Project Description: Install 3D TRASAR for Cooling

With improved water and chemical control there is an opportunity to reduce the blowdown water content from 35% to 20% a reduction in make-up and blowdown water by 15% 2.55 MM gallons x 15% = 383,000 gallons of make up and 383,000 gallons of blowdown Total savings \$3,066 Annually. ROI – 21 months.

This project moves the County toward meeting its Sustainability Principles by

- Reduction of over 700,000 gallons of makeup and blowdown water combined
- Demand based control of chemical treatment eliminates excessive chemical feed
- Saving over 700,000 gallons of makeup water and blowdown water combined

This project furthers the County's Sustainable Operations plan goal of reducing the consumption of water and reducing over feeding of chemicals.
