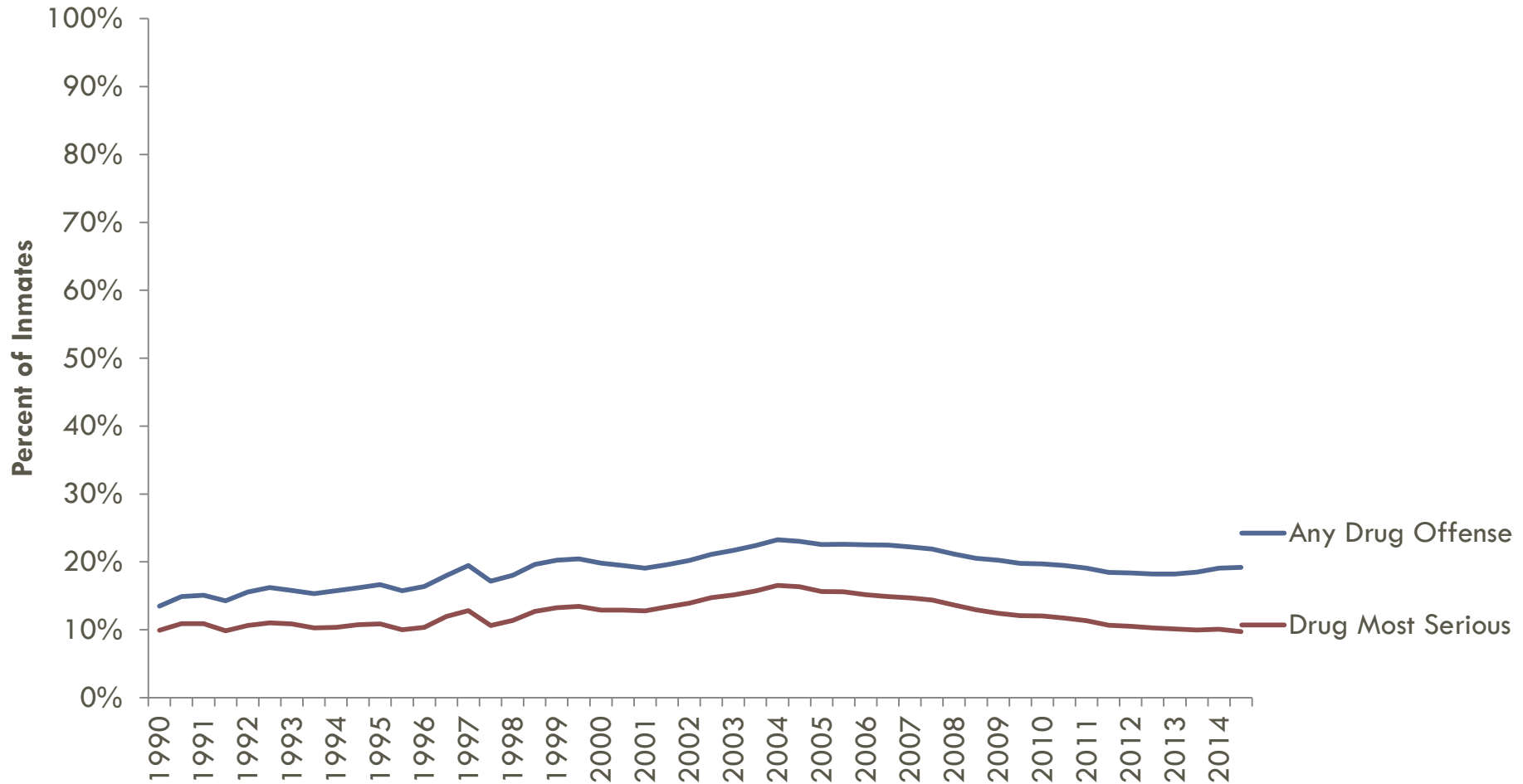

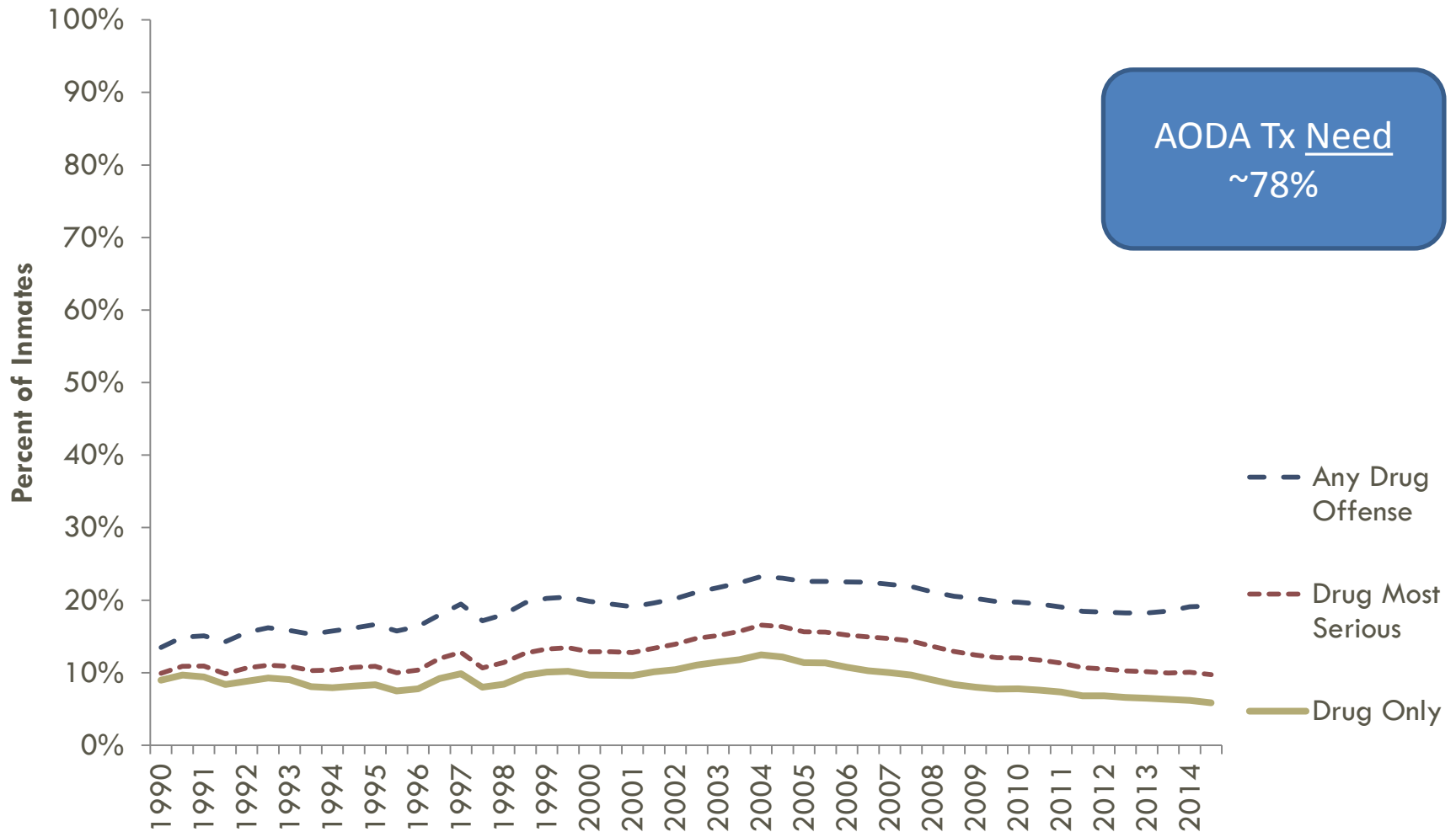

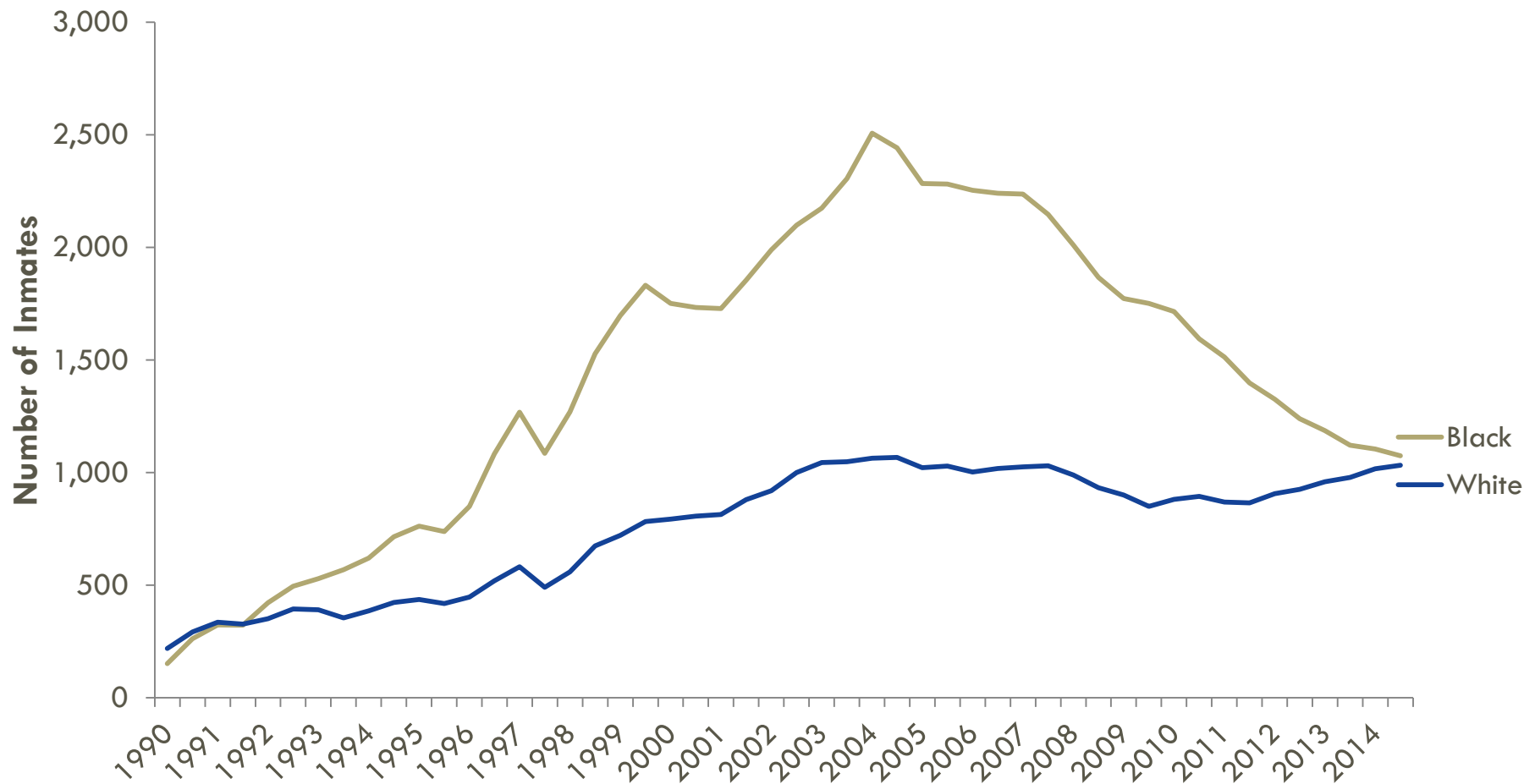

