1 SUB 2015 RES-158 (PROPOSED- RUSK) 2 3 AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE 4 DEVELOPMENT GRANT FUNDING FOR A DANE COUNTY JAIL BASED AMERICAN JOB 5 CENTER 6 7 The State of Wisconsin, Department of Work Force Development, Division of 8 Employment and Training, in collaboration with the Workforce Development Board of South 9 Central Wisconsin Program, is making funds available to establish a Dane County Jail Based 10 American Job Center, within Dane County Jail, to address criminogenic needs that can lead to recidivism including employment, education, anti-social cognition, anti-social personality, and 11 12 anti-social companions to assist in the transition from incarceration to the community. 13 14 Grant funding of \$500,000 has been awarded to the Workforce Development Board of 15 South Central Wisconsin to establish a Dane County Windows to Work Program funded through 16 the US Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration. As part of this grant 17 \$450,000 has been awarded to the Sheriff's Office to support two (2) FTE Social Worker Senior 18 positions as Career Coaches, a (.5) FTE Program Manager, supplies for instruction, and other 19 facility program expenses including printing, insurance, and telephone costs; the term of the 20 grant is September 1, 2015, through May 31, 2017. 21 22 The Sheriff's Office will work with the Work Force Development Board of South Central 23 Wisconsin to identify eligible participants for the Program by administering risk assessments of 24 criminogenic needs and work readiness. Career Coaches will provide pre/post-release services 25 and support to assist in the transition from incarceration to the community. Career Coaches will 26 work with program participants for pre-release utilizing Windows to Work Program. Pre-release components shall include Cognitive Intervention, General Work Skills and Expectations, 27 28 Financial Literacy, Community Resources, and Job Seeking Applications and Resumes. Career 29 Coaches will register participants with Job Center Wisconsin to build a work readiness portfolio 30 to assist and support successful entry and retainage of employment. 31 32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to 33 accept \$450,000 from the Department of Work Force Development to create a Dane County Jail 34 Based American Job Center; and 35 36 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is authorized to create 2 FTE 37 Social Worker positions and .5 FTE Program Manager position effective September 1, 2015, 38 contingent upon continued funding from US Department of Labor, Employment and Training 39 Administration; and 40 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$450,000 is set up as additional revenue in Sheriff, Security Services, Windows to Work Revenue (SHRFSEC-NEW) and be credited to the General 42 43 Fund; and 44 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$450,000 is transferred from General Fund to the 45 46 following expenditure accounts: 47 Salaries and Wages (SHRFSEC 10009) \$ 273,900 \$ Retirement Fund (SHRFSEC 10099) 22,000 Social Security (SHRFSEC 10108) \$ 21,300
