AWARD OF CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS FOR THE NUTRIENT CONCENTRATION SYSTEM AT THE GL DAIRY BIOGAS DIGESTER IN THE TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD

## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

Brief Description of Proposal -

The GL Dairy Biogas digester owned by Gundersen Health System converts cow manure from three dairy farms into valuable renewable electricity and continues Dane County's partnership with the agricultural community by reducing phosphorus runoff to area lakes and streams. The nutrient concentration system (NCS) proposed to be added to the digester project will treat the post-digester effluent resulting in clean water and concentrated liquid nutrients.

Current Policy or Practice -

The NCS effectively controls nearly 100% of the phosphorus from the dairy manure compared to 60% phosphorus removal from the current operating technology.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Additional phosphorus reductions from land-applied manure will enhance the County's efforts to further limit phosphorus runoff resulting in less algae growth and cleaner lakes and streams.