Drug Offense as Most Serious Offense by Race Statewide

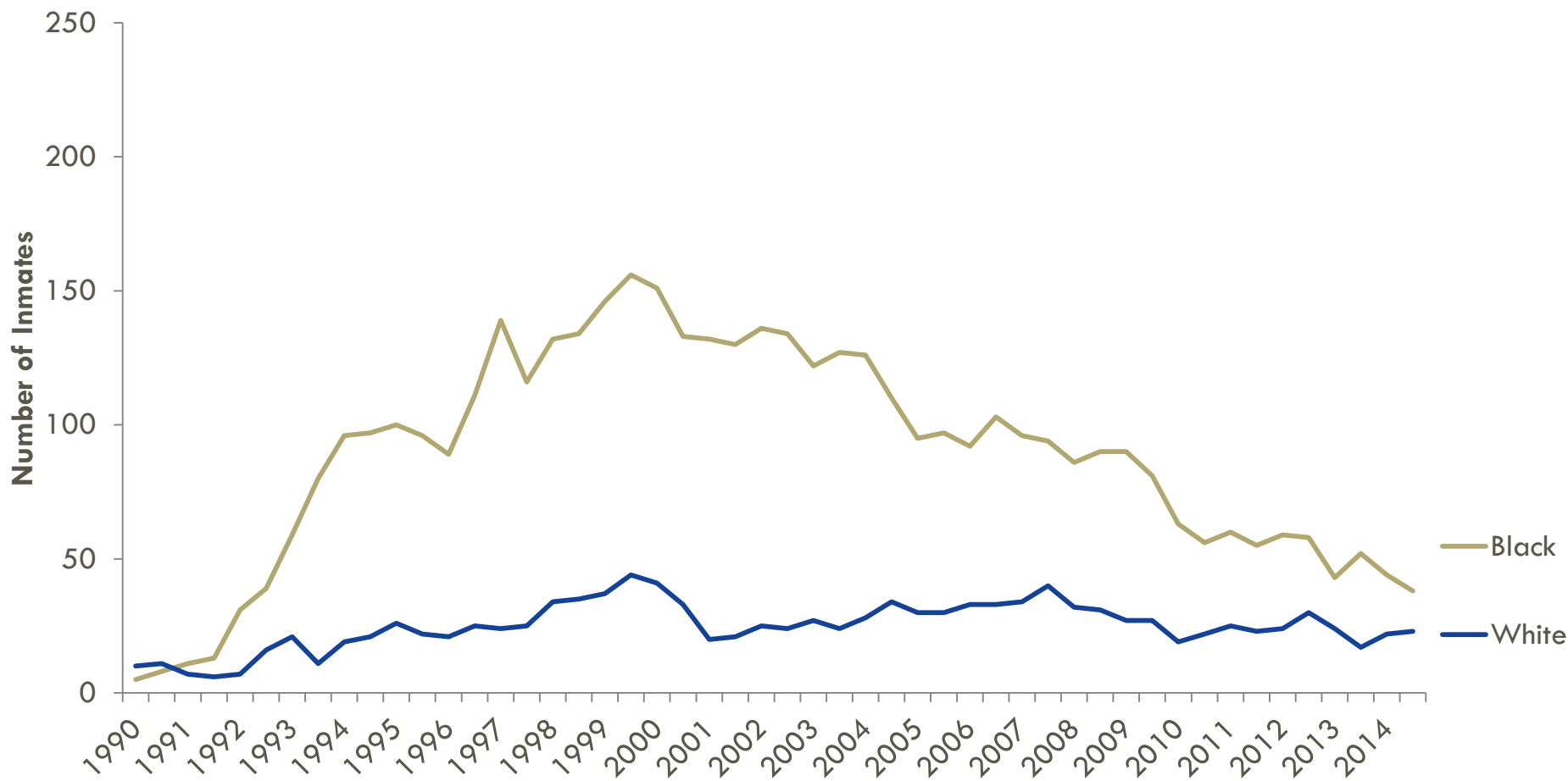

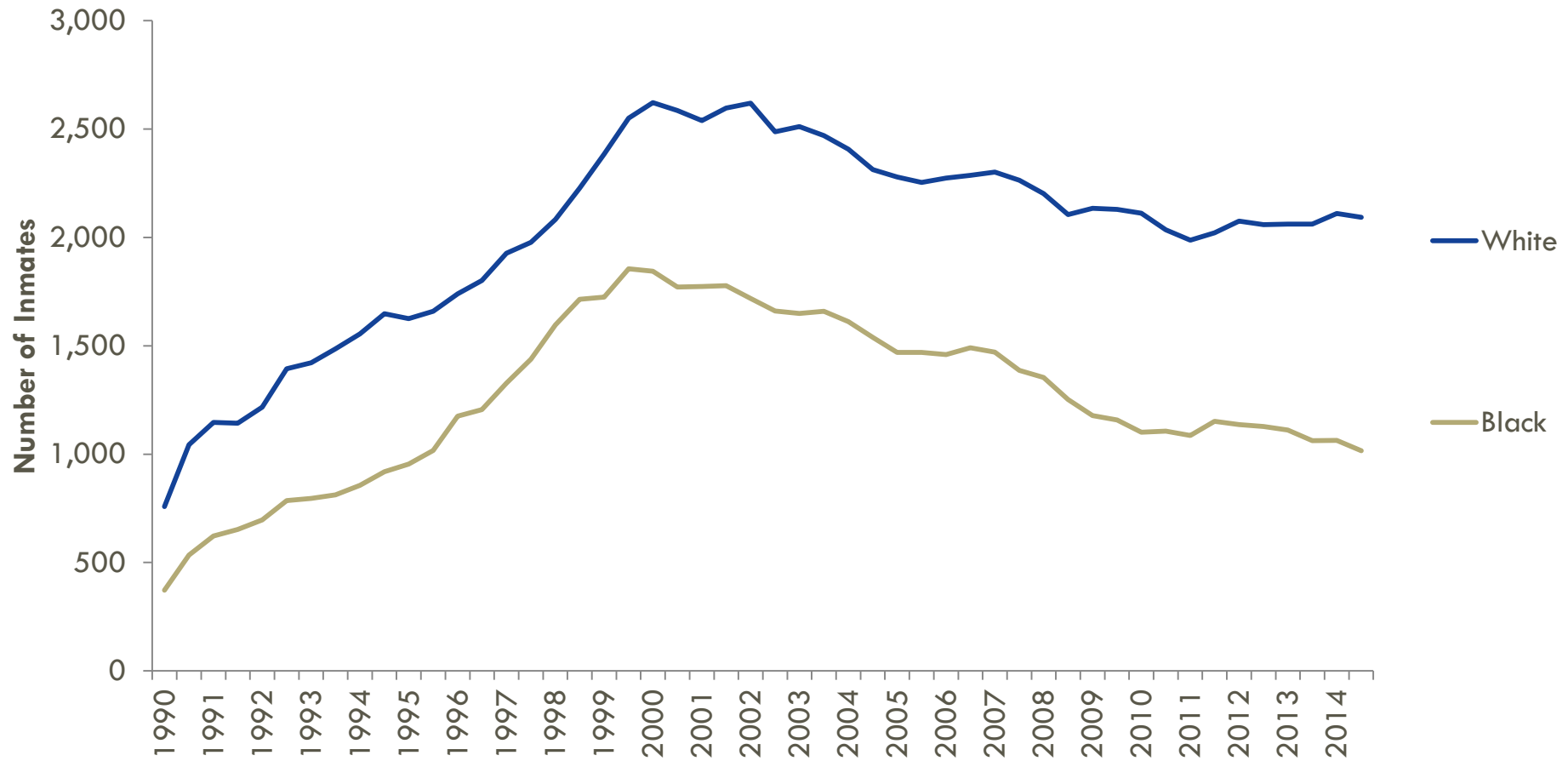
