Current ordinance

• None

Discussion

- Rural areas different from urban areas.
- Transient or infrequent vs. steady noise.
- Difficulty in measurement, establishing uniform standards in diverse landscape, lot size, etc.
- May be more appropriate to tailor to specific uses/locations through CUP or conditional zoning to commercial districts.

Noise Limits

Current Ordinance

• None

Proposed Ordinance

- Town / committee may, as necessary, set decibel limits appropriate to the use and location as a condition on a CUP.
- County board may, as necessary, set decibel limits appropriate to the use and location as a condition on rezones to General Commercial, Heavy Commercial, Limited Commercial or Traditional Neighborhood Mixed-Use districts.
- Measurement: all decibel readings shall be:
 - Based on the db(a) scale
 - Taken from the property line of the property nearest to the source of the sound
 - Averaged over readings taken once a minute over a fifteen-minute interval.
