

AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF INSURANCE

The adopted 2017 budget provides the authority to purchase insurance to protect Dane County.

Dane County purchases insurance coverage through Wisconsin Municipal Mutual Insurance Company (WMMIC) for automobile liability, general liability, miscellaneous liability, and errors and omissions in amounts up to \$10 million in excess coverage to protect the County from catastrophic losses.

In addition, insurance coverage is purchased from commercial insurance carriers for issues that are excluded from the WMMIC policy, specifically: Airport Liability insurance, Professional Liability insurance for Badger Prairie Health Care Center and the Medical Examiner's Office; property insurance, insurance to cover physical damage to automobiles and equipment, boiler insurance, underground tank insurance, insurance to cover employee crime and theft insurance, builder's risk insurance, and Workers Compensation coverage for volunteer EMS. The specific amounts for these policies are provided in the adopted 2017 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Controller be authorized to pay the premiums and deductibles associated with these contracts.