Drug Offense as Most Serious Offense by Race

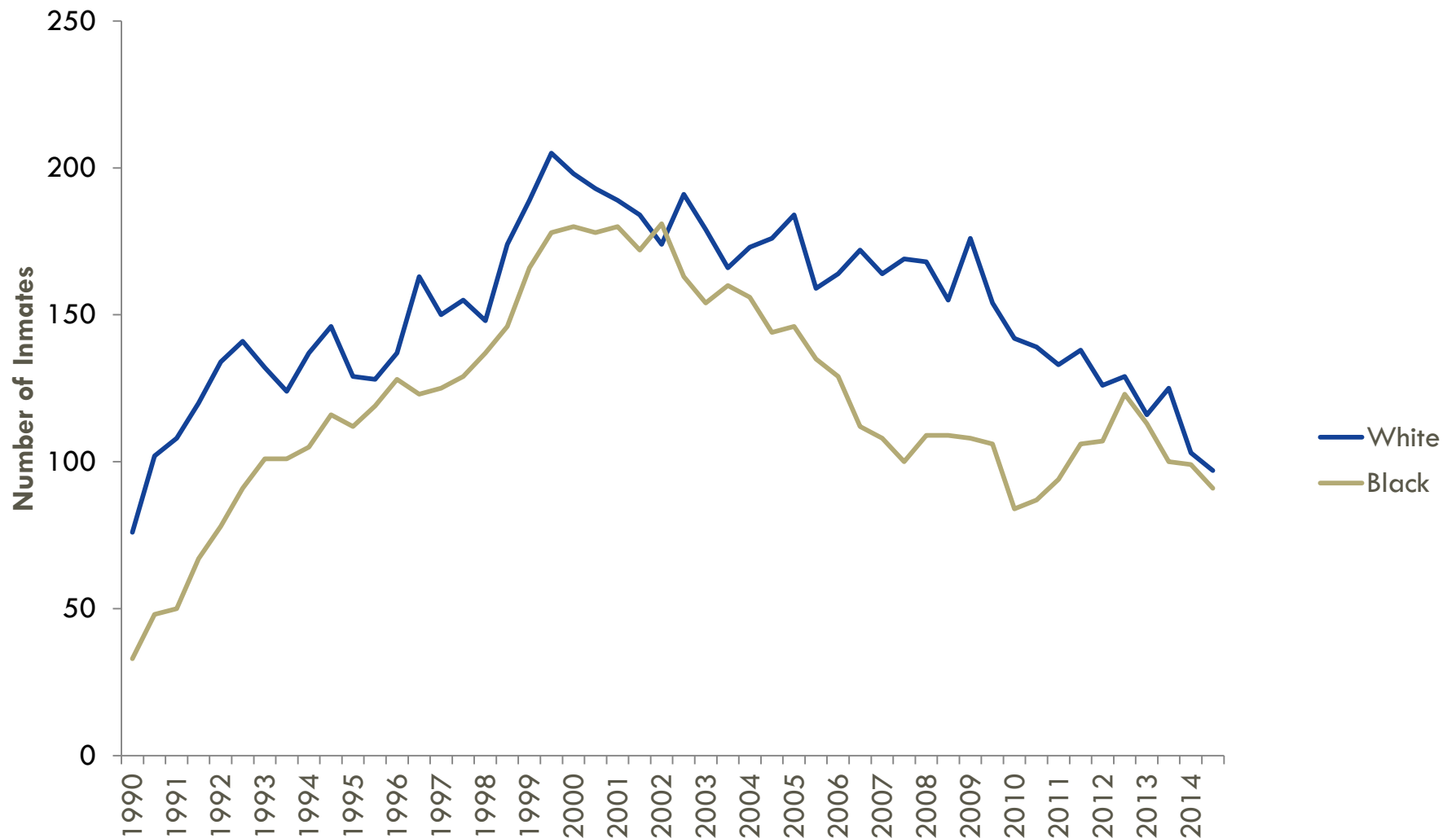
Property Offense as Most Serious Offense by Race Statewide

