2016 RES-217 AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF COST-SHARE FUNDS Dane County Land & Water Resources - Land Conservation Division has secured \$48,600 in funding from Clean Lakes Alliance and \$31,050 from Yahara WINs for extending Harvestable Buffer Program contracts. Three contracts are in the Six Mile Creek Watershed north of Lake Mendota. One contract is in just outside of Door Creek. These contracts were implemented in the first years of the Harvestable Buffer Program. Since 2014, the program has expanded to include 10 and 15-year contracts. The Land Conservation Division will receive funds from Clean Lakes Alliance and Yahara WINs to extend contracts for a total of 15-years for 7.7 miles and 386 total pounds of phosphorus reduction each year. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$48,600 from Clean Lakes Alliance and \$31,050 from Yahara WINs. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that new accounts CPLWRESC Harvestable Buffer Cost-Share revenue and expense be established for \$79,650. These funds shall be carried forward until expended.
