Missy Tracy, Ho-Chunk Nation and Zia Brucaya, Urban Assets provided an overview and update of the proposed Ho-Chunk Gaming Madison Development Project. The project is proposed to include an expansion of the existing casino, hotel, sports fields and heritage center. The heritage center will provide visitors information regarding the history of the Ho-Chunk Nation in Wisconsin, and in particular Dane County. The Commission and staff provided summaries of cultural resources within the Capital Springs Recreation Area and efforts Dane County Parks has made to preserve cultural resources, including expediting of the 1992 burial mound inventory completed by Larry Johns. Zia summarized by asking that Dane County attend an upcoming project steering committee meeting to further their awareness of existing cultural resources and potential partnership opportunities.