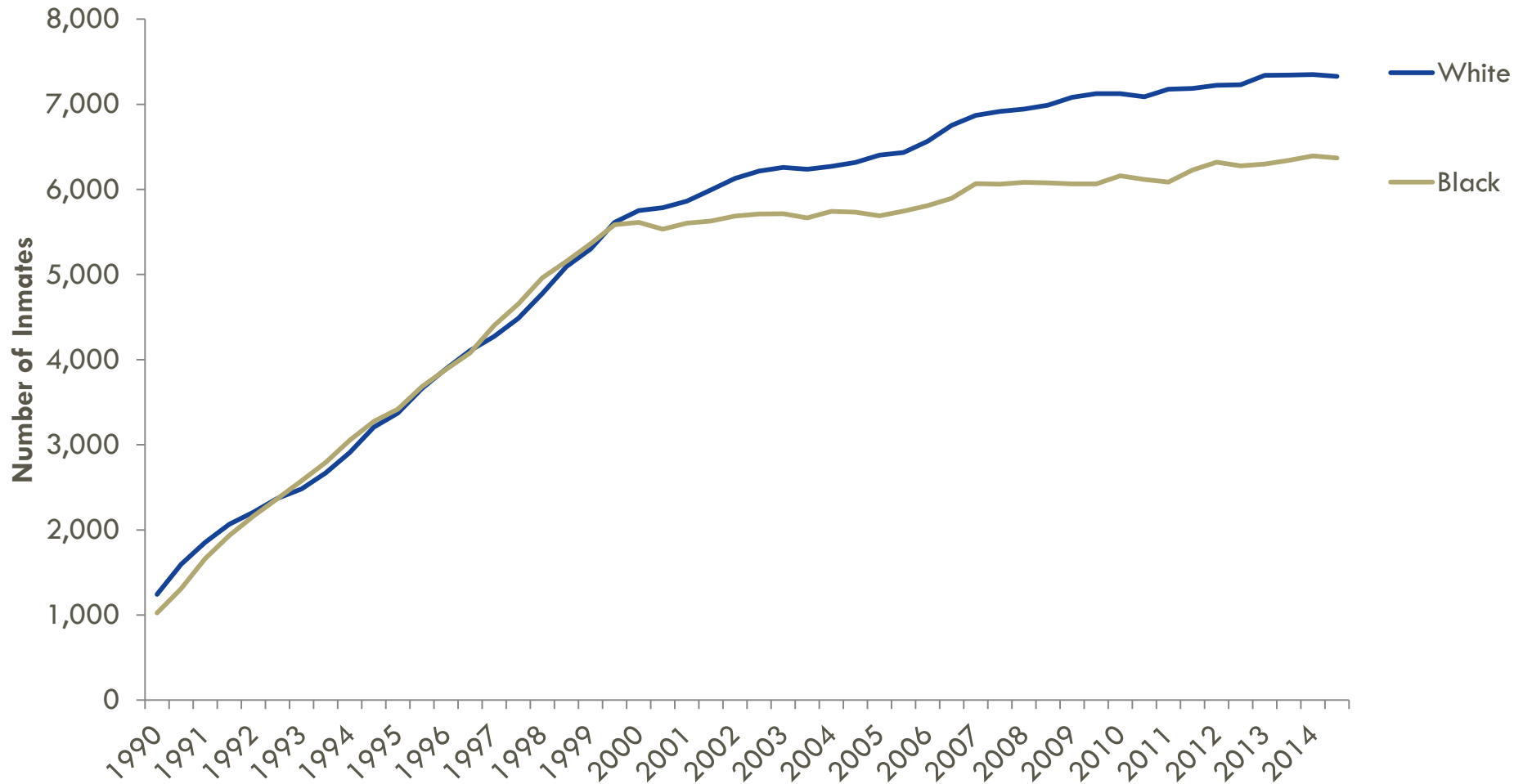

Violent Offense as Most Serious Offense by Race Statewide

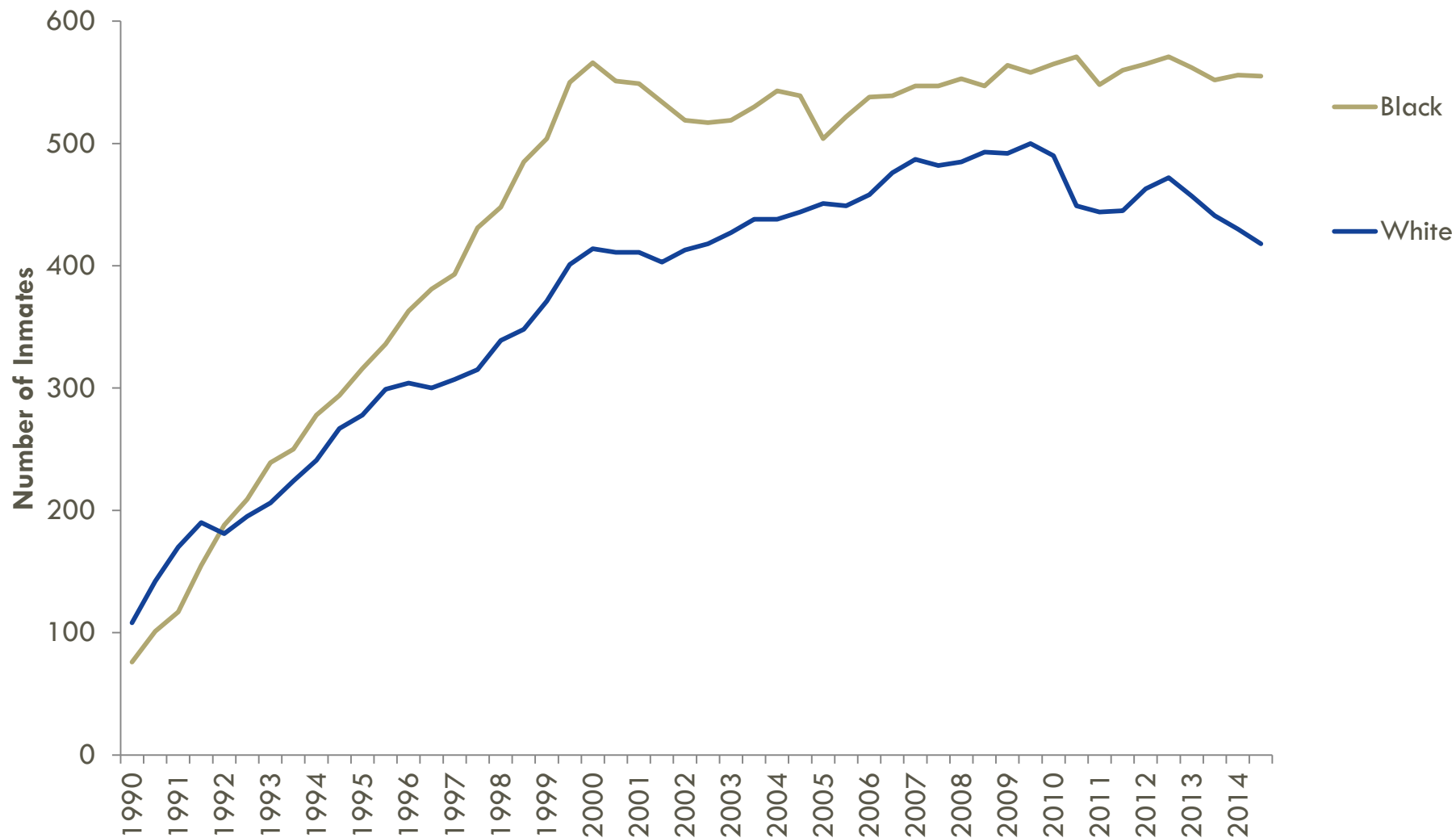

