Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Dept of Public Works, Highway & Transportation and representatives of the Village of Marshall have determined that CTH T from School St to STH 19 will be resurfaced. The same segment of road will be jurisdictionally transferred to the Village on November 1, 2017 and will no longer be a County Trunk Highway.

Current Policy or Practice -

Dane County Highway and Transportation has an agreement to cover the design and resurfacing project with the municipality.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The County's maximum share is \$300,000 and the Village's maximum share is \$190,000. The County has funds available in account HWCONCAP-59070 to cover the total project costs.
