AMENDING THE 2016 TELLURIAN, INC. PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - CYF DIVISION

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This resolution adds funds to the professional service POS contract with Tellurian, Inc. for 2016. Among a variety of services provided to individuals, Tellurian, Inc. provides residential treatment at their Adult Residential Program (ARP) for Dane County residents who have a substance use disorder who otherwise have an inability to fund this level of care. The demand for this service has exceeded the projection of 162 days of care that was contracted at the beginning of the current year. As such, it is necessary to increase the funding to this contract by \$25,000 for an additional 100 days of care to meet the actual demand for the year. The contract for this program will increase to a total of \$65,500.

Current Policy or Practice -

Budget and professional service contract changes require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

A professional service contract between Tellurian, Inc. and Dane County will be amended for 2016. By amending this contract, the department is able to continue to deliver quality residential care without the need for a waiting list. The department screens and authorizes individuals to receive residential treatment in this program. Residential treatment is one of the tools the department uses to help people who are dependent on heroin and other opiates enter into recovery. The department has underspending in other areas that can be used to fund this contract amendment.