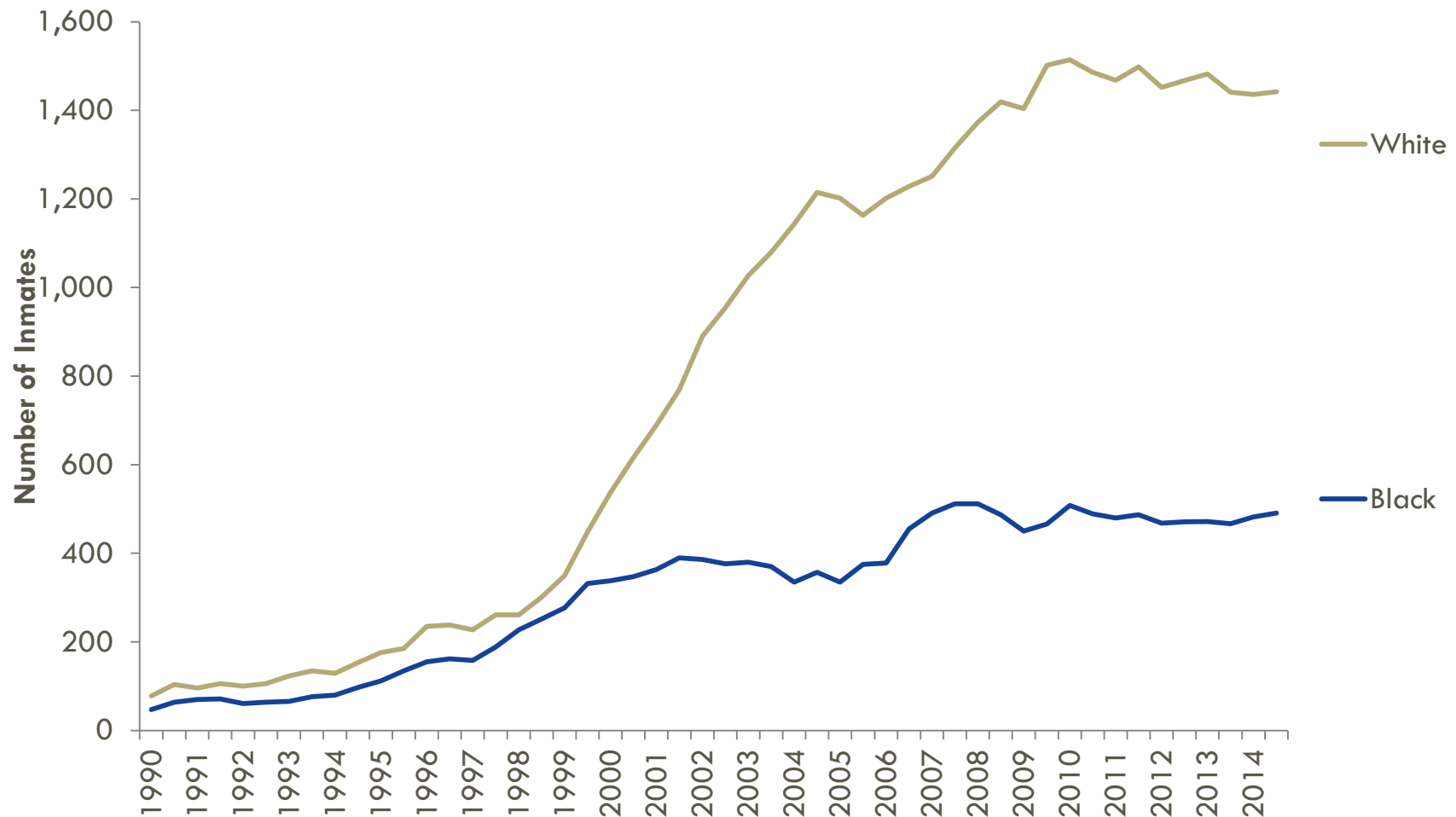

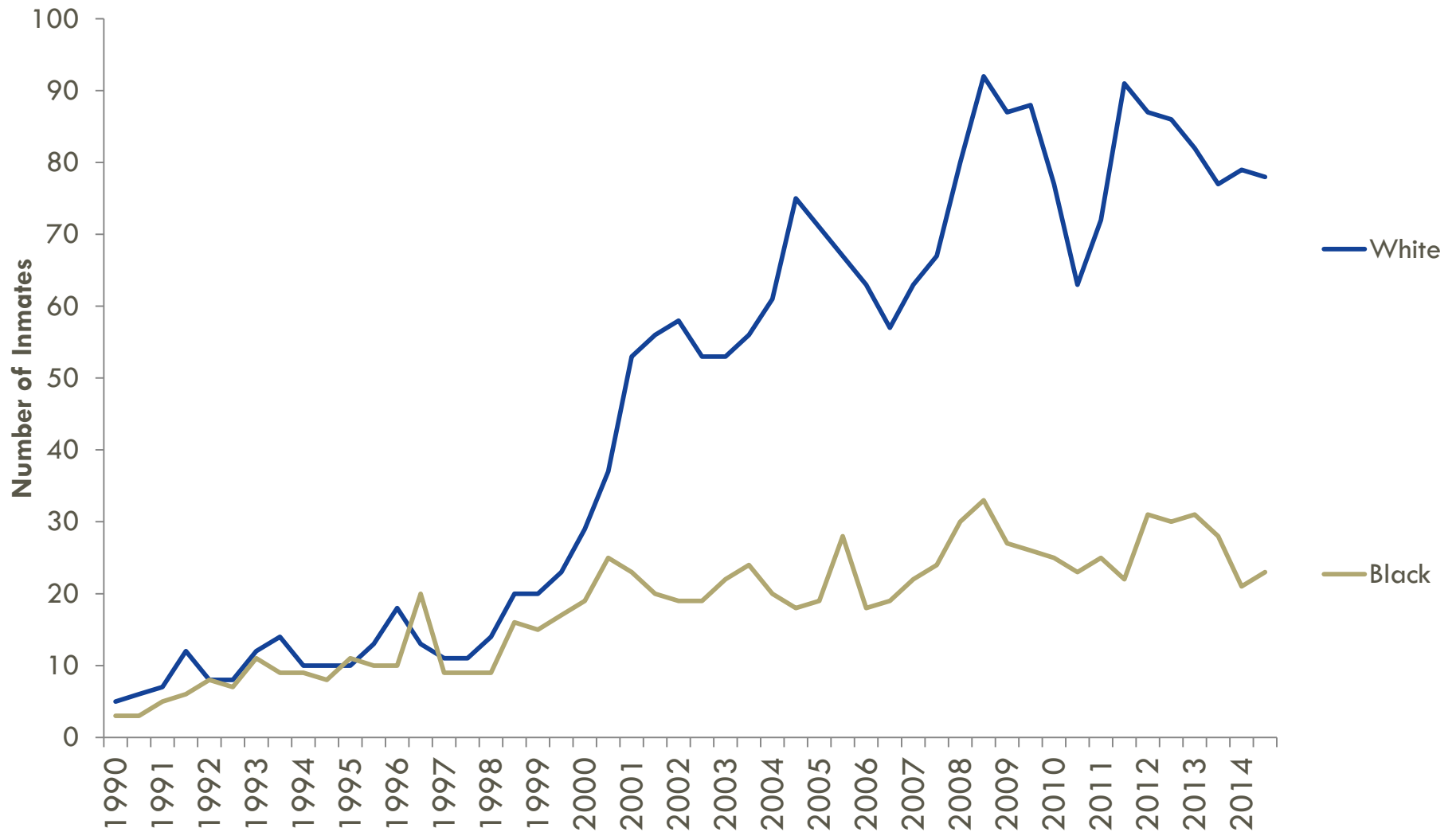
Public Order Offense as Most Serious Offense by Race Statewide

