4 5 6 7 8	In 2007 Dane County entered into a cooperative agreement with Landkreis Kassel, Hessen, Germany to form a sister county relationship. The purpose of the agreement was to exchange ideas and build economic partnerships in the areas of renewable energy, regional transportation systems, workforce training and continuing education and cultural exchange.
9 10 11 12 13 14	Kassel, a county with a population of approximately 193,000, has a regional transport system, is home to a university and the Institute for Solar Energy Technologies. The area hosts a high- technology based economy focused on traffic, logistics, and renewable energies with its main industries being systems technology for photovoltaics, the manufacture of train engines, and automotive factories for Volkswagen and Daimler-Chrysler.
15 16 17	Throughout the last nine years, both Kassel and Dane County have remained committed to the goals that were set forth in the cooperative agreement as demonstrated by multiple exchanges between the counties.
18 19 20 21 22	A delegation from Dane County went to Kassel in 2007 to experience and learn about Kassel's commuter rail structure, solar energy initiatives, and the international <i>Documenta</i> Art Festival. Representatives from Kassel came to Dane County in 2008 to witness water resource management, visit agri-businesses, tour an organic farm, and attend a performance at Concerts on the Square, as well as a Mallards baseball game.
23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30	The Kassel Fine Arts Curator and local officials brought a Brothers Grimm artwork exhibit in 2010 to the Dane County Regional Airport terminal and in 2012 Michael Velliquette travelled to Kassel to represent Dane County as part of an international contemporary art show. Dane County welcomed artist and photographer, Christian Schauderna, from Kassel in 2014 as an Artist-In-Residence at Edgewood College, where he created a new work in the Edgewood College Gallery. And Dane County chamber music group, <i>con vivo!</i> , traveled to Kassel in 2015 to participate in the Kultursommer NordHessen Arts Festival.
31 32 33 34 35	Most recently, in 2016 the Kassel-Dane Task Force invited the Edgar Knecht Trio to Dane County to perform one concert at the Stoughton Opera House, collaborate with the chamber music group <i>con vivo!</i> to perform a concert at First Congregational Church, and hold a master class with the Madison College Big Band and perform in a joint concert at Mitby Theatre.