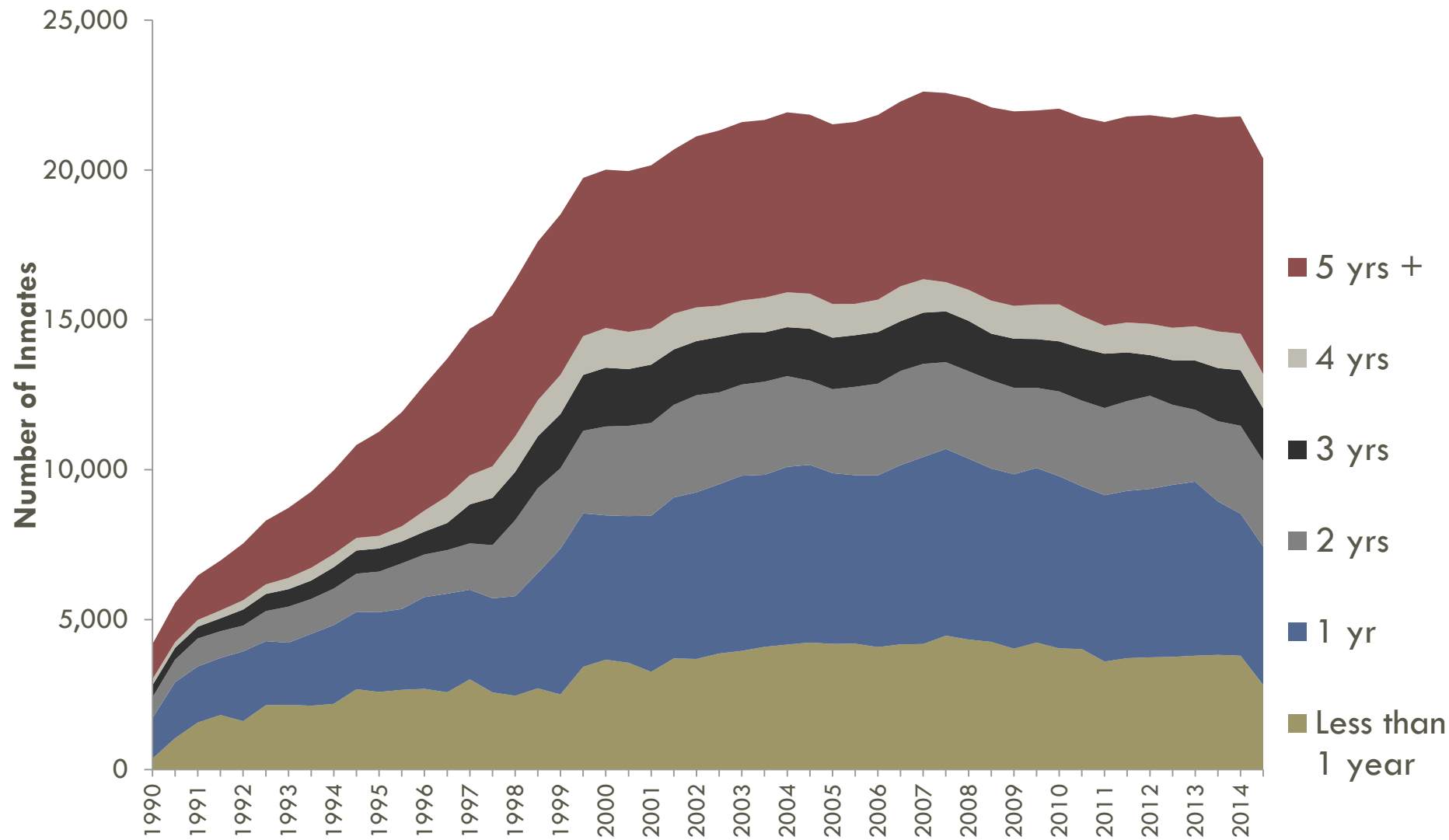

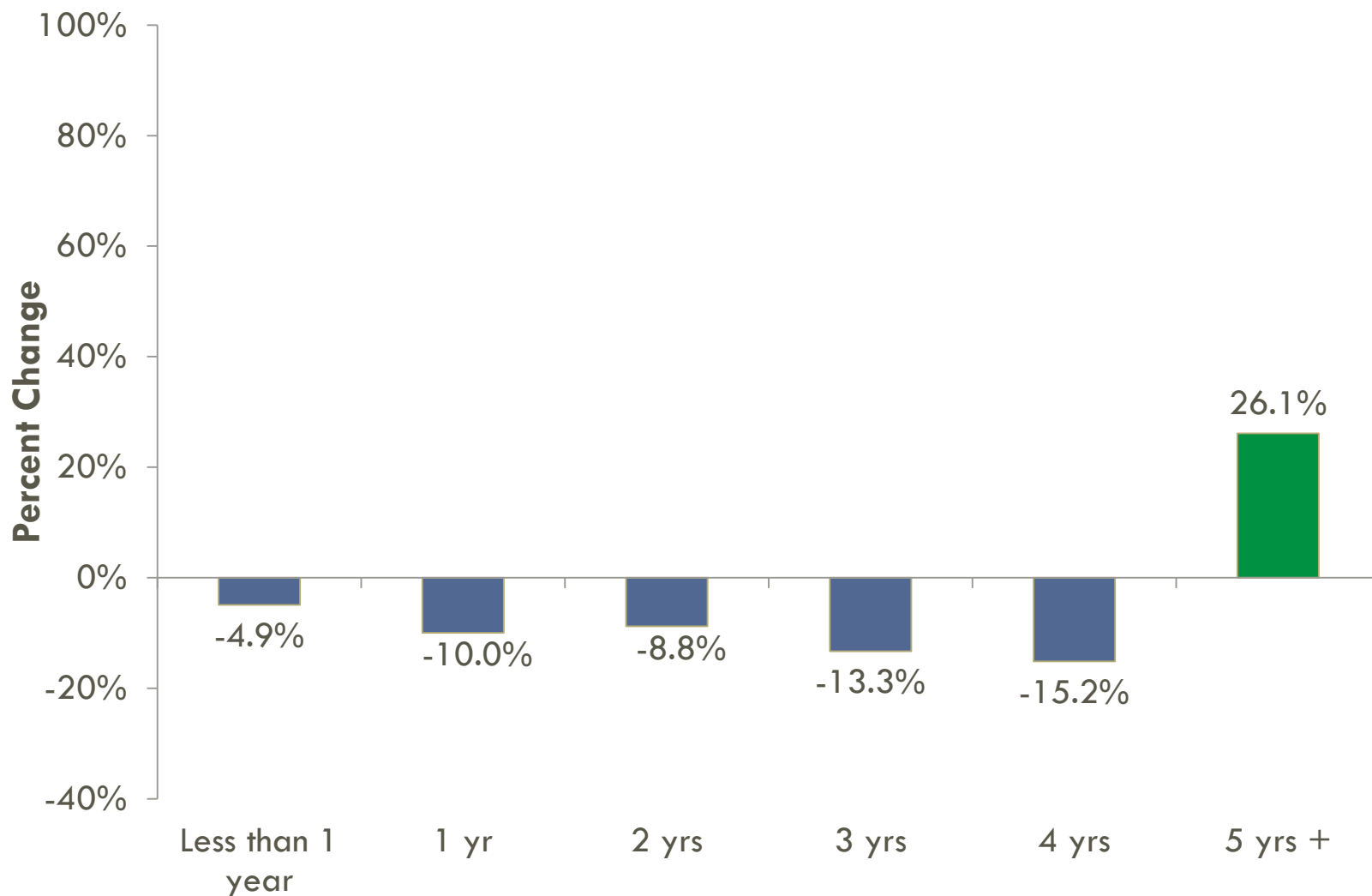
Confinement Time Remaining

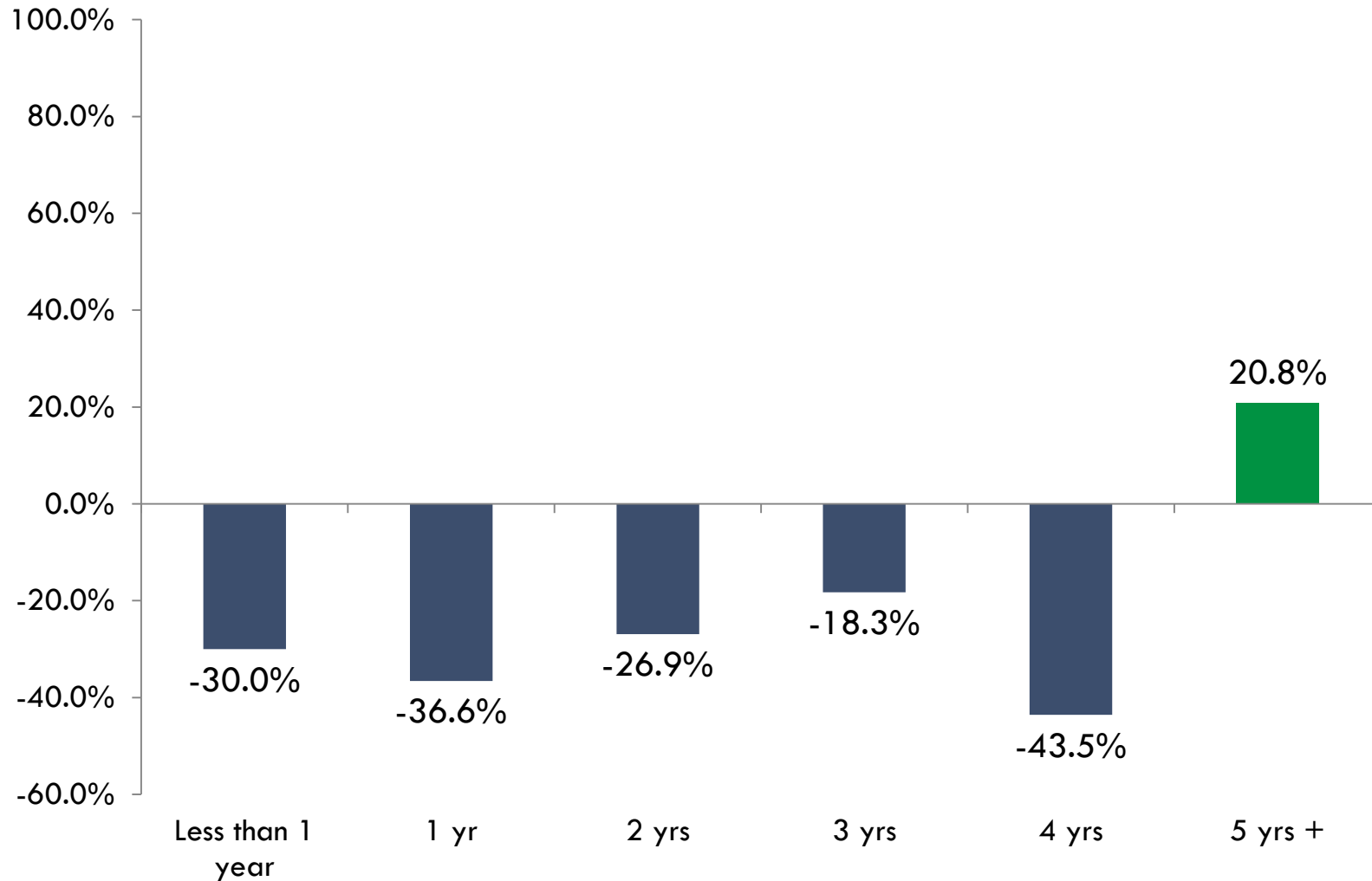
% Change in Time Left to Serve 2000 to 2014 *Statewide*

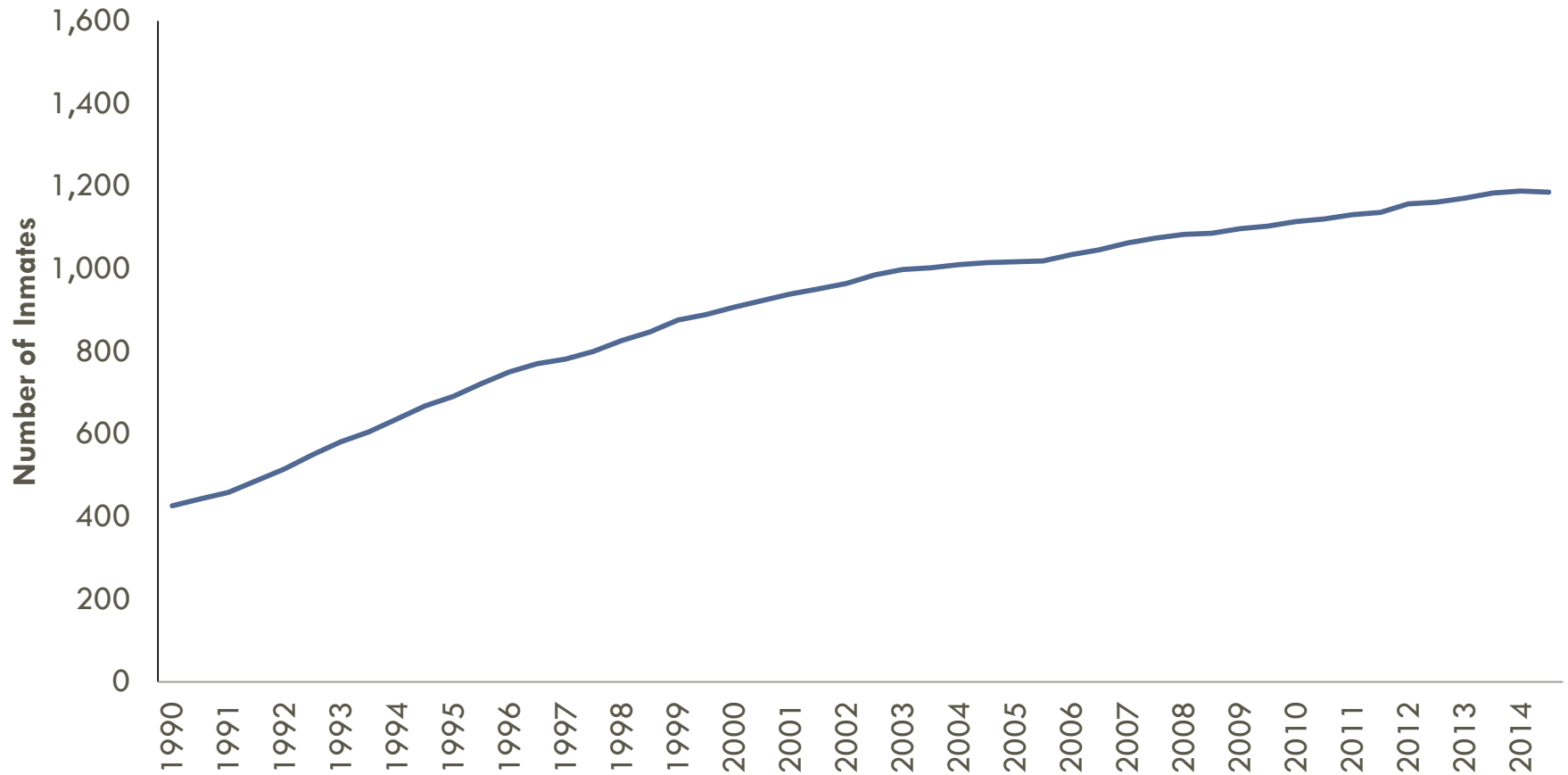
% Change in Time Left to Serve 2000 to 2014

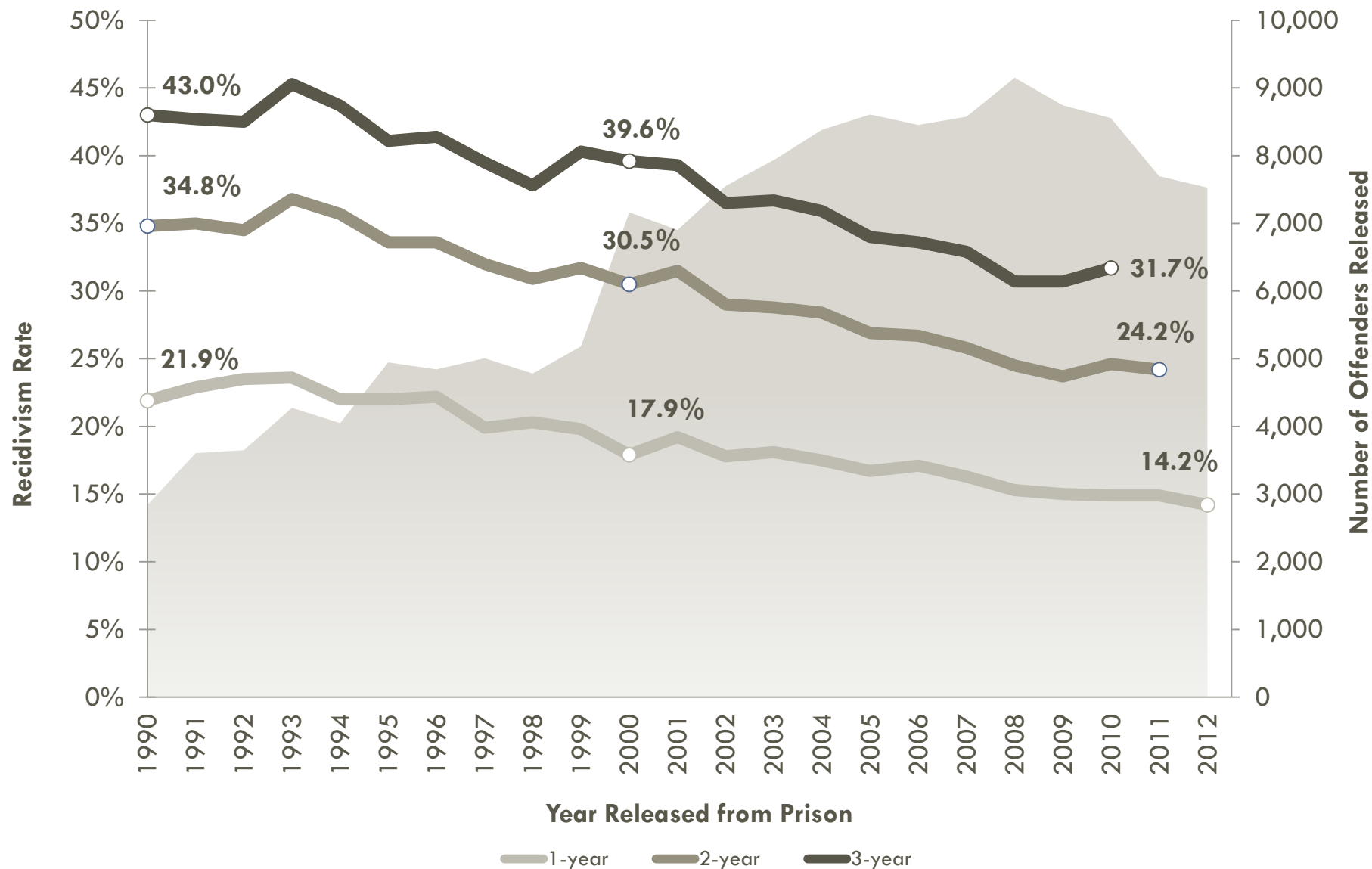
Number of Lifers at Each Point in Time



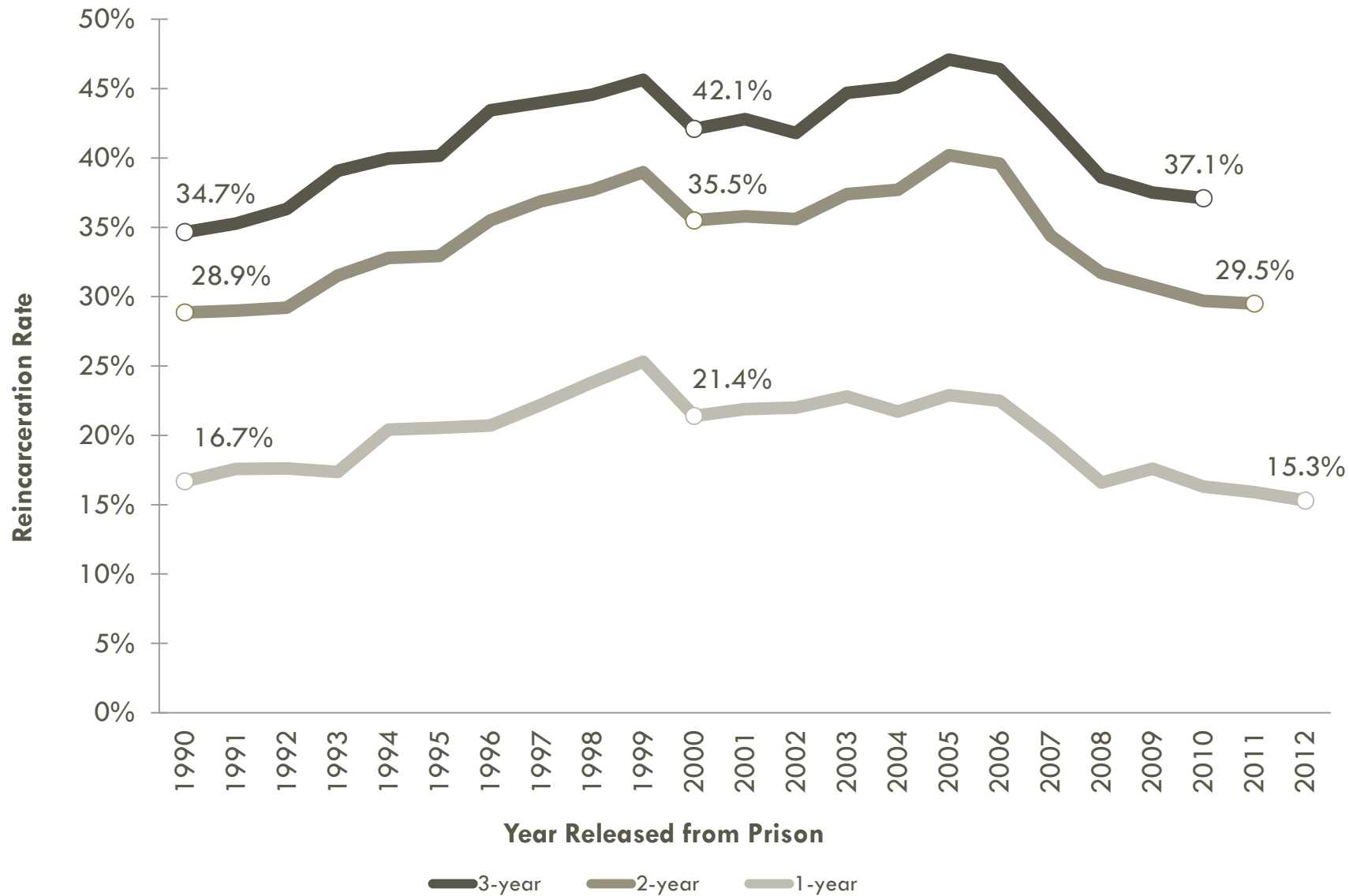
Percent Change of Lifers in Prison (as Proportion of Total Population)

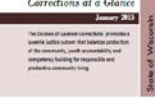
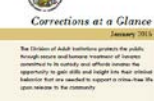
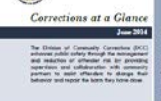
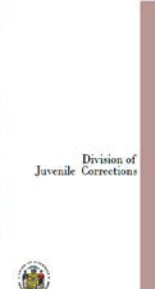
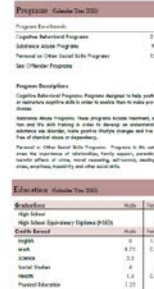
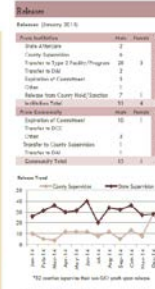
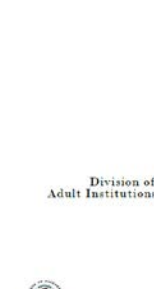
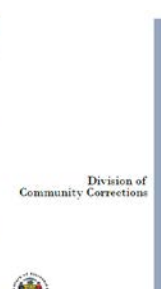
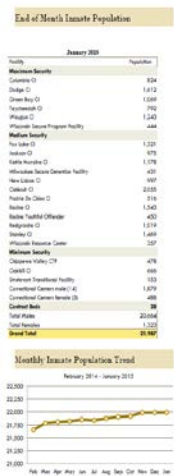
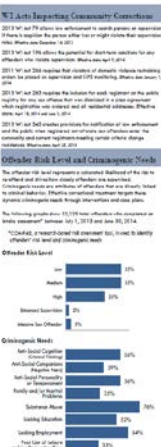
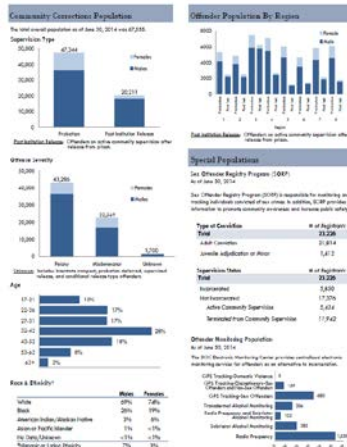
Recidivism Rates

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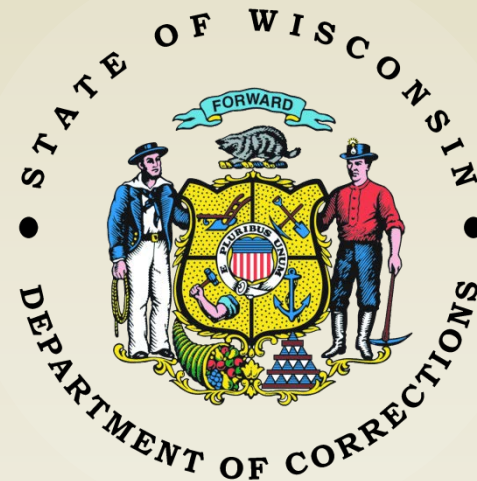
